

All law enforcement agencies maintaining records (police departments, sheriff's offices, clerks of superior courts, credit bureaus, photo registration records, tax collectors' records, city directories, telephone directories, and power commission records) have been checked in the 21 county area covered by the Albany RA 4/10/68, against the surname of LOWMEYER and LOWMYER with phonetic variations and no record was located except at the Credit Bureau of Albany.

MERLENE HYSLER, Credit Bureau of Albany, advised SA CHEEK her records reflect an inquiry in September 1967 from the Credit Bureau of Jacksonville, N. C., concerning Captain DONALD L. LOHMEIER, MCSN 030160. Captain LOHMEIER was in Viet Nam in 1966 and formerly lived in Magnolia Apartments, Albany, Ga., His wife's name is HELEN. In September 1967 he was living at 16 Vandergriff, Jacksonville, N. C. The files contained no additional identifying data.

All laundries in the same 21 county area were checked on 4/10/53. The only laundry utilizing tags made by the Thermo Seal Marking Machine (manufactured by the Textile Marking Machine Company, Syracuse, New York) is Sno-White Laundry of Albany, Ga.

S. J. RICE, Manager of Sno-White Landry, Albany, Ga., advised SA CHEEK on 4/10/68 he utilizes Thermo Seal equipment exclusively. He purchased this marking machine from DICK BRISTOW, Salesman for Thermo Seal Marking Machines for the Southeast states. BRISTOW resides in Gainesville, Fla., and will have a listing of all laundries for the Thermo Seal Marking Machine.

RICE advised he uses red tapes with black lettering and furnished specimens of laundry markings which have been forwarded to the FBI Laboratory for comparison purposes. Specimens bearing the marks "02B-6" and "D2B-6" were obtained. RICE pointed out that these combinations were not his marks since he does not start a mark with a letter nor does he use a "0" as a starting number. His marks begin with a number, such as one, two, three, etc.

Teletype leads to interview BRISTOW and to check out Captain LOHMEIER were sent 4/10/68.

Results of negative investigation were summarized as above and are not set forth in detail relative to investigation conducted by the Albany RA concerning laundry marks and attempts to identify LOWMEYER and LOWMYER.
