MAX HEMPERLY, College Park, Rt. #2, Pleasant Hill Road, no telephone, telephonically furnished the following information at 8:55 a.m., 4/12/68, stating that he was calling from a pay telephone, as he had no telephone at his residence:

HEMPERLY stated that he had seen a sketch of the alleged killer of MARTIN LUTHER KING in the "New York Daily News" on 4/11/68 and noticed an individual who resembled this sketch on a bus that he took to College Park on 4/11/68.

HEMPERLY said he caught this bus near Rich's Department Store shortly before 2:00 p.m. and this bus got to College Park about 2:30 p.m. While on this bus, he noticed this individual, whom he said closely approximated the sketch that he had seen in the "New York Daily News." Attached article sets forth Mrs. Riley's statement that she contacted the FBI last Wednesday night and was referred to the Atlanta Police; that the police checked it Wednesday and FBI Agents followed Thursday afternoon. This is incorrect. We have no information indicating any such contact with the FBI on Wednesday, and I have contacted all logical employees to substantiate this. Superintendent CHAFIN, Atlanta PD advised me today that his Department has no record of any such report on Wednesday. The first information received by the APD. according to CHAFIN, was on Thursday, when two ministers reported the information to the Atlanta Police Department, which prompted the NCIC check. This appears to be an error on the part of the reporters in establishing the specific day.

When interviewed 4/11/68 by BuAgents, Mrs. Riley made no reference to any previous contact with the FBI in this case.
