UNLIKE CAESAR'S WIFE, J. EDGAR HOOVER IS NOT ABOVE REPORACH WHEN IT COMES TO THE CIVIL RIGHTS ISSUE. LET MR. HOOVER THEN CLEAR THE AIR BY EITHER REMOVING HIMSELF FROM THE INVESTIGATION OR SHARING THE HUNT WITH MEN AND ORGANIZATIONS THAT COMMAND THE FAITH OF THOSE WHOSE CAUSE KING CHAMPIONED.



Referenced memo advised that Professor JOSEPH LONERO. Room 208. Sturgess Hazl. Geneseo College, Geneseo, N.Y. telephonically contacted the Buffalo Office on 5/2/68 concerning an anonymous letter in his possession. According to LONERO this letter claims that ERIC STARVO GALT is currently residing in Asantee (Ashantee). There is no place by the name of Asantee located in Livingston County, N.Y., however, Ashantee is located in the Town of Avon, N.Y. on New York State Route 39 south of the Village of Avon, N.Y. There is no Post Office located at Ashantee.

LONERO contacted on 5/2/68 at Geneseo College at which time he made available a copy of the letter he referred to in his telephone call. The letter indicates that there is a group calling themselves "Knights of the Valley" and that they are arming themselves against future rioting and violence by Negroes.

LONERO advised that he has no idea as to who may have sent him this letter and is not acquainted with anyone who lives in the Ashantee area. However, he stated that he is very active in civil rights matters and feels that this is the reason he received this letter. LONERO advised that he has no idea as to what the word Nitschie in the first line of this letter means and knows no one by this name. LONERO advised that he does not have any information to indicate that an organization know as "Knights of the Valley" actually exists.

On 5/2/68, DOUGLAS WELCH, Chief Deputy, Livingston County SO, Geneseo, N.Y., advised that he has no information concerning an organization know as 'Knights of the Valley", however, he understands that LONERO has received other letters signed "Knights of the Valley". WELCH stated that LONERO is not well liked by several of the students and faculty at Geneseo College and feels that someone from the college may have sent the letters to LONERO.



2 New Ray Photos Distributed by FBI

WASHINGTON (UPI) — The FBI distributed yesterday two more photographs of the accused killer of Dr. Martin Luther King — one of them "an extremely good likeness."

Both were snapshots of James Earl Ray, alias Eric Starvo Galt, an escaped convict accused of shooting Dr. King to death in Memphis April 4.

The "extremely good likeness" is a candid photograph of Ray in a business suit and tie and shows almost his full face, taken in late January or early February somewhere in California.

The other, which the FBI said was taken last November somewhere in Mexico, shows him wearing sun glasses and what appears to be a white sports shirt.

The two new photographs -

the FBI refused to say where or how they were obtained — will be displayed throughout the country along with three others now appearing on FBI wanted posters.

One of the earlier photographs was taken when Ray was graduated from bartending school in Los Angeles early this year. His eyes were closed when the shuttersnapped, but they were sketched in by an FBI artist.

The other two photographs were made when Ray entered the Missouri State Prison in 1960 to serve a 20-year sentence for armed robbery.

Ray, who escaped from prison April 23, 1967, by hiding in a truck, is wanted by the FBI for illegal flight to avoid prosecution in Tennessee for Dr. King's murd er.
