On 4/18/68, SA PAUL LEE MILLER was contacted by car radio and he was to proceed to the Atlanta Police Department, where Sergeant BRADLEY of the Atlanta Police Department, Auto Theft Squad, had someone under questioning who appeared to be similar in appearance to ERIC STARVO GALT.

On arriving at the Atlanta Police Department, Auto Theft Squad, SA PAUL LEE MILLER conferred with Sergeant BRADLEY, who advised that this individual, STEPHEN GORDON PRESSLEY had come into the Atlanta Police Department voluntarily to answer questions concerning his identity and reason for being in Atlanta, SA MILLER identified himself to STEPHEN GORDON PRESSLEY and told him that he was not under arrest and asked him whether he would be willing to answer some questions. Mr. PRESSLEY advised that he would gladly answer any questions that were asked of him and would cooperate in any way possible so that he could leave the Police Department as soon as possible. Mr. PRESSLEY advised that he was carrying his Social Security Card along with his Selective Service Card, his birth certificate, and his discharge papers from the Air Force, which he made available, to SA PAUL LEE MILLER for examination.

On April 17, 1968, he took a Greyhound bus from Warner Robins, Georgia, to Atlanta, Ga., and arrived sometime after midnight, April 17, 1968.

Mr. PRESSLEY advised that while he worked for Geren Rides, he used an alias, GENE SEAWEIL. PRESSLEY stated that the reason he used an alias is that his former wife, who has just remarried, is seeking at least \$600 in back support payments for his children. PRESSLEY stated that he does not want her to find him, since at this time he does not have the money to pay her. Mr. PRESSLEY stated that he believes he does not look like ERIC STARVO GALT and denies every being in Memphis, Tenn., or having any knowledge whatsoever concerning the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. PRESSLEY stated that he would voluntarily allow himself to be photographed and fingerprinted so that his name could be cleared from this investigation.

PRESSLEY advised that he worked for the carnival show as a person who helps in constructing the ferris wheel and operated a ride while the carnival was in session. PRESSLEY advised that he decided to leave the show and seek some temporary work in Atlanta. He secured whatever money was coming to him and took a bus to Atlanta. PRESSLEY said that he was sitting in the bus station since about midnight, 4/17/68, until Detective BRADLEY approached him after he had given blood at a nearby blood bank and asked him whether he would accompany the detective to the Atlanta Police Department, for some questioning.

SA PAUL LEE MILLER was advised by SA ROGER L. KAAS that the photograph and fingerprint examination of PRESSLEY has proven that he is not ERIC STARVO GALT and that there is no reason to continue questioning PRESSLEY. Thus PRESSLEY was allowed to leave the Police Station and a room was found for him at the Falcon Hotel, 180 Luckie Street, Atlanta, Ga.




