stop the "Niggers" and "kill" them. On one occasion SUBJECT said, "I'd Kill that son-of-a-bitch, Martin Luther King, if I got a chance." SUBJECT mentioned King's name on four or five occasions, but did not mention the names of any other Negro leaders. At an unrecalled date in 1966, SUBJECT visited Edward F. Griffith at his home, Route 4, Hartselle, Alabama, and tried to recuit him for KKK, but Edward Griffith asked HIM to leave and would have nothing to do with HIM. SUBJECT'S position in the KKK was unknown, but on one occasion HE was seen with the KKK robe and pointed cap, face uncovered, directing traffic on a highway, near a KKK rally. SUBJECT always carried a loaded .45 caliber, nickel-plated, gold-engraved automatic pistol in HIS automobile, which HE sometimes transferred to HIS trouser pocket. HE was also seen with a high-powered rifle, make and caliber unknown. In Decatur and Hartselle, Alabama, carrying of firearms, rifle, shotguns or pistols, was not considered unusual, and attracted no attention. KKK members were known to transfer weapons among each other, so that one day a person may be in possession of a certain firearm, but not have it the next day. DATC had from 6 to 8 employees, of whom some were KKK members, identifications unknown. KKK had strong followings in Decatur and Hartselbe, Alabama, not only members but non-member sympathizers.

Source advised that the following persons may have further knowledge concerning GRIFFITH or may be able to corroborate the information given above:

Dennis Griffith, CPT, USA Medical Corps, Fort Bragg, North Carolina, Psychologist, permanent address: Hartselle, Alabama, SUBJECT'S cousin, degree of closeness with SUBJECT unknown.

David Sandlin, Sheriff, Morgan County, Decatur, Alabama, knowledgeable of SUBJECT and KKK activities, no sympathy for KKK.

Mewton Powell, influential citizen and former county official, Decatur, Alabama, believed to be knowledgeable of SUBJECT and KKK activities.

Albert Brewer, Lieutenant Governor, State of Alabama, former resident of Decatur, Alabama, not known if Brewer was acquainted with SUBJECT but believed to be knowledgeable of KKK activities in Decatur and Hartselle.






