HARRY STREEM, Owner, Vegas Club, 5510 Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles, California, was asked in reference to JAMES EARL RAY, also known as Eric Starvo Galt, if he knew of a middle age belly dancer of Greek descent named "HELENA" and/or a Caucasian female with blond hair named "JERI". STREEM said that he believed he knew of "HELENA". He said if his memory is correct, she used to dance at a night club that specializes in eastern dancing, located on the south side of Sunset Boulevard between La Brea and Fairfax Avenues. He advised that he did not know of any Caucasian female named "JERI", in reference to RAY, also known as, Galt.

He stated that his last bar girl at the Vegas Club was DANA RAVEN, who was recently arrested, approximately two weeks ago. He said prior to arrest she only worked for a few weeks. He described her as a slender, dark Caucasian, female.

STREEM stated that prior to the employment of RAVEN, he employed Barbara (Last Name Unknown), a buxom, blond, Caucasian, female. He said that BARBARA was employed by him for in excess of a year prior to the termination of her employment. STREEM said that subsequent to her employment at the Vegas Club, he thought she was employed at the "Fat Cat" located on Western Avenue.

STREEM stated that LOUIS LOMAX, a Los Angeles television personality, and an unknown Caucasian male with a beard, were in the Vegas Club the same day asking if he knew of "JERI" and "HELENA". He said that he provided to them essentially the same information.

She said that during September, October, November, and December she was working at the "Arabian Nights", a night club in Fresno, California.

VLAHOS said that she does not go to any bars and night clubs east of the Hollywood Freeway, on Hollywood Boulevard. She said to her recollection she has never been to the Sultan Room at the St. Francis Hotel.

MARIA VLAHOS, apartment 302, 640 North Kingsley Drive, Hollywood, California, stated she was the sister of HELENA VLAHOS. She was shown photographs of JAMES EARL RAY. She said the individual in these photographs is familiar to her. She said that she remembers this individual coming into the Fez, 1508 North Vermont Avenue, Los Angeles, California. She said that she works at the Fez as a cocktail waitress and dancer. VLAHOS stated that this individual is familiar to her because of the strange way in which he came into the Fez, walked about and then left. This is unusual for the type of clientele that frequents this night club. She stated that she knows of no other information concerning this individual.

VLAHOS stated that she does not frequent bars east of the Hollywood Freeway, on Hollywood Boulevard. She stated that to the best of her knowledge she has never been to the Sultan Room in the St. Francis Hotel.

MELODY MARGARET O'BRIEN, was interviewed at her residence, 5545 Carlton Way, apartment 202, Los Angeles, at which time she furnished the following information:

When asked if she was acquainted with ERIC STARVO GALT, JAMES EARL RAY, CHARLES J. or CHARLEY STEIN, RITA STEIN, or MARIE MARTIN, who is also known as Marie Dennino and Marie Martinello, she replied that she was not acquainted with any of these individuals. When asked if she was acquainted with a JERI or HELEN, she replied that she was not acquainted with a JERI, but did know a HELEN, whose last name she could not recall, who was a topless dancer at "The Mouse Trap" on Valley Boulevard, Industry, California, at the same time as O'BRIEN. She added that HELEN had formerly been employed as a topless dancer at "The Stairway", 6274 Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles, prior to her employment as a topless dancer at "The Mouse Trap". She stated that HELEN resided on Russell Avenue, Los Angeles, exact address unknown, but in the vicinity of Western Avenue and Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles. HELEN was described by O'BRIEN as:

O'BRIEN advised she knew of no reason why her telephone number, 461-2050, would be written in a telephone booth in the St. Francis Hotel. She related she had never been in the St. Francis Hotel or the Sultan Room, nor did she know anyone residing at the St. Francis Hotel. She related that she was a topless dancer and many of the patrons who come to watch her dance get her name. They thereafter obtained her telephone number from the telephone book or telephone operator as her number is published. She stated she had been told that

her name and telephone number was even written in the men's restroom at the places where she had danced topless. She commented she had danced topless in various places in the Los Angeles area until she terminated her last place of employment the past Saturday, April 20, 1968. She was shown photographs of JAMES EARL RAY at which time she advised she could not recognize the individual depicted in the photographs. She further added that she could not recognize JAMES EARL RAY as an individual who patronized the places where she danced. O'BRIEN stated she did not know anyone who drove a white Mustang with Alabama license plates.

O'BRIEN advised that for a period of about four months ending February 1967, she received a series of telephone calls at her residence which is the number listed above. Each call was placed at approximately 2 a.m. She advised the caller was a male, who she believed to be in his twenties. The caller would ask to meet her. She refused on every occasion and, therefore, did not learn the caller's name or the location from which he was calling. O'BRIEN stated she had notified the Hollywood Division of the Los Angeles Police Department, but telephone calls ceased before any action could be taken.

O'BRIEN advised she had been living with a roommate, MARTIN VILLAIRE, during the past two years and he may have had an acquaintance at the St. Francis Hotel, who placed her telephone number on the wall.

MARTIN EDWARD VILLAIRES, 5545 Carlton Way, apartment 202, Hollywood, was interviewed at his residence at which time he furnished the following information:

MARTIN EDWARD VILLAIRES, advised that he did not know CHARLES J. STEIN, CHARLEY STEIN, RITA STEIN, MARIE MARTIN, also known as Marie Deninno or a girl by the name of JERI. VILLAIRES advised that he did not know JAMES EARL RAY or ERIC STARVO GALT nor did he recognize a photo of RAY as an associate of his.

VILLAIRES stated he did know a HELEN that had worked at a bar with MELODY O'BRIEN about one year ago. He advised that HELEN was a topless "Go-Go" dancer, who he described as:

VILLAIRES stated that he had seen a picture of HELEN in a "Nudie" magazine. VILLAIRES did not know HELEN's last name.

VILLAIRES advised that he did not know why MELODY O'BRIEN and his phone number was written in the phone booth at the St. Francis Hotel. VILLAIRES advised that the only person he had known who ever resided at the hotel was DON EMBRY. VILLAIRES advised that EMBRY had come from Ohio about two weeks ago and had stayed at the St. Francis Hotel till he moved to downtown Los Angeles.

VILLAIRES advised that he had received some phone calls from an unknown male, beginning about the first of December 1967, and continuing until mid January 1968. He

advised that the caller would ask for MELODY and try to get her to meet him. VILLAIRES advised that the calls were received about 2 a.m. and were so frequent that he contacted the Hollywood Division of the Los Angeles Police Department. VILLAIRES advised that the calls ceased before anything was done to identify the caller.

VILLAIRES advised he had been in California for about two and one-half years and had resided in his current address with MELODY O'BRIEN for about two years. VILLAIRES advised that he was an actor but had not yet been employed.

As of interest in connection with the investigation of ERIC S. GALT, I am attaching the following documents from our investigative file on "The Local Swinger", a correspondence club operating from P. O. Box 3802, Downey, Calif. 90242:

- (a) Copy of typewritten letter dated February 17, 1968, signed "Eric S. Galt" and directed via "The Local Swinger" to one Patricia K. Anderson, 2800 Glenview Avenue, Los Angeles.
- (b) Copy of Polaroid photograph of a subject purporting to be Eric S. Galt which was transmitted with the original of the letter cited in (a).

The letter and photograph were furnished to this Service by Patricia K. Anderson, who considered the letter objectionable, for our use in investigating "The Local Swinger" as a suspected medium through which obscene materials are transmitted and exchanged.


The address shown on (a) is the address of the St. Francis Hotel, which has been mentioned in press releases concerning Eric S. Galt. The telephone number shown on (a) is the desk telephone of the St. Francis Hotel. The Polaroid code number on the reverse of the photograph, of which (b) is a copy, indicates that the film was manufactured in August 1967.

Post Office Box 3802, Downey, was rented on January 31, 1968, by James O'Dowd, who supplied the business address 8115 East Imperial Highway and the telephone number 861-1926.

Our investigation of "The Local Swinger" is assigned to Inspector L. O. Poindexter, of our Los Angeles office, and it will be satisfactory to consult with him directly should any additional information concerning the enclosures be desired. Inspector Poindexter can be reached at 688-2161.

ANN L. MEYERS, 8115 East Imperial Highway, Downey, California, co-owner of The Local Swinger, along with JAMES E. O'DOWD, advised that the two began the operation in February 1968 for the purpose of mailing list of local swingers to those who desired such a list. She stated that they placed an advertisement in the Los Angeles Free Press, offering to send a list of local swingers to anyone who paid the price of \$1.00. In addition it was understood that for each letter sent to The Local Swinger, the sender would have to pay \$1.00.

MEYERS stated that about the middle of February 1968 they received a note from ERIC S. GALT, and also a dollar, and a request for a list of swingers. Shortly after they received what she believed were five letters being sent to five individuals who coded names appeared in their list. MEYERS stated that no record was kept of those who received these letters. She did recall that one PATRICIA SCHUBERT was the recipient of one such letter, but she did not know the other four. The \$5.00 for the five letters was in cash.

MEYERS viewed pictures of JAMES EARL RAY but stated that she had never seen RAY, or had never met the man who wrote under the name of ERIC S. GALT.

JAMES E. O'DOWD, 8115 East Imperial Highway, Downey, California, one of the co-owners of The Local Swinger, a correspondence club, stated that this club used Postoffice Box 3802, Downey, California for receipt of their mail.

O'DOWD stated that in about February 1968 he and ANN L. MEYERS started The Local Swinger by inserting an advertisement in the Los Angeles Free Press, offering to send a list of local swingers to anyone who sent in the amount of \$1.00. About the middle of February they received a note from ERIC S. GALT, along with \$1.00, asking for the list. Shortly thereafter they received five letters, along with \$5.00, these letters to be sent to individuals whose coded names appeared in The Local Swinger list. O'DOWD explained that each time a letter is sent on to another individual they charge \$1.00, and in this case he believed that five letters were sent. O'DOWD stated that they kept no records of the individuals who were to receive these letters, but he did recall that one was sent to PATRICIA SCHUBERT, and the other four to four other unknown individuals.

O'DOWD viewed photographs of JAMES EARL RAY but stated that he had never seen RAY, or had never met the man who wrote under the name of ERIC S. GALT.

O'DOWD reviewed his records and stated that he did not keep the note requesting that a list of swingers be sent to ERIC S. GALT, and he had no idea who GALT had contacted.

PATRICIA ANDERSON, 2800 Glenview Avenue, Los Angeles, California, advised that she first became aware of "The Local Swinger" when she received a letter dated February 17, 1968 from ERIC S. GALT which she considered obscene in content. She immediately turned this over to the Postoffice, as well as two others which she received from other persons.

PATRICIA ANDERSON stated that all communications to her came in her maiden name, PATRICIA SCHUBERT. She believes that her name might have been bought from a mailing list as she subscribes to magazines using this name. She has never subscribed to "The Local Swinger", has never written to pen pal clubs, or subscribed to "Los Angeles Free Press".

MRS. ANDERSON viewed a group of pictures of JAMES EARL RAY, but she stated that she never saw the man, nor did she ever try to communicate with GALT despite the fact that she received his phone number and address on the letter sent to her by GALT.

PATRICIA KATHLEEN ANDERSON stated that she was a secretary in the Claims Department, U.S. Fidelity & Casualty Company, Los Angeles, California, and resides with her aged mother and ill 54 year old brother at the residence. At the present time she is separated from her husband, LEE T. ANDERSON, 7942 East Hayne Place, Tuscon, Arizona.

They advised they had taken many of these names from the "Los Angeles Free Press", an avant garde newspaper. O'DOWD and MEYERS stated it has been their experience that many of these addresses are not accurate and some persons either send inaccurate addresses or send addresses of other individuals as a joke.

The following persons, identities supplied by O'DOWD and MEYERS, were contacted in an effort to determine if they had received any correspondence from ERIC S. GALT or JAMES EARL RAY. None of the following listed individuals recalled having received mail or contact through any media from ERIC S. GALT or JAMES EARL RAY. They all advised that he is unknown to them:

TURNER stated that this advertisement ran in the February 2-8, 1968, issue of the "Free Press." He stated that the address listed in the advertisement of 406 South Second Street, Alhambra, California, is an address of a mail forwarding service which is used quite frequently by persons placing advertisements in the "Free Press." TURNER made available copies of the February 2-8, 1968, issue of the "Free Press."

MORRISON said that another customer who knew the girl, separated them. MORRISON said that subsequent to this event GOODSSELL died through an overdose of some type of medicine. He said that she formerly resided at the Carlton Towers, an apartment complex, in the neighborhood. He described her as:

MORRISON said that RAY habitually drank vodka or screwdrivers. He said that he was a very quiet customer and it was unusual for him to become involved in an argument. MORRISON said that he believes he used the name "DOUG" while at the bar.

DEL MONTE said that RAY drank vodka straight or in screwdrivers. DEL MONTE said that RAY purchased a key for the key club, which is operated by the Rabbit's Foot Club. He stated that he believes RAY gave him the name "DOUG COLLINS", when he purchased his key. DEL MONTE said that the writing of this name was by himself, and RAY furnished no other information as to residence.

GUERIN stated that he moved into Apartment 6 at 1535 Serrano Avenue, Los Angeles, on July 28, 1967. He moved from this apartment on October 1, 1967. He related the names ANITA KITZWINKEL and GINGER DAY do not mean anything to him. He related that to the best of his knowledge he has never met either of the above two persons. He recalled that when he moved into the apartment there was a woman's magazine, the exact title he does not recall, but similar to McCall's, and another article, which he could not describe, which contained some names written on it.
