

IN THE COURSE OF HIS JEVELRY BUSINESS, HE MET A WHITE MALE

FBI Not "Guilty?"

The House assassinations committee has come up with a yes-but verdict on the Federal Bureau of Investigation regarding accusations made against the agency in the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King. The committee says the FBI had no direct part in the slaying.

But the verdict has been softened somewhat to mollify those in the black community who have unequivocally accused the FBI of having a part in the assassination.

Now the committee wants to know the answers to three other questions:

- Did the FBI's effort to discredit King result in his being in Memphis at the time he was assassinated?
- Did the FBI, through other black activists, foment the violence which made a second King appearance there necessary?
- © Did the FBI have foreknowledge of the assassination on which it did not act?

It is obvious that if the answer to any one of these questions is found to be yes, then the FBI is guilty, guilty of something — bad judgment, imperfect perception, etc.—but guilty.

But Americans, if they had any doubts, can now put them to rest. No, the FBI did not have a contract on Dr. King, did not pay activists to disrupt the King-led demonstrations, did not lure him back to Memphis so that he could be murdered and did not, at the time, know who did.
