

Reference is made to the memorandum of SPC ALVIN R. KNOLES dated 4/20/68 in this matter, further identified as Serial #1391.

This memorandum discloses that at 9 P.M., on 4/28/68, an anonymous telephone call was received by SPC KNOLES to the effect that an individual resembling the subject, wearing dark glasses, purchased a newspaper daily from the Crescent and 12th Street area between 5 and 5:30 PM every afternoon. This caller suggested that a "lookout" be maintained over this area each day at that time, and the caller then terminated the call.

An examination of this area discloses that there is no newspaper stand in the area at 12th and Crescent St., nor is a newsboy stationed at that area during that time. This area adjoins a parking lot behind the C & S Bank at 12th and Peachtree and the C & S Bank Drive-In windows, which are located on the southwest corner of 12th and Crescent Streets.

There are no newspaper boxes at 11th and Crescent Streets in view of the fact that Peachtree Street immediately adjacent to that area has a large number of newspaper boxes and a news stand.

It does not appear that further inquiry in this matter is warranted.

Mr. JONES described the car he believed the person to be driving as well as furnishing a physical description of this individual. He also stated that he believed the individual purchased gas on a temporary Pure Oil Credit Card, which he believes expires in August or September, 1968. He also advised that the credit card slips were purchases on April 16, 1968, and had already been forwarded to the Pure Oil Company Retail Department, Palatine, Illinois.

On April 26, 1968, Mr. CLYDE E. PHODES, Accounting Department, Pure Oil Company, Palatine, Illinois, was telephonically contacted by SA RENE J. DUMAINE, at which time he advised that the package of credit card slips mailed in by Mr. JONES on April 17, 1968, would already be in the Balance process, Accounting Department, and would take until at least April 30, 1968, to locate. He said it is possible that he would be able to locate the credit card slips mailed in on April 22, 1968. He requested that he be furnished with the Transmittal Slip number used by JONES in submitting the credit card transactions.

On the same date, Mr. RHODES was furnished with the following transmittal numbers:

4/22/68 - 7-0217997 7-0217998

The foregoing were obtained from the Atlanta Division in contact with Mr. R. B. JONES. Mr. RHODES advised that he had located all of the credit card slips submitted on April 22, 1968. A review of these slips did not reveal any

credit card slips for any transaction on April 16, 1968.

In a continuing review of Pure Oil Company records, in conjunction with Mr. RHODES and THOMAS DAVINI by SA ROBERT F. PEVAHOUSE on April 29 and 30, 1968, located the list of credit card invoices submitted by Mr. Jones on April 18, 1968. Credit card purchase number 0882579109 was made by Lt. Col. WILKERSON, however, the invoice itself could not be located and the address was not yet in file. The charge for credit card number 603-855-3685 is another company credit card and the ticket was already been separated elsewhere. No further effort will be made to locate this card in view of the comments made by Mr. JONES. It should be noted that this review did not reveal any purchase made on a temporary Pure Oil Credit Card.

It was determined that the landlord of 113 14th Street also operates the same type house next door at 107 14th Street, N.E. A check of his records revealed that HAROLD LOYD rented room number 6 at 107 14th Street, N.E., for the week starting March 18, 1968, and for the week starting March 25, 1968. He listed his home address as 571 Conquet Street, Macon, Georgia.

On April 16, 1968, SA JOHN H. BRANDT attempted to locate HAROLD LOYD at 571 Conquet Street, Macon, Georgia, and determined that this is a fictitious address. A review of the City Directory for Macon, Georgia, revealed one HAROLD A. LOYD, an employee of the Sign Maintenance Company, 680 Law Street, N.W., Atlanta, Georgia.

HAROLD LOYD, \$642 Least Yale Street, College Park, Georgia, was contacted at his place of employment, Sign Maintenance Company, 680 Law Street, N.W., Atlanta, by SAS TRAVIS L. LYNCH and MARION E. CHEEK on April 17, 1968, and he furnished the following information:

LOYD was moving to Atlanta from Macon, Georgia, around March 18, 1968, and he rented room number 6 at 107 14th Street, N.W., Atlanta, for a week, beginning March 18, 1968, and paid a week's rent on that date. He only stayed in the room at night to sleep and he was there from Monday night, March 18, 1968, until Saturday night, March 23, 1968. He did not stay ground his room during the daytime, and merely used the room to sleep until he could find a permanent residence in the Atlanta area. He did not return to the room, and he did not pay rent for the week of March 28, 1968.

Mr. LOYD's room was on the decond 2100 at 107 14th Street, N.E. He met none of the residents in that building or the building next door during the period of time he was there, except a large, heavy-set man who rented a back room, whom he spoke to on one occasion. He did not learn this man's

name. On another occasion, at night, someone came into the building looking for another individual whom LOYD did not know.

Mr. LOYD observed photographs of ERIC S. GALT and advised he has observed no one resembling GALT and he definitely did not observe anyone resembling GALT at 107 14th Street or in that vicinity, and he knows that the two individuals he saw while residing at 107 14th Street were not identical with GALT.

Mr. LOYD listed his permanent address when he registered at 107 14th Street as his mother's address at 571 Conquet or Colquit (phonetic), Macon, Georgia. He is not sure of the name of the street where his mother regides because she recently moved there from 1179 Boulevard, Macon, Georgia.

Mr. LOYD offered his cooperation and advised that in the event he observes anyone resembling GALT he would immediately notify the FBI Office in Atlanta.

During this interview he was again questioned concerning the one million dollar bounty ", " KK of the south" and the " Southern Businessmens association " that he was quoated as saying on the national TV. He stated that by KK he did not mean the klan but either Kennedy & King or Kill King was his understanding of these initials when he heard them in prison.
