SUBJECT: MURKIN

At 12:10 A. M., 4/7/68, SA CHARLIE TANNIAN, Boston Division, telephonically contacted the Charlotte Division and advised as follows:

The word "Murkin" is the code name given to investigation concerning the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. A Mrs. ELEANOR POWERS, Reade Hotel, Boston, telephonically contacted the Boston Division the night of 4/6/68, and confidentially furnished the following information with request that her identity be concealed in view of her friendship with the BREECE family.

She is acquainted with one GEORGE WILBUR BREECE, white male, age 22, six feet, sandy hair, a prominent nose, of Fayetteville, N. C. He is the son of JOE WILBUR BREECE who operates a funeral parlor at 123 Bow St., Fayetteville, N. C. He bears a strong resemblance to the composite sketch of the suspect in the KING assassination. She recalls GEORGE WILBUR BREECE as a wild young man whose family gave him a white Mustang automobile a year or two ago. She ;stated he has used the alias of JOHN WILLARD which is the name used by the suspect at Memphis.

SA TANNIAN stated he had contacted Supervisor DAVID A. SCHMIDT, Division 6, of the Bureau, by telephone who instructed that the Boston Division telephone this information to Charlotte and follow it with a confirming teletype. SA TANNIAN advised that all leads in this matter are being handled on a most expedite basis.

At 12:20 A. M., 4/7/68, the above information was furnished to SA ROBERT H. CAVERLY at Fayetteville, N. C.

Re Boston teletype to Bureau, Charlotte and Memphis

RE: GEORGE WILBUR BREECE

WILLIAM JOYNER, Bureau of Identification, Fayetteville, N. C., PD, advised 4/7/68, BREECE is son of J. WILBUR BREECE who operates funeral home at 123 Bow St., Fayetteville, N. C., which is located directly across the street from the PD.

JOYNER is acquainted with BREECE and saw him last week in Fayetteville in U. S. Army fatigues. He was driving a late-model green automobile, believed to be a Mustang or Cougar, and over the sun visor was a sign with the words "Army Mortuary Service".

JOYNER stated BREECE is of similar stature and bears a resemblance to composite photograph of suspect in KING assassination; however, the nose on the photograph is too long for BREECE.

Desk Sgt. STEVENSON, Provost Marshal's Office, Ft. Bragg, N. C., advised his records contain "as of 2/29/68" the name of Specialist Fourth Class GEORGE W. BREECE, ASN RA 12981065, who was assigned to the Headquarters Co., U. S. Army Garrison, Ft. Bragg, N. C.

Sgt. BURKE, Headquarters Co., USAG, Ft. Bragg, N. C., advised he has no records available at this time of the morning to indicate whereabouts or duty status of BREECE but stated these records would be available in the later morning hours or possibly by Monday morning.

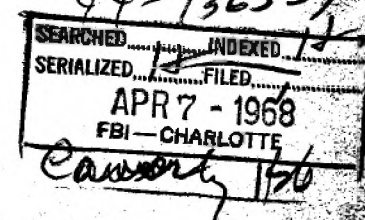

IT WAS DISCUSSED AT SCHOOL THAT IF ROBERT DE PUGH, LEADER OF MINUTEMEN, WAS EVER ARRESTED "STRIKE TEAM" WOULD ASSASSINATE MARTIN LUTHER KING AND VARIOUS GOVERNMENTAL OFFICIALS TO CREATE DIVERSION THEREBY MAKING IT POSSIBLE TO RESCUE DE PUGH. BUMGARDNER NOTED DE PUGH PRESENTLY WANTED BY FEDERAL AUTHORITIES. 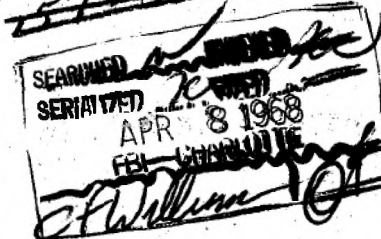

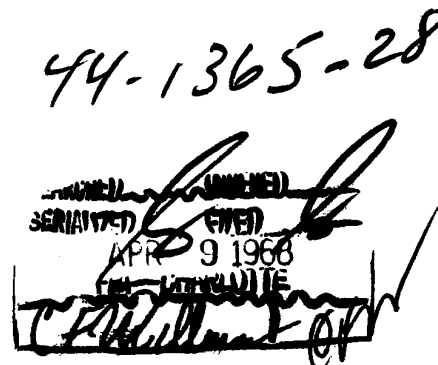

This is the case involving the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., on April 4, 1968, at Memphis, Tennessee.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES, should anyone be told this investigation is being conducted in connection with captioned matter.

It has been determined that a rifle abandoned near the scene of the crime was purchased by an individual using the name HARVEY LOWMEYER or LOWMYER. This individual was described as a white male, thirty-six years of age, five feet eight inches, one hundred fifty to one hundred sixty pounds, black or dark brown hair.

In view of the unusual nature of the names LOWMEYER and LOWMYER, all offices should immediately check your indices, all city directories, all telephone directories covering your territory, all driver's license records, all automobile registration records and credit and criminal records on the surnames LOWMEYER and LOWMYER. In view of the unusual nature of the names, do not confine your check to HARVEY LOWMEYER and LOWMYER only. Any individuals identified as bearing the surname LOWMEYER or LOWMYER should be immediately checked out covering the pertinent period. You should also appropriately check out all bombing suspects in your territory, handle IMMEDIATELY, and give TOP PRIORITY ATTENTION.

The Bureau advised that the Bureau files contain no information identifiable with HARVEY LOWMEYER or LOWMYER.

The Raleigh Resident Agency is attempting to handle all voter registration records and is checking driver's license, automobile registration, and selective service records. All telephone directories are being checked at Charlotte.

In order to comply with Bureau instructions, all city directories and credit and identification records are to be checked immediately in every county in the state. The search should not be confined solely to LOWMEYER or LOWMYER but should also include variations and possible spellings of the surname. Possibilities include LOHMIER, LOHMAIER, LOMEYER, et cetera.

As pointed out by the Bureau, these checks should not be confined to any first name, but any individual identified as bearing the surname should be immediately checked out covering the pertinent period. The pertinent period in this case is March 29-30, 1968, and April 4, 1968. It has been determined that the rifle found near the scene of the crime was purchased in Birmingham, Alabama on March 30, 1968.

Any positive results should be immediately furnished Charlotte by telephone. Negative results should be recorded in memorandum.

By airtel dated 4/6/68, the Memphis Office instructed that Charlotte and other offices canvass criminal informants, security informants and racial informants for possible knowledge concerning assassination with specific emphasis directed toward informants in known hate groups.

All Agents are instructed to immediately contact criminal, security and racial informants. Positive information should be telephonically furnished Charlotte Office. Negative information should be included in a memorandum captioned "MURKIN" to reach Charlotte no later than 4/12/68.

Due to the emphasis being placed on this case, the deadline of 4/12/68 must be met without fail.

He advises he received 1967 Christmas leave, at which time he headed to the West Coast. While he states he was probably hitchhiking from Texas to Louisiana on Thursday, 4/4/68, he is vague concerning his location and SIMPSON is obviously in need of mental care. However, SIMPSON is similar in facial appearance to the artist's sketch of the UNSUB drawn by Memphis artist BILL HARRINGTON and carried in the Beaumont, Texas, Enterprise morning newspaper of 4/6/68.

The Latent Fingerprint Section is requested to compare the major case prints of SIMPSON with those reportedly found on the rifle or other latents submitted by the Memphis Division and advise interested offices as to findings.
