



On the evening of 5/6/68, Mr. FRANK A. HOLLOWAY, 1266 Gordon Road, called the Atlanta Office to advise he had some data with regard to the possible identification of JAMES EARL RAY. Mr. HOLLOWAY requested that he be contacted.

Mr. HOLLOWAY was telephonically contacted by writer and arrangements were made to interview him the following morning.

On 5/7/68, SAS HARRY L. LEE and KENNETH R. HEINEMAN interviewed Mr. HOLLOWAY at the Southern Railroad Building, Room 806, where he is employed in the Ticket Department. He advised on the previous evening he was an Atlanta Transit Co. Bus No. 10, which he caught in the Five Points area enroute to his home when he noticed an individual, who was accompanied by a woman sitting across the isle from him, He is described as white male, approximately 35 to 40 years of age, 5' 9", 180 - 190 pounds, with auburn hair and impressed Mr. HOLLOWAY as resembling subject RAY. HOLLOWAY explained this individual and the woman he was with were not married and when pressed for his reason for making this statement, Mr. HOLLOWAY said any married individual could always tell when another couple was not married. He would not elaborate.

Mr. HOLLOWAY then said that the individual was carrying a small suitcase and he "twitched" or jerked at the handle continuously throughout the ride. Mr. HOLLOWAY said he read in Life Magazine that JAMES EARL RAY had some kind of twitch or jerk when meeting persons and he thought this was also significant.

The most recent of RAY was displayed to Mr. HOLLOWAY who immediately said that was not the man. HOLLOWAY did say then that the photo he saw in the newspaper did resemble the man on the bus. HOLLOWAY further described this man as having auburn hair which was wavy and he said he would, therefore, assume that this individual might have been wearing a wig inasmuch as this particular aspect of his physical description did not match that of RAY. HOLLOWAY described the woman with this man as somewhat older than the man, approximately the same height and he believed she was also wearing a wig. He advised she had a very rough, bad complexion.

HOLLOWAY advised these two individuals got off the bus on the south side of Gordon Street, near Brady Street, and crossed heading toward the tavern in that area.

It would not appear that further inquiry in this regard is warranted. It is pointed out that HOLLOWAY positively stated that the most recent photo of RAY was not the same individual on the bus.

On 4/29/68, Mrs. ANNETTE CLAY, 928 Washington Street, Apt. 8, Atlanta, was interviewed at her place of employment, Lithonia Lighting Co., Conyers, Ga., at which time she stated that on two separate occasions, 4/15/68 and 4/24/68, she was driving out Interstate 20 east, as she does every morning, and a man driving a pickup truck was following her. Each time she noticed him she first saw him just east of Moreland Avenue, and he followed her off at the second Flat Shoals Road Exit. He even followed her into a shopping center parking lot where she waits to meet her ride into work. On each occasion the man wore glasses and stayed right on the tail of her car waving at her and smiling. She would try to speed up and slow down, but he would stay right with her. Mrs. CLAY said she gets on the expressway at the Capitol Avenue entrance at 6:50 A.M. every morning. She said she thought the man was waving at her because he had his arm across the seat of the truck and was bobbing his hand up and down. She said he was not looking at her but just waving, but would look at her when he came up beside her car.

Mrs. CLAY described the truck as a white 1956 Chevrolet pick-up truck, with the tailgate painted brown, bearing 1968 Ga. license 38-1320. She described the man as a 36-year-old white male with a fat face and reddish hair combed straight back. His build looked broad and heavy and he wore a short-sleeve white shirt and no hat. She has never seen him before nor has

she seen him since the last time he followed her. When shown a photo of subject RAY, she stated she thought he looked something like the man who was following her, but she certainly could not positively identify him as such.

On the same date, it was determined from the Ga. Department of Public Safety, GSP, Atlanta, that JAMES L. GEORGE, 206 Adams St., Covington, is subscriber to Ga. Drivers License 0-040692, reflecting that Mr. GEORGE's DOB is that he is 5' 6", 145 pounds, has brown hair worn in a crew cut and gray eyes. It is noted that the photo of GEORGE on the drivers license is not at all identical with the photo of JAMES EARL RAY, subject.

It is recommended no further action be taken with regard to Mrs. CLAYs complaint.

On 5/2/68, the writer went to 3150 Meadowsod Lane Chamble, Ga., and observed that there was no one home at that address, but that the name ROBERT J. MILLER was on the mailbox. In order to gain information concerning MILLER, the next door neighbor, Mrs. NANCY COUCH, 3156 Meadowood Lane, was contacted. Mrs. COUCH advised ROBERT J. MILLER moved from the house next door approximately three months ago and sold the house, which is now being rented to another party. She stated Mr. MILLER operated Alkon Products, Inc., as a business out of his home and was a salesman for that business. She stated MILLER lied in that house for about three years and drove a blue Mustang. It is her understanding that

Mr. MILLER left Atlanta because he was transferred to the New York Office of the company. Mrs. COUCH described MILLER as being 6' 1"; well over 200 pounds; heavy, fleshy build and when shown photo of subject RAY, she stated MILLER bears no resemblance whatsoever to that photo. She stated MILLER has a wife and two children.

It is recommended no further action be taken with regard to ROBERT J. MILLER.

The following investigation was conducted by SAs TRAVIS L. LYNCH and MARION E. CHEEK on April 18, 1968, to ascertain if the resident of Apartment 5, 175 Olympic Place, Decatur, Georgia, was identical with ERIC STARVO GALT:

Efforts to locate Mr. W.C. LEE, 3754 Wieuca Road, Atlanta, Georgia, owner of the apartment building at 165 Olympic Place, Decatur, Georgia, met with negative results.

Observation revealed that 175 Olympic Place, Decatur, Georgia, is an eight-unit apartment building consisting of four units upstairs and four units downstairs. The resident Manager in Apartment 7, name unknown, could not be located.

Mrs. MILLIE DORRIS, Apartment 2, 169 Olympic Place, Decatur, who resides in the building next to 175 Olympic Place, advised the photograph of ERIC S. GALT did not appear familiar to her.

Mrs. GEORGE KELLEY, Apartment 4, 175 Olympic Place, Decatur, furnished the following information:

About two weeks ago a man and his wife moved into Apartment 5, 175 Olympic Place. She does not know their names. Neither of them work. The man's wife remarked to Mrs. KELLEY that they had been in an automobile accident; however, from observation of them she say no indication of injuries. Mrs. KELLEY described the man in apartment 5 as a white male, about 40 years of age, 5 feet 11 inches tall, 165 pounds, dark brown hair worn in a long flattop cut.

Mrs. KELLEY stated this couple drives an older model Ford station wagon, but she has not observed a license plate. Mrs. KELLEY observed a photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT and advised that the man who resides in Apartment 5 bears a strong resemblance to GALT; however, his face appears to be a little thinner.

Mr. MARSH JOHNSON HORNE, JR., Apartment 5, 175 Olympic Place, was contacted at his residence, and observation revealed that Mr. HORNE does resemble the photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT, but that he is not identical with GALT.

HORNE is older than GALT appears, has bad teeth, and has brown hair which is greying. HORNE also has a thinner face than the face depicted of GALT in the photograph. Mr. HORNE furnished the following information:

Mr. HORNE spent several tours of duty in the United States Army and returned to Atlanta after completion of his last tour of duty. He and his wife previously resided at 866 Briarcliff Road, N.E., Atlanta, Georgia, and moved to their present residence on April 1, 1968. He exhibited United States Army Discharge papers reflecting his Army Serial Number as and reflecting that he was in the Army from March 23, 1943, until December 7, 1947; and from April 4, 1956, until April 3, 1959. He also exhibited a marriage certificate, number 37174, dated May 29, 1956, reflecting his marriage at Boston, Massachusetts, to LUCIA SMITH, the daughter of THOMAS H. SMITH and LUCY TRITTY. Mr. HORNE's parents were reflected as MARSH J. HORNE, SR., and LAURA TRERITTA. He also exhibited a Davison's Department Store credit card in his name, bering the address 866 Briarcliff Road, N.E., Atlanta, Georgia, and bearing the numbers 12FD and B-3.

Mr. HORNE advised that he was arrested in 1967 in Atlanta, Georgia, for driving under the influence, was fined and placed on probation, and as a result of his probation being revoked he has served about four months sentence in the Bellwood Prison Camp, Atlanta, Georgia.


