

RITA STEIN'S RESIDENCE OR RITA WAS AT THE BAR AND TOOK GALT TO HER RESIDENCE TO MEET RITA'S BROTHER, CHARLES STEIN. MARIA MARTIN DID NOT REMEMBER WHETHER SHE WAS AT THE STEIN RESIDENCE THAT EVENING.

LATER THE SAME EVENING, WHEN GALT LEARNED THAT CHARLES STEIN WOULD ACCOMPANY HIM TO NEW ORLEANS INSTEAD OF MARIA OR RITA, GALT MADE THE STATEMENT TO MARIA THAT "IF ITS A SET UP I'LL KILL HIM. I HAVE A GUN." MARIA REASSURED GALT THAT IT WAS NOT A SET UP BUT ONLY RITA STEIN'S NEED TO GET HER CHILDREN. GALT THEN MADE THE CONDITION THAT RITA, CHARLES AND MARIA HAD TO REGISTER FOR GEORGE WALLACE IN CALIFORNIA AND ARRANGEMENTS WERE MADE TO REGISTER THE NEXT DAY. GALT'S MUSTANG WAS BELIEVED TO BE FOREST GREEN IN COLOR AND VERY PLAIN INSIDE IN THAT THERE WERE NO EXTRAS, SUCH AS A CONSOLE, FM RADIO OR AIR CONDITIONING. MARIA RECALLED ONE OCCASION WHEN GALT TOLD HER HE HAD HAD DIFFICULTY DRIVING THROUGH A NEGRO COMMUNITY, BECAUSE OF THE ALABAMA LICENSE PLATES ON HIS CAR AND THAT TOMATOES HAD BEEN THROWN AT IT.

GALT GAVE THE IMPRESSION TO MARIA THAT HE HAD BEEN MARRIED ONCE JUST BY HIS COOL MANNER.

LYLE, 783 Confederate Avenue; J. D. BRIDWELL, 232 Pryor Street, Atlanta; J. W. LIPSCOMB, 1811 Fisher Road, S.E., Atlanta, CHARLES E. PRATT, Box 637, Route 1, Austell, Ga. He listed his mother as INEZ HOWELL, 803 Parkway Street, Dalton, Ga. and sister PATRICIA JUNE HITE, 2847 White Oak Drive, Decatur, Ga., telephone 289-8958. Check at HOWELL's neighborhood reflects neighbors advise HOWELL went to visit wife's parents in Atlanta, last name ELLIOTT. no address given.

Birmingham Office noted that EDWARD UHLAN HILL, FBI No. 594075E was the subject of a Racial Matters investigation conducted by Birmingham and Atlanta in 1965. HILL was described as a fanatic on the racial question and has made statements in the past that he was a demolition expert and was available for jobs in the Klan at any time. HILL reportedly mentioned he had purchased a rifle scope in April, 1965. He is described at Polk Co. Ga., 5' $10\frac{1}{2}$ ", as a white male, born 182 pounds, brown hair, plue eyes. Review of Atlanta files indicates racial matters file referred toby Birmingham was the "Green Bombs" case, Atlanta File 174-1. Atlanta file 44-1774, indicated that EDWARD UHLAN HILL was victim in a Civil Rights case investigated by the Atlanta Office and indicated his address is 616 East Avenue, Cedartown, Ga., in August, 1965. He was listed as being 25 years old, DOB in Polk Co. Ga. Above Civil Rights investigation was based on HILL's allegation of police brutality by Cedatown, Ga. Police Officers.
