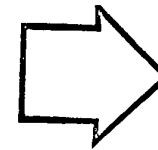

Miss ROBBIE LEE GARNER, Dixieland Apartments, 1295 Donnelly St., SW, Atlanta, Ga., apartment unknown, reportedly found envelopes addressed to ERIC S. GALT at 113 14th St. on the mail table near the front door, on either 4/13 or 14/68. She brought the findings of these envelopes to the attention of her brother, JIMMY D. GARNER, who is manager of above apartment house. Miss GARNER allegedly had informed her brother that this was the same name as the name of the person in the news and radio broadcasts that they are looking for in connection with the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. GARNER allegedly responded by saying that a lot of people had the same name.

LEAD:

Will locate and interview Miss ROBBIE LEE GARNER re above matter and attempt to determine brother's reaction to findings of envelopes addressed to GALT. She should be closely questioned in this regard because of purpose of this interview to determine veracity of GARNER. GARNER has given different stories in different interviews and question has arisen as to whether or not he is covering up GALT's activities or not.

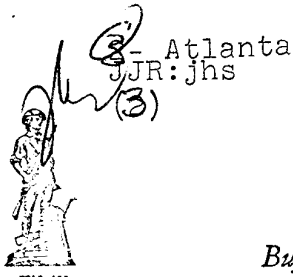

BILL CONOVER, WSB News Director, telephonically contacted the Atlanta Office at approximately 11:45 p.m. on 4/13/68, and advised that he had received a telephone call from a Mr. JOHN RILEY, Capital Homes, Atlanta, Georgia, at which time RILEY stated his wife had been interviewed by FBI Agents when the 1966 white Mustang was recovered in parking lot of Capital Homes, but had not told the Agents at the apartment building.

Unsub. entered after leaving car.

Because she was frightened, CONOVER was of the opinion RILEY, who was in Fulton County Jail for drunk and disorderly, was motivated by his attempt to be released from prison.

It should be noted Mrs. RILEY was unable to furnish any pertinent information in this matter by interview of Agents and advised news media that she had telephonically contacted the Atlanta Office the night before the recovery of subject Mustang, which information was untrue.

Will reinterview Mrs. JOHN R. RILEY, Capital Homes in an effort to determine if she is aware of apartment that Unsub entered after leaving white Mustang.

On 4/7/68, MICHAEL GARCIA voluntarily appeared at the FBI RA, Gainesville, Fla., and furnished the following information.

GARCIA is a Private E-3, US Army. His serial number is RA 12889051 and he is from Tampa, Florida. He is to report to Ft. Lewis, Washington, on 4/20/68, for shipment to Viet Nam. He will be in Tampa, Fla. until it is time for him to report to Ft. Lewis.

GARCIA's father is MANUEL GARCIA, Attorney, Tampa, Florida.

On Saturday, 3/30/68, GARCIA left Ft. Benning, Ga. en route to Gainesville, Florida, where he was formerly a student at the University of Florida. GARCIA took State Road 28 out of Columbus, Georgia, en route to Interstate 75 at Cordele, Georgia. Several miles out of Columbus on "28", at an isolated spot, he picked up a hitchhiker who claimed he was going to Orlando, Florida. GARCIA described this hitchhiker, who gave his name as JACK or HARRY RUSSELL as follows:

the law as he knows places to hide. He further claimed two Negroes threw him off of a train once causing him to have a concussion and causing his inner ear to fill with blood. He expressed a distinct dislike for Negroes. GARCIA advised that during conversation with this individual he asked GARCIA where he was from. When GARCIA told him he was from Tampa he asked if GARCIA knew anything about the Mafia. GARCIA told him that his father, MANUEL GARCIA, an Attorney, had done some legal work for the TRAFFICANTES in Tampa. He told GARCIA he was going to Orlando to do some work for the Mafia, for which he would receive a new Mercury and \$7000. He told GARCIA upon arrival in Orlando he was to walk up and down a certain street, name unrecalled, in Orlando until someone contacted him. He further stated that from Orlando he was going to Miami after which he would head north through Tennessee, to Idaho, and would feel better when he had a "few G's" in his pocket. He told GARCIA that his job had nothing to do with dope and indicated his job would be done in a week, after when he would be on his way to Idaho. He showed GARCIA a picture which he removed from his billfold of a place where he was going in Idaho. GARCIA recalls this picture showed snow covered mountains and a mountain lake. He claimed he was going to a small camp where he had "laid up" before. GARCIA recalls that he mentioned a waterfall at this place which gave off a spray revealing an image that looked like a reclining woman.

GARCIA advised that this individual appeared to know quite a bit about weaponry and stated that he talked about the AK47, Chinese assault rifle, laser beam, and light anti-tank weapon.

GARCIA advised after arriving in Gainesville he let this individual off on West University Avenue where he claimed he wanted to wash his clothes in a washateria. GARCIA stated that on Sunday, 3/31/68, around noon, he saw this individual hitchhiking on Archer Road toward I-75. He stopped and asked GARCIA if he would give him a ride as far as I-75, but GARCIA was in a hurry and unable to do so. ~~He~~ ~~has~~ not seen this individual since.

GARCIA stated that he did not give too much thought to the conversation he had with this individual until after the announcement of the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. on 4/4/68. He stated after this announcement he began to give thought to the conversation mentioned herein that he had with this individual, particularly to his expressed dislike for Negroes and he also mentioned the Communist element among Negroes and he therefore thought he should report this to the proper authorities.

GARCIA reviewed all the pending identification orders but was unable to make an identification. He was asked to study the identification order of ROBERT BOLIVAR DE PUGH, IO #4176, inasmuch as process is outstanding for DE PUGH in Seattle and the description of the hitchhiker somewhat fits DE PUGH. After closely studying DE PUGH, GARCIA stated he could not state whether or not DE PUGH was identical with the hitchhiker, primarily in view of the fact the hitchhiker had such a full bush beard.
