

She added she did not know anyone by these names.

On 4/11/68 Mrs. MAMLE MATHIS, residing at Box 245, Route 2, Clinton, N. C., furnished the following information:

MATHIS stated her daughter, BONNIE LEONE PETERSON, is the owner of a 1962 Rambler 4-door bearing 1968 N. C. license HF-7050. She stated on 4/5/68 her daughter told her she was leaving Clinton in search of employment, and hadded she would call her when she got settled. MATHIS stated she believes she was in the company of an individual named JOSEPH LUNCEFORD. She stated also that her daughter had one of her children, a 5 year old boy with her. MATHIS stated she received a telephone call from her daughter on 4/6/68. At this time her daughter told her she was in a town near West Palm Beach, Fla., but she did not indicate the exact location. On 4/10/68, Captain ROBERT GODWIN, Raleigh, N.C., Police Dept., advised a confidential source had advised him on this date of the Kollowing:

One JEFF CROWELL, Wadesboro, N.C., should be considered as a possible suspect in captioned matter. CROWELL in some respects appears similar to the artist's conception of the Unsub. CROWELL has a nose and receding hairline similar to artist's conception.

CROWELL worked for the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Co., Charlotte, N.C., until approximately two years ago, selling yellow page advertising. At that time he drove a late model red Mustang with an extra powerful engine. He also had a Citizens Band Radio in the car and always a rifle, type unknown. CROWELL is originally from the Wadesboro, N.C., area but continually traveled throughout N.C. for Southern Bell, and on weekends it was his habit to travel out of the state on vacation. Consequently, he maintained no permanent residence.

He admitted membership in the UKA in Wadesboro, N.C., was known to have UKA literature in his car and although he was a quiet individual, he talked strongly on occasion about his feelings in favor of segregation and UKA philosophy.

The last time the source heard of CROWELL was about 18 months ago, at which time he was self-employed with another former telephone company employee selling some type of copy equipment from an office-house located at Independence Blvd. and The Plaza, Charlotte, N.C.
