On 4/25/68, Chief of Police GEORGE PEARSON, Hapeville PD, and Dets. JIM CLAY and JACK GRANT advised that Old Hwy. 41 is now known as Central Ave. All of these individuals said they had never heard of a JOHNSON Grocery Store. They further advised there is no Robinson St. in Hapeville. Physical observation of Central Ave. throughout Hapeville failed to disclose any Johnson Grocery. A Robinson St. was finally located in the Mountain View area, and it is noted that this is a dirt street in the Negro section. The homes along this street are not numbered and repeated inquiries failed to locate anyone on the street named JOHN DORE.

On 5/7/68, a general merchandise store and Citco Gas Station were located on Old Hwy. 41 but well south of Forest Park, Ga. The owner was interviewed and he advised he had never heard of any other JOHNSON Grocery Store on Old Hwy. 41. He said he is not acquainted with a JOHN DORE nor with anyone named JOHN WILLARD. He said he has no recollection of anyone ever attempting to cash a \$400 or \$500-dollar check in his store. He said he is not acquainted with anyone driving a new Mustang with Alabama license plates and is positive that no one had ever asked him about an alleged individual using a driver's license with the name JOHN WILLARD on it.

JIMMIE DELTON GARMER, 107 - 14th Street, N.E., Atlanta, was interviewed at his place of business, 1052 Northside Drive, N.W.

GARNER specifically was asked regarding any discussions he may recall with the man whom he knew as ERIC S. GALT concerning drugs and/or narcotics. GARNER replied that he could recall no conversation with "GALT" concerning these matters and can recall nothing to indicate GLT was using drugs or narcotics.

GARNER also was asked specifically whether he recalled any conversation with "GALT" concerning racial matters. GARNER said he cannot recall any such conversation.

GARNER reiterated information previously furnished that the only conversation with GALT was the one on March 31, 1968, at which time he was paid for an additional week's rent. He again stated he is positive he did not encounter "GALT" at 113 - 14th Street, N.E., on Friday, April 5, 1968, when he GARNER, went to that address to remove the dirty linear to be given to the laundry man.

GARNER said FERRY LEE ZACKERY, the cook at Garner's Cafeteria, and another employee at the cafeteria, went to the rooming houses on 14th Street on the afternoon of April 5, 1968, to make up the beds. He cannot recall the identity of the woman who accompanied ZACKERY, but knows only it was a Negro female whom he had picked up to work in the restaurant as a dishwasher. He noted that during the past several weeks, he has had numerous different women working at the restaurant, and cannot specifically recall which one was working on April 5, 1968. He suggested that EDMA JACKSON, who resides at 646 Whitaker Street, might have been the woman who accompanied PERRY ZACKERY to clean the rooming houses on April 5, 1968.

James Earl Ray, (Eric Starvo Galt), Depicted As Mean Kidln Mean Times

The accused killer of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., James Earl Ray, alias Eric Starvo Galt, grewupa mean kid in mean times.

Five Life Magazine reporters depicted him as such in a recent article dealing with the wanted man,

The reporters, all former newspapermen, spenta grueling week on the trail of Ray and his family.

They traced the Rays across Illinois and Missouri and heard many times of the family that lived "out there on the side of that hill without enough to eat."

His troubled life began early. Ray was not a conforming child, according to the reporters. He missed from 25 to 30 per cent of each school year that he attended. He quit school when he was 16. In school he was described as a rebel.

Ray was the oldest of sine children. He was born in ALton, III., Mar. 10, 1928.

His second grade school record seemed to begin a long list of rebel ways.

In Ewing, Mo., where Ray spent most of his childhood, the school principal reflected his attitude on Ray's

school record.

"Attitude toward regulations... violates all of them; honesty-needs watching; appearance... repulsive; courtesy... seldom if ever polite.

His post-school life was described by Life writers as "one head - on encounter with cops after another."

They describe two incidents where that just seemed to be working against him,

Ray had robbed a Chicago cabbie of \$11 in 1952. Trying to escape, he had run into a deadend alley; he was shot in the arms and tell through a basement window.

After his release in 1954, Ray tried to rob a dry cleaner's in East Alton, Ill. This time he lost his shoes breaking out through the front window.

Police had disabled his geta. way car so Ray ran five miles home in badly cut stocking feet. He was arrested anyway.

From a grocery store and dry cleaner's bandit to the most hunted man in the country, Ray spent a spell of time living high with "a roll of 20s and an assumed name."

James Earl Ray, say the Life

writers, never made the big time. He was described as "innocuous" and "penny ante."

Life depicts him as slight and round-shouldered, a man who flinched, smiled a croked, private grin and sometimes even seemed to walk on a slant. The story concludes:

"But, says the FBI, on April 4 in Memphis, at the moment Martin Luther Kind died, all the bills for the Mustang automobile, shoes, dancing lessons and a \$15,030.06 Remington—and maybe the bitter childhood—came due."





LATENT FINGERPRINTS

The following investigation was conducted by SA MARION E. CHEEK:

Chief of Police ED FRIEND, Albany Police Department, and Assistant Chief LESLIE SUMMERFORD, In Charge of the Detective Bureau at Albany, Georgia, as well as Deputy Sheriff J. A. MC DONALD, Dougherty County Sheriff's Office, were contacted May 1, 1968, and requested to search any unidentified latent prints they might have in unsolved cases since April of 1967 against the fingerprints of JAMES EARL RAY as they appear on Identification Order 4182. All advised they would do so.

On May 2, 1968, Georgia Bureau of Investigation (GBI) Agent JAMES T. CAWTHON, assigned at Perry, Georgia, and covering Dooly County, Georgia; Sheriff H. C. JOHNSON, Dooly County Sheriff's Office; Chief of Police LOUIS JOBE, Cordele, Georgia, Police Department; and Sheriff EARL E. POSEY, Crisp County Sheriff's Office, were likewise requested to search any unidentified latents they might have in unsolved cases since April of 1967 against the fingerprints of JAMES EARL RAY. They agreed to do so.

AARON BINNER HOLCOMB was contacted in front of the White Front Market, 415 Memorial Drive, S.E., and was made aware of the identity of the interviewing Agent. HOLCOMB was presented a standard warning and waiver of rights form which he read, stated he understood, but refused to sign. HOLCOMB was advised he was being contacted with regard to his knowledge of the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTIMER KING, JR., in Memphis Tennessee, on April 4, 1968. He then furnished the following information:

On April 4, 1968, he was released from the Fulton County Jail at approximately 9:30 A.M. He said he then left for Memphis shortly thereafter in a car with his friend. HOLCOMB declined to give his friend's name or address, but stated his friend is living with him and the car was owned by this friend. HOLCOMB advised he was in the vicinity of the hotel where KING was shot.

At this point, HOLCOMB was asked for particular details. He declined to furnish any and asked if the FBI had proved that JAMES EARL RAY actually did it. Without waiting for an answer, he stated he knew where RAY was. When asked where, he replied Mexico, and stated he knew exactly where in Mexico, but that RAY was then planning to go to Cuba. HOLCOMB would not elaborate any further on this subject and would not disclose any information pertinent to RAY's exact whereabouts, nor his source or sources of information. He simply stated he wanted the FBI to "sweat it out" looking for RAY and that when the FBI found RAY, HOLCOMB would give in and furnish all the information he has. He explained that he did not want to disclose any of the information at this time because it would get him involved in it. He stated that the only way he could be made to furnish this information was to be arrested, and in order for the FBI to do this, it would need some evidence linking him to the crime. HOLCOMB advised that until the time RAY is caught, dead or alive, or until the tire the FBI links him to the crime, he would say nothing else about it.

HOLCOMB stated that on the day the FBI recovered the white Mustang at a Capitol Homes parking lot, he was in the area and admitted telling some residents he had some knowledge of the KING slaying. He denied ever telling them that he had received \$100,000 to help the assassin get away, explaining that these residents of Capitol Homes always twist a story around to make it more interesting. He then advised there were actually two Mustangs in Memphis involved in the assassination; one was the white Mustang recovered and the other was a black Mustang. When advised that previous interviews revealed that he had told several residents that the Mustang the FBI was looking for was a white one with a red racing stripe on the rear deck, he denied ever saying it and refused to talk about it anymore.

HOLCOMB then stated he was currently on 12 months State probation and had to report to his probation officer every Friday. He stated under the conditions of his probation, he was not to leave the State of Georgia. When advised that he had just told the interviewing Agent he was in Memphis on the first day of his probation, he stated "Sure, I told you, and I was there, but you don't think I'd tell the probation officer, do you?"

HOLCOMB further advised he really had no concern for any law enforcement officials, and stated he felt that way because the Atlanta Police Department once tried to get him to join the force. He said he could not be a law enforcement officer of any sort, because he breaks the law every day "by drinking and other things."

When asked if he were directly involved in the slaying of KING, HOLCOMB refused to answer the question and said to get the evidence first. He stated he himself would have killed KING if someone else hadn't because "they were making too much of a fuss over King and they didn't do it over President Kennedy." He explained the "they" included the press and everyone in the nation, except a few.

HOLCOMB stated he had been in Texas since the assassination of President MENTEDY and he had heard of information relative to the assassination that the FBI does not know. He declined to elaborate on this topic any further.

When advised that his stories have many conflicts, and that they were hard to believe, HOLCOMB replied that he was furnishing contradictions for the purpose of confusion and that he did not want to tell the entire incident as he saw it at this time.

HOLCOMB stated he goes by the name "CURLY" and that all a person has to do is come to the area of Cherokee Avenue and ask for "CURLY" and they would know him. He further advised he is currently working for a contractor who sub-contracts for the Gas Company. He then produced a check stub showing date of April 24, 1968, which indicated that the check for approximately \$14.10 was for the period ending April 23, 1963, and for 82 hours work. The check stub bore the name of R. J. Reid Contracting Company and had the name A. B. EOLCOMB written in ink on the stub. HOLCOMB further advised that he was presently thinking of leaving that company, but had no idea where he was going to work. He refused to give his exact address, except that it was on Cherokee Avenue. When asked how he could possibly be contacted if his help were needed, he stated he would only talk to the FBI in front of the White Front Market and that he could be reached at telephone number 523-3750, which is the number at his rooming house, which is unlisted. HOLCOMB instructed that if he were not home, the Agent could leave a message with his frien! who would get it to him.

HOLCOMB added that his mother, Mrs. WELCHEL and his father, JOHN HOLCOMB, are separated, but they both know his residence. When advised that contact with them failed to reveal his address, he said he had instructed them never to give it to anyone.

HOLCOMB then refused to give any further information concerning himself.

. When again reminded that he should not withheld any information, he repeated he wanted the FBI to "me on! it out."
