BH 44-1740

Mr. JOE SULZBY, Manager, Lane Rexall Drug Store, 1024 20th Street South, stated that the tapes from the two cash registers in his store reflect the name of his drug store, as well as the date of purchase for each item. SULZBY stated that any register receipt found that did not bear the name of his store or the date of purchase could not have come from his drug store.

Mrs. ELAINE DODSON, 1719 13th Avenue South, observed the FBI sketch of the Unsub in this case, and stated that he resembles someone who lives somewhere in her neighborhood. She stated she sees this individual three or four times a week driving a white Mustang hardtop. She stated she has not seen this individual for two or three weeks and added that he is always trying to pick up girls on 11th Avenue. She stated that this individual tried to pick her up about a month ago at the Modern Drugs Pharmacy at 11th Avenue and 12th Street South.

She stated that this individual is a white male, 37 - 38 years, dark hair which is lighter in front. She stated that she could not judge this individual's height or weight as she has only seen him in the car, but estimated that he had a medium build. She stated that this individual is usually dressed in a business suit and wears a white shirt and tie.

She stated that she could not be any more specific on whether or not this individual is identical with the sketch but stated that there was a resemblance in the face, although again she stated that she had never seen this individual out of the car. She stated that she did not know the license number of the Mustang nor did she have any idea where this individual lived or worked but assumed he must live in the neighborhood due to the frequent number of times she has seen him.

Mrs. DODSON stated that she would be particularly alert for this individual and would notify the FBI should she observe his license number.





JIMMY PHILLIPS, Standard Oil Service Station Manager, 7953 Crestwood Boulevard, residence 1204 Concord Avenue, Birmingham, furnished the following.

Until about the middle of March, 1968, PHILLIPS had been the Assistant Manager at the Standard Service Station at 2188 Highland Avenue, Birmingham. He recalled a customer at the Highland Avenue Station who drove a white Mustang and whose first name was ERIC. He described this person as a white male in his early 30's, five feet, nine to ten inches, 180 pounds, black hair, combed straight back, neat dresser, easy-going in his manner.

PHILLIPS believes this person at the time claimed he was working for an insurance company or a realty company or possibly Social Security. He made all his purchases in cash and was always alone. PHILLIPS believes this person had been observed by him smoking on occasions, but he could not recall his discussing anything except the night clubs in downtown Birmingham and "chasing women." PHILLIPS believes this man once told him that he was divorced and lived in the Highland area of Birmingham.

PHILLIPS claimed when he first observed this car, it had Georgia license plates and a trailer hitch. PHILLIPS said this man claimed he was from Atlanta and used his Mustang to pull a large boat, with the result that the clutch on the Mustang was then in bad shape.

PHILLIPS believed the last time he saw this man was in February, 1968, and he was positive he could identify him if he saw him again.

Mr. HILL HARDY was interviewed at the Nifty Paper Company in Birmingham and advised that he is originally from Pensacola, Florida, and has been working for Nifty and living at PETE CHERPES' boarding house for the past four years. He stated that this boarding house was located on 19th Street until July, 1967, when that building was sold, forcing CHERPES to move his boarding house operation to 2608 Highland Avenue.

HARDY advised that he occupies Room 21 and has occupied this room since July, 1967.

When questioned concerning an individual using the name ERIC S. GALT, who occupied Room 14 from August 26, 1967, until October 7, 1967, HARDY advised that the only man he remembers living in that room was an old man. He said he cannot remember anyone by the name of ERIC GALT as living at the rooming house. He also stated, after being advised of GALT's description, that he could not remember anyone with that description living there. He said that he does not recall a white Mustang automobile belonging to anyone living at the rooming house or sitting in the island of the front street in front of this house.

HARDY stated he was sorry he could not be of more help, but that he is a quiet individual himself and stays in his room most of the time and has little or no association with the other tenants at this house.

After viewing an artist's conception shown to him, HARDY advised that it does not resemble anyone he remembers ever living at this boarding house.





JOE B. GILLILAND, 5013-B Georgia Road, Birmingham, telephone 592-0429, advised as follows:

He advised he has worked in the electrical shop at Hayes International Corporation for 15 years, and in September of 1967 was laid off. Beginning then, he went to work for Yellow Cab Company as a dayshift driver. He advised that he drives Taxi Cab #52 and begins work at 6:00 a.m.

At approximately 9:00 a.m. on March 28, 1968, he drove a fare from the Tutwiler Hotel to the airport. The taxi cab starter at the airport advised that they had too many taxis at the airport and he need not wait at that cab stand.

GILLILAND advised that he returned toward town along the airport highway, and at 15th Avenue in front of the Enco Station he picked up a fare that flagged him down. He stated this individual was standing on the grass in front of the service station between the two entrance ramps.

He described this individual as a white male, six feet to six feet, one inch, 180 pounds, 35 to 40 years old, wearing a blue suit with a black tie. This individual was carrying a small overnight, blue suitcase about 24 inches long. The man opened the back door and placed the suitcase on the back seat beside him. This individual stated "You go where I tell you. Go down 5th Avenue to 20th Street and turn left."

GILLILAND advised this individual made no further comments during the trip until they reached the vicinity of Five Points South, when the passenger stated "This is good enough. I'll get out right here."

GILLILAND advised that he let his passenger off on the northwest corner of 20th Street and 9th Avenue South, referred to as Five Points South. The total fare was \$2.16, and this individual gave him three one-dollar bills and told

him to "keep the change - buy a cup of coffee."

GILLILAND stated that on Thursday, March 28, 1968, he had 18 total fares, and this particular run was his fifth of the day; therefore, the time would be placed at approximately 9:00 a.m. He was unable to recall whether the suitcase this individual was carrying was leather, nylon, or of some other composition. He stated the last he saw of this individual was when he stepped from the cab up onto the curb on the northwest corner of 20th Street and 9th Avenue South.

When displayed the artist's conception of the individual using the name HARVEY LOWMEYER, GILLILAND advised the face was familiar and he was quite certain that it was the individual he took to Five Points South.

On March 29, 1968, he made two trips from the airport, the first being two boxes which were transported from the Railway Express to Office Park Circle, and the second a fare from the terminal to 4740 lst Avenue South. GILLILAND stated he could not recall this particular fare but was relying on his trip sheet.

GILLILAND advised he could not recall the fare from the Tutwiler Hotel to the airport on March 30, 1968, or the return trip from the airport to 4604 South Long. These last two trips were the last two of the day, so that the time would be placed around 4:00 p.m. He has no recollection of the number of passengers, their sex or race.
