On 4/16/68, Mrs. JUDY CORRIGAN, Judy Corrigan School of Dance, 11 North Locust St., Hagerstown, Md., advised she instructs only young children in her school.

On 4/16/68, efforts to contact anyone at the Pat Patrick School of Ballroom Dancing, 65 W. Franklin St., Hagerstown, Md., were negative. It appeared that this school might not be operating, and an attempted telephonic contact of the school reflected it had been closed and the telephone disconnected. No further information was obtained from this source.

On 4/16/68, Mr. EUGENE BUDOWSKI, Manager, Fred Astaire World of Dance, residing 822 Dewey Ave., Hagerstown, Md., was contacted; he was unable to furnish any pertinent information, stating ERIC STARVO GALT was not now and had not been registered at that school under that name or the aliases, HARVEY LOWMYER or JOHN WILLARD. He was unable to identify GALT's description as being possibly identical to anyone currently or previously registered at that school. He has operated this school for over one year.

Mr. BUDOWSKI further advised he had been affiliated with the Pat Patrick School of Ballroom Dancing prior to its closing in Hagerstown. He was unable to furnish any pertinent information from his knowledge of the clients of that school.

BECAUSE HE DOES NOT REMEMBER INSTRUCTIONS. HE WAS DESCRIBED AS AN INTROVERT WHO VOLUNTEERS NO INFORMATION AND REPLIES WITH YES OR NO ANSWERS WHEN ASKED; DID NOT MINGLE WITH OTHER STUDENTS AND MADE NO EFFORTS TO MAKE FRIENDS OR CONVERSE WITH ANYONE.

ANOTHER DANCE INSTRUCTOR STATED GALT IS A GOOD DANCER, DISPLAYED SLIGHT SOUTHERN ACCENT, RURAL CHARACTERISTICS OF LANGUAGE AND DICTION, TEETH STRAIGHT AND CLEAN, FINGERNAILS CLEAN AND NEATLY TRIMMED; WORE GOLD RING WITH DARK STONE; ALWAYS NEATLY DRESSED WITH SUIT AND SHINY SLIP ON TYPE BLACK ALLIGATOR SHOES WITH THIN SOLES, BLACK HOSE AND WORE TIE TACK AND CUFF LINKS. SMOKED FILTER CIGARETTES AND HAD NERVOUS HABIT OF OCCASIONALLY PULLING AT EAR LOBE. ATTORNEY GENERAL RAMSEY CLARK ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT ERIC STARVO GALT IS BEING SOUGHT BY THE FBI AS A FUGITIVE ON A FEDERAL CHARGE ARISING FROM THE FATAL SHOOTING OF THE REVEREND DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., IN MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE, ON APRIL 4, 1968.

DIRECTOR J. EDGAR HOOVER STATED THAT A FEDERAL COMPLAINT WAS FILED BY THE FBI IN BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA, TODAY CHARGING GALT WITH CONSPIRING TO VIOLATE THE CIVIL RIGHTS OF DR. KING IN VIOLATION OF TITLE 18, SECTION 241, OF THE UNITED STATES CODE.

THE FBI COMPLAINT CHARGES THAT "ON OR ABOUT MARCH 29, 1968, AT BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA,...ERIC STARVO GALT AND AN INDIVIDUAL WHOM HE ALLEGED TO BE HIS BROTHER, ENTERED INTO A CONSPIRACY WHICH CONTINUED UNTIL ON OR ABOUT APRIL 5, 1968, TO INJURE, OPPRESS, THREATEN, OR INTIMIDATE MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.,...IN THE FREE EXERCISE OR ENJOYMENT OF A RIGHT SECURED TO HIM BY THE CONSTITUTION OR LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES: NAMELY, THE RIGHT TO FREELY TRAVEL FROM STATE TO STATE. IN FURTHERANCE OF THIS CONSPIRACY, ERIC STARVO GALT DID, ON OR ABOUT MARCH 30, 1968, PURCHASE A RIFLE AT BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA...."

ACCORDING TO MR. HOOVER, A 30.06 RIFLE EQUIPPED WITH A TELESCOPIC SIGHT WAS FOUND NEAR A ROOMING HOUSE ON SOUTH MAIN STREET IN MEMPHIS IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE FATAL SHOOTING OF DR. KING OCCURRED. THE ROOMING HOUSE OVERLOOKS THE LORRAINE HOTEL AND MOTEL WHERE DR. KING WAS STAYING.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT FBI AGENTS DETERMINED THAT THE 30.06 RIFLE HAD BEEN PURCHASED FROM A GUN DEALER IN BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA, ON MARCH 30, 1968. THE TELESCOPIC SIGHT ALSO WAS PURCHASED FROM THIS DEALER.

THE FBI DIRECTOR SAID THAT GALT, WHO HAS USED THE NAMES OF JOHN WILLARD AND HARVEY LOWMYER IN THE PAST, IS THE OWNER OF A 1966 WHITE MUSTANG BEARING ALABAMA LICENSE PLATES WHICH WAS LOCATED ABANDONED IN ATLANTA, GEORGIA, ON APRIL 11, 1968. INVESTIGATION DISCLOSED THAT GALT PURCHASED THIS CAR FROM A PRIVATE CITIZEN IN BIRMINGHAM ON AUGUST 30, 1967. THE MUSTANG'S ODOMETER SHOWED THAT IT HAD BEEN DRIVEN MORE THAN 19,000 MILES BETWEEN LATE AUGUST, 1967, AND EARLY APRIL, 1968.

ACCORDING TO MR. HOOVER, GALT'S TRAVELS IN THE MUSTANG INCLUDED TRIPS TO LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA; NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA; BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA; AND MEXICO, AS WELL AS TO MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE, AND ATLANTA, GEORGIA. GALT WAS REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN IN MEMPHIS ON APRIL 3 AND 4, 1968, AND TO HAVE DEPARTED FROM THERE FOR ATLANTA.

INTENSIVE INVESTIGATION BY THE FBI HAS DISCLOSED THAT GALT HAS CLAIMED TO HAVE BEEN EMPLOYED AS A COOK ON MISSISSIPPI RIVER VESSELS AND AS A MERCHANT SEAMAN. HE IS SAID TO BE AN AVID DANCER AND TOOK DANCING LESSONS IN NEW ORLEANS IN 1964 AND 1965; IN BIRMINGHAM DURING SEPTEMBER AND OCTOBER, 1967; AND IN LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, FROM DECEMBER, 1967, TO FEBRUARY, 1968.

GALT LEFT LOS ANGELES ON DECEMBER 15, 1967, AND DROVE HIS WHITE MUSTANG TO NEW ORELANS, WHERE HE CLAIMED HE CONTACTED EITHER AN ENGINEERING OR A CONTRACTING FIRM. HE LEFT NEW ORLEANS ON DECEMBER 19TH AND ARRIVED BACK IN LOS ANGELES ON DECEMBER 21, 1967.

WHILE IN THE LOS ANGELES AREA EARLY THIS YEAR, GALT TOOK A COURSE AT A SCHOOL OF BARTENDING AND WAS GRADUATED ON MARCH 2, 1968.

THE FUGITIVE IS DESCRIBED AS A WHITE MALE. HE IS APPROXIMATELY 5 FEET 8 INCHES TO 5 FEET 11 INCHES TALL AND WEIGHS BETWEEN 160 AND 175 POUNDS. HE IS SAID TO BE A NEAT DRESSER AND HAS A MEDIUM BUILD.

GALT HAS BROWN HAIR, WHICH HE WEARS IN A "BRUSH" CUT. HE REPORTEDLY HAS BLUE EYES; HIS NOSE IS STRAIGHT AND NARROW; HIS TEETH ARE STRAIGHT AND CLEAN; AND HE HAS GIVEN HIS DATE OF BIRTH AS

THE FUGITIVE IS SAID TO HAVE A NERVOUS HABIT OF OCCASIONALLY PULLING AT AN EAR LOPE WITH HIS HAND. HIS LEFT EAR PROTRUDES FARTHER FROM HIS HEAD THAN HIS RIGHT EAR.

ACCORDING TO MR. HOOVER, PERSONS WHO HAVE MET GALT DESCRIBE HIM AS A "LONER" AND STATE HIS LANGUAGE AND DICTATION HAVE A "RURAL" QUALITY AND SUGGEST THAT HE PROBABLY DOES NOT HAVE A HIGH DEGREE OF EDUCATION. HE IS SAID TO DRINK ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND HAS A PREFERENCE FOR VODKA AND BEER. HE IS A FAN OF WESTERN AND COUNTRY MUSIC.

THE FEDERAL STATUTE UNDER WHICH GALT HAS BEEN CHARGED PROVIDES A MAXIMUM PENALTY OF TEN YEARS' IMPRISONMENT AND/OR \$5,000 FINE. BOND OF \$50,000 HAS BEEN RECOMMENDED.

GALT SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS. ANY INFORMATION CONCERNING HIM SHOULD BE FURNISHED IMMEDIATELY TO THE NEAREST FBI OFFICE.

The following investigation was conducted by SA Moberg on 4/18/68 :

Mr. WILLIAM LEROY GALT,, residing at the home called Fort Venture, Located at Bellevue, Maryland, provided the following informationL:

He is president, treasurer and salesman of the firm known as POKE GALT, Inc., and has his offices in Bellevue, Md. He also uses the nickname POKE GALT. He has been in the Bellevue area for about 6 years, having come from Pennsylvania, where he had the same business located in Alden, Pa. and where he residedX in Clifton ~~MAINT~~ Heights, Pa. His business consists of wholesale plumbing and piping. He still retains an answering service in Philadelphia area as some of his customers still come from there. HMX

He has a brother JOHN PETER GALT, recently retired from the U.S. Navy, who currently resides at 3003 Blue Ridge Avenue, Wheaton, Md. , telephone number 949-2443, and another brother CHARLES P. GALT, residing in San Rafael, California.

GALT has no children of his own. He is married to his second wife who has several children of her own, none of the name GALT.

GALT advised that he is aware of the interest of the FBI in an ERIC STARVO GALT from publicity but has no knowledge of that person. He has never heard the name other than from the wide publicity recently given it and has no relative of that name. He could provide no information which might be of any help in this matter.

GALT viewed a photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT appearing on page # 1 of the Baltimore Sun Paper of 4/18/68 and advised that the man ~~HE~~ is unfamiliar to him.

On 4/18/68 Dr. R. LANE WROTH, St. Michaels, Md., who is acquainted with WILLIAM LEROY GALT of Bellevue, Md., advised that to his knowledge ERIC STARVO GALT is unrelated to WILLIAM L. GALT. Dr. wroth viewed the above mentioned photo of ERIC STARVO GALT but advised that it was totally unfamiliar to him.

Also all laundries and dry cleaning plants and shops, civilian and military, in these ~~two~~ counties were contacted with negative results concerning the instant Thermo Seal laundry mark.

The Waldorf Laundry at Waldorf, Md. was the only laundry utilizing the Thermo-Seal ~~marking~~ marking process. Mr. J. Burns, Mgr. of this laundry informed 4/10/68 that this laundry has never used the Thermo-Seal tape to mark underwear but only used on shirts.

Mary Credle, the Thermo-Seal machine operator at Waldorf Laundry, contacted 4/15/68 and she also confirmed that this machine only used to mark shirts and never used to mark underwear.

KING CASE AGAINST THE FINGERPRINTS OF THE OVER 53,000 PERSONS FOR WHOM "WANTED NOTICES" HAVE BEEN POSTED IN THE FILES OF THE FBI'S IDENTIFICATION DIVISION LED TO THE DETERMINATION THAT GALT AND RAY ARE IDENTICAL.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT RAY, WHO IS 40 YEARS OF AGE, WAS REPORTED MISSING FROM THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY AT JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, SINCE APRIL 23, 1967. HE HAD BEEN RECEIVED AT THAT INSTITUTION ON MARCH 17, 1967, TO SERVE A 20-YEAR SENTENCE FOLLOWING CONVICTION IN ST. LOUIS FOR ARMED ROBBERY AND FOR OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WITHOUT PERMISSION OF THE OWNER.

HE HAS SERVED TERMS IN THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY JAIL IN 1949; IN STATE PRISONS AT JOLIET AND PONTIAC, ILLINOIS, IN 1952-54; AND IN THE FEDERAL PENITENTIARY AT LEAVENWORTH, KANSAS, IN 1955-58.

MEMORANDUM

At 10:15 a.m. on April 10, 1968, a telephone call was received from Lawrence J. Hawkins who lives at 3708 Dolfield Avenue, whose home telephone number is 664-5520. Mr. Hawkins is a postal employee at the Airmail Section of the Main Post Office, and his telephone number there is 962-4230.

Mr. Hawkins related that he viewed a television program last night on which there appeared a composite of the alleged killer of Martin Luther King, Jr. Mr. Hawkins stated that the composite resembled closely a white man by the name of Philip Jenkins, who picketed the CORE convention at Broadway and Gay Street, Baltimore, in July 1966. Hawkins states that Jenkins' picture was in the paper at that time.

Hawkins also advised that Jenkins was connected with an organization by the name of Peace International in the 800 block of W. Gay Street, Baltimore, but that the organization is no longer there. Hawkins also advised that Jenkins founded a rifle club on Gay Street and Baltimore.

The above information was transmitted by telephone at 10:30 a.m. this date to Tom Charigo, Baltimore FBI, who advised that Philip Jenkins is known to them.

CLARK advised that they were unable to locate any Baltimore listing for OTT and requested Baltimore to immediately make a pretext call to the A.G. Food Company for any available information concerning OTT.

While ASAC was on the phone, SA ALMON telephonically contacted the A.G. Food Company under a suitable pretext, requesting information concerning OTT.

Their records indicate that a HERBERT O. OTT, who was born on [redacted], worked as a laborer with A.G. Food Company (Gino's Restaurants) from 10/65 until he quit on 2/25/68. Search of premises believed occupied by Unsub who assassinated Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING on 4/4/68, disclosed suitcase in which was located tee-shirt and undershorts bearing laundry mark on red tape with black lettering believed to be thermo-seal type, manufactured by Textile Marking Machine Co., Inc., Syracuse, N. Y. The tape is  $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide and  $1 \frac{1}{16}$ " long and bears letters and numbers 02B-6.

Experts at Textile Marking Machine Company advise type on this machine is unusual in that the first two characters are 15 point type and the last three characters are 18 point type, with the middle character, the letter B, probably being narrow rather than regular type. The usual machine carries 15 point type for the first three characters and 18 point type for the last two characters.

Textile Marking Machine experts also stated this machine is defective in that it is producing a tape  $1 \frac{1}{16}$ " long instead of  $1 \frac{1}{8}$ " long and is not projecting the tape far enough resulting in cutting off a portion of the first letter. The code used in the Northeast part of the U. S. is as follows:

The first letter O stands for lot number; the first number 2 indicates the day of the week, two being Tuesday; the second letter indicates the first letter of the store name, this is the letter B; the last number is the bundle number, this is 6. Color coding of the tag may designate various things such as a different month or the identity of a store in a chain. Experts also state the use of this system on laundry items is unusual in that the system is normally used on garments being dry cleaned.

The Bureau has instructed that all textile machines using this type tape be located and machines using this code be identified.
