

JOHN HOLCOMB, JR., Birmingham Recorders Court, advised their files contained no information on POUNDERS.

Records of the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office also failed to reflect any information on POUNDERS.

Mr. RICHARD LORENTZ, Veterans Administration Hospital, Birmingham, Ala., advised POUNDERS stayed in the VA Hospital for 100 days in 1966 and 1967. He advised he was admitted on October 14, 1966, and stayed until January 26, 1967. Mr. LORENTZ advised POUNDERS is a chronic alcoholic and tries to stay in VA Hospitals as long as possible. He said he also has stayed at the VA Hospital In Ft. Worth, Texas. Mr. LORENTZ advised he is a most unstable person who has received psychiatric care. LORENTZ advised he referred him to the Alabama Rehabilitation Center and, namely, to a Mr. G. G. HOLMES.

SHIRLEY CARR, 3052 Lorne Drive, Birmingham, Alabama, advised on 4/7/68, that she is a barmaid in the Court Room of the Parliament House Motor Hotel, Birmingham, Alabama, and has been employed in this capacity for several years. After viewing an artist's conception of an individual exhibited to her by SA J. T. ARNETT, she stated that this artist's conception reminded her of an individual she knew only by the name of "BOB". She stated that she has not seen this individual for several months, but recalls that quite some time ago, the exact time she cannot recall, IDA GOODE, who was at that time employed at the Parliament House as a barmaid, dated this individual, and she should be able to furnish his complete name. She advised that IDA GOODE is now employed at the Domino Lounge, Homewood, Alabama. advised as best she can recall, "BOB" was a salesman from Memphis, Tennessee, who came to Birmingham approximately every two weeks. She advised she recalls that "BOB" related to her on one occasion that he had three children and his wife had been killed in an automobile accident. She said subsequent to this, IDA GOODE had informed her this was not true as on one occasion she had called BOB's home and had talked to his wife.

The following investigation was conducted by SA's NEIL G. MARTIN and J. T. ARNETT on 4/8/68:

IDA GOODE, 1264 49th Place South, Apt. D., Birmingham, Alabama, after viewing an artist's conception exhibited her by SA J. T. ARNETT, advised this artist's conception did resemble an individual known to her as "BOB", however, it was not an exact likeness of "BOB".

She stated that she met "BOB" approximately  $2\frac{1}{2}$  to 3 years ago, and she dated him three times. She stated she could not recall BOB's last name, but he is a salesman and works out of Atlanta, Georgia. She stated that "BOB" had informed her that his wife was dead, having been killed in an automobile accident, and he had three children. He advised her he had a housekeeper who kept the children. She stated "BOB" claimed he had fallen in love with her and had given her his home phone number. She stated that "BOB" drove an old stationwagon, she believed a Chevrolet, and this stationwagon was loaded with black suitcases which contained articles connectioned with "BOB"'s employment. She stated she cannot recall the merchandise or articles "BOB" sold but does not believe it was anything in the clothing line. She advised that "BOB" was not checked into the Parliament House Motor Hotel, as on the occasions they went out they would go in her automobile and she would return him to his stationwagon which was parked near the Parliament House.

"BOB" informed her that when he left Birmingham, he traveled to Montgomery and Mobile. She stated he would be in Birmingham approximately every two weeks. She advised that she has not seen "BOB" in approximately two years. She advised that she has recently dated HAROLD SARGENT from Sylacauga, Alabama, a white male, 34 years old, 6'2", 200 pounds, long black hair. She has also dated JOHN AMES,


