

BECKWITH was arrested by Bureau Agents June 22, 1963, for the murder, and was tried on two occasions at Jackson, and on each occasion, the jury was unable to reach a verdict.

Memphis has background on subject, and Jackson has forwarded photographs of BECKWITH to Memphis in this matter.

BECKWITH described as white male, born [REDACTED] Sacramento, California, 5' 10", 170 pounds, dark hair, olive complexion, medium build, resides 101 Dewey Avenue, Greenwood, Mississippi, and is employed as sales representative for Barrentine Manufacturing Co., Inc., Greenwood, Mississippi. He has
