Attached for information regarding JAMES BERTRAM MC ARTHUR HUBKA is one copy of Hubka's prior arrest record and one copy of his presentence report dated 12/10/62 for the violation of Title 18, Section 871, U. S. Code.

On 4/14/68, Officer CONAWAY and Sergeant CORN, Birmingham Police Department, Ensley Division, were contacted and interviewed regarding their possible knowledge of HUBKA but they advised that the vonly record of anyone of that name arrested by their division was one DAVID HUBKA, age 56, who had been previously arrested for drunkenness on many occasions who had been a trustee at the Ensley Jail when it was in operation. Officer CONAWAY advised that he could locate no record in his files of JAMES HUBKA.

On 4/15/68, Special Agent in Charge ADOLPH M. DOWNING, U. S. Secret Service, advised that he was familiar with the JAMES HUBKA matter because HUBKA had written letters which contained threats against the life of JOHN F. KENNEDY, President of the United States, in 1962. Mr. DOWNING advised that his records indicate that JAMES HUBKA presently resides at 2121 Avenue H, Ensley, Alabama, with his father and mother. He advised that he had interviewed HUBKA on several previous occasions and had learned of HUBKA's intents, personal dislikes for members of the Negro

race and his obsession to insure a separation of the races in all aspects of living. Mr. DOWNING advised that he had had no recent discussions with HUBKA but understood from discussions with USA MACON L. WEAVER, Birmingham, that HUBKA was attempting to initiate criminal prosecution against Dr. A. B. STEPHENS, JR., with regard to STEPHENS psychiatric diagnosis of him in 1962.

On 4/18/68, Mr. JOHN W. MC INTOSH, U. S. Probation Officer, Birmingham, Alabama, advised that he was familiar with JAMES HUBKA due to the fact that he had had long interviews with him on many past occasions. Mr. MC INTOSH said that in his opinion HUBKA was capable of anything and would not be surprised if HUBKA actually attempted to carry out some of his plans using violent methods. Mr. MC INTOSH further stated that he believed HUBKA had sympathies toward Nazi groups and groups which favored segregation of the races. MC INTOSH stated that he believed that HUBKA was presently collecting antique weapons but world not know to the extent which this activity had reached. A review of JAMES HUBKA's file at the U. S. Probation Office indicated that he has a paranoid personality and has been diagnosed as follows by A. H. MILOSKEY, MD, Staff Psychiatrist, Federal Prison. Springfield, Missouri, March 1, 1963:

Schizophrenic reaction; chronic undifferentiated type manifested by looseness of associations, flattening of the effect, impoverished relationship with people, chronic enuresis, history of bizarre thinking (e.g., experimenting with his own feces to see if they would attract mosquitos, while in the service - presentence report), and lack of evidence of progression from adolescent identity confusion.

This agent observed a photograph of JAMES HUBKA taken in 1962 and eliminated him as

IT IS NOTED JERRY SERVED TIME FOR BURGLARY AT ISP, MENARD, AND ARMED ROBBERY AT MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY. END PAGE FIVE

## IMMEDIATE RELEASE - ADRIL 17, 1968

Attorney General Ramsey Clark announced today that ERIC STARVO GALT is being sought by the FBI as a fugitive on a Federal charge arising from the fatal shooting of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King. Jr., in Memphis, Tesnessee, on April 4, 1968.

Director J. Edgar Roover stated that a Tederal complaint was filed by the FBI at Birmingham, Alabama, today, charging GALT with conspiring to violate the civil rights of Dr. King in violation of Title 18, Section 241, of the United States Cade.

The FBI complaint charges that "On or about March 29, 1966, at Birmingham, Alabama ... ERIC STARVO GALT and an individual whom he alleged to be his brother, entered into a conspiracy which continued until on or about April 5, 1968, to injure, oppress, threaten, or intimidate Martin Lather King, Jr. ... in the free exercise or enjoyment of a right secured to him by the Constitution or laws of the United States; namely, the right to freely travel from state to state. In furtherance of this communicy, ERIC STARYO GALT did, on or about March 30, 1968, parchase a rifle at Birmingham, Alabama...."

According to Mr. Hoover, a 30.06 rifle, equipped with a telescopie sight was found near a rooming house on South Main Street in Memphis immediately after the fatal shooting of Dr. King occurred. The rooming house overlooks the Lorraine Hotel and Motel where Dr. King was staying.

Mr. Hoover said that FBI Agents determined that the 30.06 rifle had been purchased from a gun dealer in Birmingham, Alabama, on March 30, 1968. The telescopic sight also was purchased from this dealer.

The FBI Director stated that Galt, who has used the names of John Willard and Harvey Lowmyer in the past, is the owner of a 1966 white Mustang, bearing Alabama license plates, which was located abandoned in Atlanta, Georgia, on April 11, 1968. Investigation disclosed that Galt purchased this car from a private citizen in Birmingham on August 30, 1967. The Mustang's odometer showed that it had been driven more than 19,000 miles between late August, 1967, and early April, 1968.

Ageording to Mr. Hoover, Galt's travels in the Mustang include trips to Los Angeles, California; New Orleans, Louisians; Birmingham, Alabame; and Mexico, as well as to Hemphis, Tennessee, and Atlanta, Georgia.

Galt was reported to have been in Memphis on April 3 and 4, 1988, and to have departed from there for Atlanta.

Intensive investigation by the FRI has disclosed that Galt has claimed to have been employed as a cook on Hississipi River vessels and as a Marchant Season. He is said to be an avid descer and took demains lessons in New Orleans in 1964 and 1965; in Eirmingham during September and October 1967; and in Long Beach, Oslifornia, from December, 1967, to February, 1988.

Calt left Los Angeles on Becember 15, 1967, and drove his white Hustang to New Orleans, where he claimed he contacted either an engineering or a contragting firm. He left New Orleans on December 19 and arrived back in Los Angeles on December 21, 1987.

While in the Los Angeles area early this year, Calt took a sourse at a school of bartending and was graduated on March 2, 1968.

The fugitive is described as a white male. He is approximately 5 feet wight inches to five feet eleven inches tall, and weighs between 160 and 175 pounds.

He is said to be a neat dresser and has a medium build.

Galt has brown hair, which he wears in a "brush" cut. He reportedly has blue eyes; his nose is straight and narrow; his teeth are straight and clean; and he has given his date of birth as

The fugitive is said to have a nervous habit of occasionally pulling at an ear lobe with his hand. His left ear protrudes farther from his head than his right ear.

According to Mr. Hoover, persons who have met Galt describe him as a "loner" and state his language and diction have a "rural" quality and suggest that he probably does not have a high degree of education.

He is said to drink alcoholic beverages and has a preference for Vodka and beer. He is a fan of western and country music.

Galt should be considered armed and dangerous.

Any information concerning him should be furnished

immediately to the nearest FBI Office.

The FBI Laboratory advised that pillowcase and bed sheet were found in trunk of 1966 white Mustang registered to ERIC STARVO GALT, which was located at Atlanta 4/11/68. These items contain Thermo-Seal laundry tapes of approximately same size as tapes on items previously recovered, but are yellow in color and contain code, "20R-3." In opinion of Textile Marking Machine Company, Syracuse, New York, the tapes were produced by a different machine than previous tapes since the first three characters are 15 point type and the last two characters are 18 point type,

The Textile Marking Machine Company suggests the twenty in above code would be the lot number, the R may mean that this was a return of a batch of laundry, and the three is the bundle number.
