HAZEL EVANS CONTACTED AND ADVISED SHE WAS BARTENDER AT BILL BAILEY'S FROM 1966 UNTIL 1969. SHE WORKED THE NIGHT SHIFT. CAME IN AT 6:00 PM AND WORKED UNTIL 2:00 AM. THE DAY BARTENDER WAS JUNE HALL. A COUPLE OF TIMES HER NIECE, PATSY BOOZER, WORKED IN THE BAR. BILL BAILEY OWNED THE BAR IN 1966, HOWEVER, WAS BOUGHT OUT IN 1967 OR 1968 BY LEWIS CLARK; HOWEVER, CLARK MANAGED THE BUSINESS DURING THE WHOLE TIME. BAILEY HAD VERY LITTLE TO DO WITH THE BAR AND IT WAS VERY SELDOM HE CAME TO THE LOCATION. SHE PICKED THE PHOTOGRAPH OF ARNOLD RAY GODFREY OUT OF A SPREAD OF PHOTOGRAPHS AND ADVISED SHE HAS KNOWN HIM SINCE HE MOVED TO ATLANTA FROM COPPER HILL, TENNESSEE.
