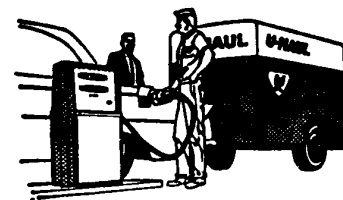
A LOOK AT GAMES AND GIMMICKS
(State Directors Meeting)

A new light has been shed on the controversial subject of Games & Gimmicks. (The Officers and Directors again went on record unanimously opposing these programs that are sponsored by the major oil companies) It was revealed during the discussion that at least three groups of Dealers in the past few months have been exempt from such a program by requesting that they not have them. One group of 13 Dealers and one of about 25 Dealers as well as one area covering from two to five states were exempt by Dealers talking and speaking

up about their likes and dislikes.

It appears that the original idea of Games & Gimmicks was to help the Dealers, and Suppliers sponsored, and in most cases pushed the Games. Some Dealers like them but most of them feel they don't honestly draw real lasting, profitable customers.

The question now, in most cases, is up to the Service Station Dealers. Each like brand of Dealers in a city or concentrated area should get in touch with one another and

WANTED BY THE FBI

James Earl Ray, with known aliases of Eric Starvo Galt, W. C. Herron, Harvey Lowmeyer, James McBride, James O'Conner, James Walton, James Walyon, John Willard, "Jim", is being sought by the FBI and charged with a civil rights conspiracy in which the victim was shot and killed and interstate flight - robbery.

According to FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover, Ray, who is 40 years of age, was reported missing from the Missouri State Penitentiary at Jefferson City, Missouri, since April 23, 1967, where he had been received on March 17, 1960, to serve a 20-year sentence following his conviction for armed robbery.

Ray has a known arrest record dating back to 1949 which includes a conviction for burglary in Los Angeles, California, in 1949; armed robbery in Chicago, Illinois, in 1952; and forging United States Postal Money Orders in Missouri in 1955.

Ray had served in the U. S. Army from February, 1946, to December, 1948, at which time he was given a general discharge. He is a white male, born [redacted] in Illinois (not confirmed), is approximately 5'10", weight 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes, brown hair, has a small scar on the center of his forehead and a scar on the palm of his right hand.

Ray is a drifter and has been employed as a baker, labourer and a color matcher.

Ray should be considered armed and dangerous. Anyone having information concerning him should immediately report it to the FBI. Call Birmingham telephone 322-7711 - collect.

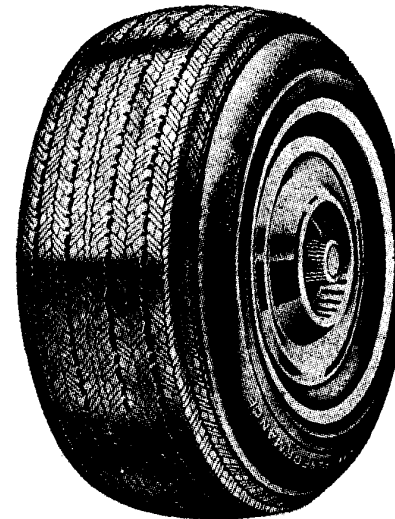
