





Re telephonic lead from Huntsville RA to check RAYMOND SNYDER, Operator Top's Cleaners, Jackson Highway, Sheffield, Alabama to determine if his laundry has a customer who might be identified through Thermo-Seal laundry label 2B-6 or O2B-6 on a red label.

SNYDER does use a Thermo-Seal labeling machine which has the ½ inch tape but he does not use a code with a 0 in formt of the first number. SNYDER has had this machine for about that 1½ years and he has very large volume of laundry tickets which contain a duplicate of the Thermo-Seal labels placed on garments handled in his plant.

Each existing laundry ticket at the Top's Cleaners has been checked and no labels of any kind were found which had a code where a 0 was in front of the first number in the code. No red label was found with the code 2B-6. SNYDER knew of no other cleaners in the Tri-Cities area who use Thermo-Seal labels and he knew of no other cleaners who would use a 0 in front of the first number of the code. He explained a cleaner could devise his own personal code system and not necessarily follow the normal code system.

Separate communication being prepared re other information furnished by SNYDER regarding possible means of locating cleaner who might use code with a 0 as the first figure in code.






