PAUL ALVIN LAIL was informed of the identities of the interviewing agents and the nature of this interview.

LAIL advised he is presently living at 34 Barbados Drive, Palm Springs, with his wife BETTY and five month old baby.

LAIL stated he had been an immate in the Missouri State Penitentiary for three years and while confined there he had met and known JAMES RARL RAY. He stated he was not very close or friendly with RAY but he did eat with him a number of times when he was in the kitchem visiting with his friend, LEWIE "WHITEY" DOWDA. He said he also watched a number of ball games and television programs with RAY.

LAIL described RAY as being a guy who knew his way around but was not one of the wheels or leaders in prison; that RAY was a sharp intelligent guy who hung around with the boys who were always up to something and were in on all of the deals. LAIL advised RAY never seemed to have a lot of money but always seemed to have enough to get whatever he wanted.

LAIL said most of the guys (he cannot recall their mames) that he, RAY, was with most of the time were on dope and were peddling it.

LAIL continued by saying that RAY's big buddy was NEAL ABBEY who was a "big wheel" and the guy who ran the prison kitchen with "an iron hand." LAIL stated ABBEY was the guy who got RAY into the kitchen which was a good deal (job).

LAIL advised that LEO BARNETT handled dope and peddled it in the Missouri State Penitentiary and he believes he is now in prison somewhere in Florida. He said that BARNETT would know for certain if RAY bud been on dope and where and who he got the dope from.

LAIL further advised that FRED MILLER, "a cut and dried com," who worked in the tag plant of the prison, was one of the leaders and knew RAY well and he might be able to furnish information about him if he would talk to the FBI.

LAIL related that WHITEY DOWDA also knew RAY pretty well and would know more about him than he did since they both worked in the kitchen together for quite a while. He said WHITEY had been living in Merietta, Georgia, and he recently heard that WHITEY is now in jail in Merietta on a robbery charge.

LAIL stated there had been trouble with some of the Negro prisoners in the Missouri State Penitentiary who were Black Muslims so some of the prisoners decided to teach them a lesson and three or four of the Negro leaders were killed. LAIL stated he did not know if RAY was in on the actual killing, but he was close with the ones that did it and therefore could have been in on the killing or at least he knew who did kill the Negroes.

LAIL would not make any further statements about the killing of the Hegroes in the Missouri State Penitentiary and he stated he could not furnish any manes or identities but he did say there were ten immates who were in on the killing of the Negroes.

LAIL said he could not recall RAY saying too much about Negroes and he does not believe from his conversations with RAY that he, RAY, was a racist, however, all of the immates in the Missouri State Penitentiary did not like the Negroes because of their belligerent attitude and amimosity toward the white immates.

LAIL stated RAY liked to wear his hair short in the summer months and long in the winter. He said RAY used to have a "butch" out in the summer months. **4** 43 9 0

LAIL stated from his association with RAY that he felt RAY would have a .45 automatic "stashed" on his person somewhere and he would not give up or be taken without a fight. LAIL said RAY is a "killer" in his opinion and that RAY would not by easy to catch or find. LAIL said RAY is "a city boy" and he does not figure him to be hiding out in the country. However, LAIL stated he would not figure RAY would hide out in a really big city like New York, but would pick one about the size of Houston, Texas.

LAIL said he could not recall RAY telling him or mentioning any place in particular he, RAY, always wanted to go to or visit, but he felt RAY would be in a warm climate rather than a cold one.

LAIL stated he had not been contacted or heard from RAY since he got out of the Missouri State Penitentiary over two years ago and to the best of his knowledge RAY would not know where or how to contact him.

LAIL advised be had visited WHITEY DOWDA in March, 1968, in WHITEY's home in Merietta, Georgia, for a few days. He said that WHITEY is his best friend.

LAIL continued by saying he recognized the name of SCHAFFER and he thinks SCHAFFER was a captain in the prison guard force, but he did not know him and/or if SCHAFFER peddled dope in the pen.

LAIL stated he felt that there was a possibility RAY's escape was engineered by and assisted by outside help but he did not have any knowledge about it. Also he stated just about anything is possible with outside help and money, however, escape from the Missouri State Penitentiary is something else and is just about impossible in his opinion.

LAIL stated he did not feel badly about MARTIN LUTHER KING getting killed, but he was sorry it happened in Memphis, Temmessee, and he would have rather seem KING killed im some Northern city. LAIL said he is a southerner and his feelings are Southern.

LAIL stated that he is of course interested in the reward money and he could certainly use it. However, he said he really does not know if he would turn RAY in or not for the reward money if he had the opportunity. LAIL stated he was certain RAY did the killing of KING himself and not involved with anyone else. LAIL stated that he wanted to be honest with the FBI and he would have to think about this a couple of days as to whether or not he would or would not turn RAY in if he knew his possible or current whereabouts.

LAIL stated he really does not know where RAY is and he said that RAY had not contacted him and he had not seen RAY for over two years.

IAIL continued by saying he was a little surprised when he learned from the newspaper and television that RAY had been identified as KING's killer because he always figured RAY as being a guy that would be too smart to leave any clues or evidence around so that the police or the FBI would be able to trace and/or identify him.

LAIL examined the photographs of RAY and said he would never recognize him with the tuxedo and bow tie outfit on and further he said he never saw RAY with his hair long as it is either. However, he said the guy with the bow tie and tuxedo on is RAY. MN 44-1854 5

LAIL said after thinking it over that he is very interested in the money and if he thinks of anything or comes up with anything concerning RAY, he will contact either Special Agent PATRICK A, PHILBIN or ROBERT W. WISHMAN.

Abernathy Fears Rights Conspiracy

By MARGARET HURST

The assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. may be part of a conspiracy in this country to defeat the civil rights movement by killing off its leaders, the Rev. Ralph Abernathy said Wednesday.

"The grave concern on my "certainly hope it would not be part is the fact that there may be a conspiracy in this country to actually defeat our movement - defeat the thrust - by picking off our leaders one by one or three by three as the case may be," Dr. King's successor said at a press briefing on plans for the poor people's campaign in Washington,

The Rev. Mr. Abernathy said he is not as concerned about the "person or persons who pulled the trigger" as he is about the climate "that made this killer feel he was on a divine mission. or carrying out the will of a majority of the people.

He added, however, that "we're going to do our job" and leave it up to the law enforcement agencies to apprehend the assassia. The job, he said, will be to mobilize the Washington march in order to prove that you may kill the dreamer but you may not kill the dream."

The Rev. Mr. Abernathy met with newsmen before going into a meeting with members of the board of directors of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, the organization founded by Dr. King.

Answering a question, the Rev. Mr. Abernathy said he had no objection to white persons marching on Washington as proposed recently by Whitney Young of the National Urban

He said, however, that he is against separatism and would a pure Lily-white march."

Since the poor people's march is already planned, he added. "I think it would be a waste of time to launch a white people's march. I think they should join

The plans for the march on Washington, the Rev. Mr. Abernathy said, were completed last weekend.

The campaign will begin with a May I rally in Memphis where Dr. King was killed. In Memphis, the Rev. Mr. Abernathy said he will place a gold star on the spot where Dr. King fell and then will lead a massive memorial service. The following day the Memphis group will march for two days to Marks, Miss.

Marks, a town "in the poorest county in the United States," is the place "where I saw Dr. King weep for the last time,' the Rev. Mr. Abernathy said.

The Southern caravan, one of nine, is scheduled to begin May 6. It will include a mule train loaded with poor families and a freedom train.

The freedom train will arrive in Washington May 13 when the Rev. Mr. Abernathy will drive the first nail to start a shanty-

town. The location of the shanty town has not been selected, the Rev. Mr. Abernathy said.

All of the caravans, including some 3,000 people, are expected to arrive in Washington before May 20-the day of the first nonviolent demonstration, he said.

He said cities will be expected to help provide transportation for the caravans as they move across the country.

"I am sure the cities will be glad to help us because we intend to stay only one night, but if they can't help us (with transportation) we'll just have to stay."

Hosea Williams, director of mobilization for the campaign, said that if the country has not responded to the demands of the poor people by May 30 that the Rev. Mr. Abernathy will put out a national call to "all people of good will" to join the protest.

He said the demonstration at that point "may or may not" be called civil disobedience.

Dr. Abernathy said he meeting with representatives of different ethnic groups this weekend to determine what the campaign demands will be, but a guaranteed income for all and jobs for all who are emplayable will be included.

The Rev. Mr. Abarnathy and some 100 representatives of the poor will present an "economic bill of rights" to congressional leaders and cabinet members next Morday before he returns to launch the caravans from the different sections of the coun-



The following investigation was conducted by SA's James Richard Flick and Joseph G. Shea:

SA ROGER L. KAAS telephonically advised on this date that two men had rented Volkswagons at a Rent A Car Agency, Atlanta, Georgia, and that SA D. F. Tackitt had displayed the pictures of JAMES EARL RAY to the Rent A Car Agency people involved and they firmly believed that one of the individuals resembled closely RAY. KAAS stated that the individuals renting the Volkswagons were an East Indian named ALI DOWLATY and JOHN MICHAEL JEWUSIAK both of whom had California identification papers in their possession. The two men rented Volkswagons described as 1967 Blue, bearing '68 Ga., license 1 D 38123 and a 1968 White, bearing 1968 Ga., license 1 D 1911h. They gave their current address as Thunderbird Motel, 545 S. 4 Lane Highway, Marietta, Ga. JEWUSIAK was the man whom the car rental agency said resembled RAY.

MR. THOMAS JENKINS, Clerk, Thunderbird Motel, 545 So. 4 Lane Hwy., Marietta, Ga., advised that one JOE DOWLATY, 1406 South Del Mar, San Gabriel, California, had registered at the motel on 4-24-68 and indicated a stay of two weeks. DOWLATY was assigned room 25 and according to JENKINS was very dark complexion and most likely was an East Indian. He stated that DOWLATY was not at the motel at present and had indicated when he signed in that he is associated with the TACO BELL Mexican Restaurant being built on Roswell St., Marietta, Ga. JENKINS advised that DOWLATY is driving a white, two floor sedan, make and license not known.

MOHAMMID ALI DOWIATY was located at the TACO BELL Mexican Restaurant now under construction at 698 Roswell Street, Marietta, Ga. Both Volkswagons described above and with the same license numbers were parked on the TACO BELL property. DOWLATY advised that he is the Field Consultant for the TACO BELL restaurants with headquarters at 2424 Moreton St., Torrence, California. He stated that he uses the first name JOE because his real name is hard to pronounce, write and because JOE simplifies his business relationships. DOWLATY advised that he is staying at the Thunderbird Motel, Marietta, Ga., room 25, and expects to be in this area for two weeks. He stated that JOHN MICHAEL JEWUSIAK is the owner of the franchise for the TACO BELL Restaurant under construction at this address.





JOHN MICHAEL JEWUSIAK was interviewed and advised that he presently resides at 347A Lake Drive, Marietta, Georgia, no phone with DAVID BOX, who is to manage the TACO BELL at 698 Roswell Street., Marietta, upon its completion. JEWUSIAK advised that he purchased the franchise for the TACO BELL Restaurant in December 1966 and is therefore the owner of the restaurant being constructed at this address. The following physical description and background information was obtained during interview:

JOHN MICHAEL JEWUSIAK 6732 Rinconada Drive.. Dr. King said he had never before spoke to such an ethnic group of people). This man bears a striking resembelance to the sketch of the assassin which has been published in the papers.

I have never written a letter like this before so please don't jump to the conclusion that it is a "crank letter". I and may husband feel very strongly about this that the man shown at 7:04 during the PBL program. Please, please review this tape again and see for yourself."

NYO reviewed the overall film on questioned broadcast with PBL and is enlosing three excerpts from film to Atlanta, depicting person referred to in above letter so that similar investigation through appropriate officials of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC) as previously requested in referenced airtel, can be conducted in order to identify this person for elimination purposes concerning subject JAMES EARL RAY.

Also enclosed for New Haven and Memphis are three photographs developed from questioned television tape.

It is further noted that the questioned film was taken on 3/14/68, at Paschal's Motel, on Hunter Street in Atlanta.

For information of Atlanta, enclosed excerpts from film were taken from a group discussion of people during which time MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., addressed the group, along with others.

The entire film relative to the broadcast by PBL which appeared on TV in various parts of the country on April 7 and 4/9/68, has been viewed by the NYO. Since the broadcast is on Video tape and quite lengthly with only a very limited portion involving the two men pointed out as look-a-likes to "sketches" of the assassin of KING, the tapes were not obtained from PBL. They are available in further needed.

NYO is conducting no further investigation relative to the PBL Broadcast.

Mr. MOORE stated he felt a person capable of this would be WALLACE ALLEN, who runs an advertising agency in Atlanta. He stated ALLEN had been mixed up in the bombing of the Temple in 1958, that he lived beyond his income in a secluded area. Mr. MOORE also stated he recently ascertained that ALLEN had a "hot line" telephone installed at his home, telephone number 255-7120. Mr. MOORE also determined that several years ago a newspaper reporter from Birmingham wrote an article indicating that a crippled man with Klan connections from Atlanta is believed to be the perpetrator of the bombing of the Baptist Church in Birmingham in which four childrenwere killed. Mr. MOORE indicated this fits the description of ALLEN.

It is noted the articles concerning the Birmingham bombing and crippled man in Atlanta with Klan connections was actually referring to J. B. STONER.

Her brother, LEWIE, never mentioned the subject by his true name or any known aliases and she viewed the photograph of subject with negative results.

The friends of her brother are "Red" (LNU) and "Red's" wife (name unknown), who came to Marietta with their young child and visited with LEWIE not too long ago. "Red" had served time with LEWIE, probably in the Missouri State Penitentiary. During the time that "Red" was in Marietta with his family, "Red" obtained employment with an Atlanta firm engaged in the sign construction business. She has no information as to the whereabouts of "Red" or his family.

Another friend of her brother's was "Dink" (LNU). Her brother went to Missouri (city not known) for some unknown reason and when he returned, he was accompanied by "Dink." She has no information as to whether "Dink" was a rap partner of LEWIE's or how their friendship developed. Dink's whereabouts is unknown to her.

Another friend of LEWIE's was a "Cheyenne" (LNU), who was from either Sanford or Orlando, Florida. "Cheyenne" came with LEWIE from Florida to Marietta in about 1962 and apparently went to California with LEWIE. On their return to Georgia, they got in trouble in Missouri, which resulted in the incarceration of her brother on some felony charge there. She has heard "Cheyenne" has subsequently died. 44-2386-4936

She has no information as to any other friends of LEWIE's.

She recalls that her brother took a bible course while at the Missouri State Penitentiary. His racial views have always been moderate and he belongs to no organizations of which she is aware.

On 4/26/68, TOM DURRETT, owner Royal Tire Service, 639 Powder Springs Street, Marietta, advised that an individual known to him as "Dink" was employed by him under the name BILLY DINK CHUMLEY, who listed his address as 236 Gramling Street, Marietta, Georgia. The employment records relating to CHUMLEY reflect he listed his Social Security No. as and his date of birth as The records further reflect that CHUMLEY was employed from 4/15/67 to 8/11/67, and DURRETT described him as being a white male, 5' 11", 200 - 210 pounds, thinning grayish-brown hair, medium to rough complexion and having no upper teeth.

DURRETT reported that CHUMLEN was from Oklahoma City and apparently left Oklahoma City because of marital problems.

DURRETT advised he has no information as to CHUMLEY's whereabouts but recalled that some two to three months ago CHUMLEY called from somewhere in Atlanta while passing through. CHUMLEY was looking for employment and inquired of DURRETT as to whether he would be a reference for him in seeking employment at the American Tire Co., Atlanta, Georgia.



WATERS was asked if he recalled a white Mustang which may have been parked at the rear of 107 14th Street or 113 14th Street, and he stated he recalled this car well since the owner of this car always parked in such a manner he would use up about three parking spots. WATERS stated there was a shallow ditch between the parking areas at the rear of 107 14th Street and 113 14th Street, and the individual who drove this white Mustang generally parked at the rear of 113 14th Street parallel to this ditch rather than heading into the ditch and In this manner utilized about three parking spots. WATERS said this irritated him since parking space was so short and he would have mentioned it to Mr. GARNER, but GARNER was sick at the time and he did not bother him with it. WATERS said if he had ever seen the driver of this white Mustang, he would have mentioned it to him directly, but he had never seen the driver of this Mustang. He stated he knew there was anout of state plate on this car, but did not recall the state and said it might have been white with black letters. WATERS said he always checked license plates of strange cars parked behind these two houses since roomers generally have out of state cars and local license plates generally belong to people who have no business parking in this area. For that reason he was able to recall that this white Mustang had an out of state license plate on it!

WATERS was asked at what time of the day he generally recalled this car being parked at the rear of 113 14th Street and he said he was only aware of it at the times when he returned from work about 5:00 p.m. He estimated that this car was in this area for about 2 weeks and he believes it was about 2 weeks since he had last seen this car.

WATERS was unable to identify anyone in the neighborhood by description or artist's composite photograph who might have been identical with the individual believed to have used the name GALT.

DOUGLAS MICHAEL HILL, who rents room number 11 at 107 - 14th Street, Atlanta, was located and interviewed at his place of employment, Thompson, Boland and Lee, Incorporated, 201 Peachtree Street, Northeast, Atlanta.

HILL advised that he had rested room number 11 from Mr. GARNER approximately March 21, 1968 and although he is still paying rent on this room, he does not always return to this room at night. It was HILL's recollection that he returned to this room nightly for the period from March 21, 1968 through March 29, 1968 and only intermittently since that time. HILL was shown a photograph of the individual who had rented room number 2 at 113 - 14th Street under the name of GALT on March 24, 1968, and HILL advised he could not recall ever seeing this individual in the neighborhood.

HILL further advised that he had no recollection of ever seeing a white Mustang parked at the rear of either 107 - 14th Street or 113 - 14th Street during the period that he has rented a room at 107 - 14th Street nor has he ever heard the name GALT while residing there.

HILL said that with the exception of Mr. GARNER, he has not become acquainted with any other roomer at either 107 - 14th Street or 113 - 14th Street.



LAWSON, aka J. Lint Lawson, Route 2, Avery Community, Canton, Ga. SEEG stated upon viewing the photograph of both subjects GALT and RAY, that this definitely was not J. LINT LAWSON, who is a highly regarded member of the Canton community.

On the same date, SEEG stated that JAMES P. CANNON, 100 Hill Top Drive, Canton, Ga., was also well known to her. She stated that CANNON is employed by the Concord Rubber Company, Cherry Hill, New Jersey, as a traveling salesman. SEEG stated that CANNON is frequently on the road traveling and spends a good deal of his time out of town.

SEEG continued CANNON was well thought of in this community and again stated, upon viewing photographs of RAY and GALT, that CANNON bore no resemblance whatsoever to these subjects.
