



He has known "BUDDY" AYERS about 6 or 7 years. AYERS is the young white man who acted as an usher at the funeral of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, without anyone realizing he had no official capacity there.

He judges AYERS to be a very smart but very individual, who he feels will do anyting to gain recognition and who he feels should really AYERS, who possesses great physical strength, has told him he, AYERS, has

), and has used narcotics, however, he himself does not know if this is really so.

About a week after the KING funeral, AYERS dropped by, supposedly to talk of buying a car. AYERS talked in a sympathetic manner towards negroes. He, however, is not certain whether or not AYERS is sincere in this feeling. AYERS claimed he had a contract with a publisher to obtain 26 volume sets of the life and speeches of Dr. KING which AYERS planned to sell at a great profit. It is seriously doubted that AYERS has any such contract.

44-2386 AYERS also shoed him a letter from a Negro minister, written in a very religious tone, in which the ministers itinerary was set out. AYERS said he planned to go to Philadelphia to join with this minister and help him in his work. Mr. ELEY said that because of AYERS he has always been very friendly and compassionate towards AYERS. 
