

AND CLAIMS HE IS CERTAIN THERE IS NO ASSOCIATION BETWEEN ROOMERS LEE, ANDERSON AND GALT. WITH REGARD TO JONES, HE FEELS JONES WAS TRUTHFUL WHEN HE SAID HE DID NOT KNOW MAN RESIDING IN ROOM NUMBER TWO. ROOM NUMBER TWO WAS OCCUPIED BY GALT. IN ESSENCE, GARNER'S STORY RE GALT'S ACTIVITIES IS AS FOLLOWS:

ERIC S. GALT CHECKED INTO GARNER'S ROOMING HOUSE MARCH TWENTYFOUR LAST. HE PAID TEN DOLLARS IN ADVANCE THROUGHT MARCH THREE ONE LAST. HE DROVE IN A WHITE CAR WHICH HE PARKED IN THE REAR OF THE APARTMENTS. ONE OF HIS PERMANENT TENANTS WHO PARKS IN THE SAME AREA ADVISED GARNER THE CAR WAS A WHITE MUSTANG. ON MARCH THREE ONE LAST, GALT PAID ANOTHER WEEK IN ADVANCE.

GARNER TALKED TO GALT ONLY TWICE AND SAW HIM ONLY TWICE. GARNER HAD VERY LITTLE TO SAY TO HIM. GALT LIVED IN ROOM TWO. ACCORDING TO GARNER, GALT HAD A LOT OF "STUFF", INCLUDING A TV. GARNER LET HIM USE A SMALL STORAGE ROOM ADJACENT TO GALT'S ROOM. ON FRIDAY, APRIL FIVE LAST, WHEN THE LINENS

WERE CHANGED IN GALT'S ROOM, HE FOUND A NOTE FROM GALT TO GARNER WHICH GARNER HAS SINCE DESTROYED. THIS NOTE SAID IF EFFECT "I HAVE TO GO TO BIRMINGHAM. CAN'T TAKE THE TV NOW. WILL TRY TO GET BACK IN A WEEK TO PICK IT UP."

GARNER WAS RE-INTERVIEWED ON THE AFTERNOON OF APRIL FIFTEEN AND DID NOT FURNISH ANY SUBSTANTIAL INFORMATION DIFFERENT FROM THAT FURNISHED IN HIS SECOND INTERVIEW. TV SET, MAPS AND OTHER THINGS FOUND IN STORAGE ROOM BEING SUBMITTED TO FBI LAB.

On 4/15/68, Mr. R. C. McDOWELL, Manager, Merchants Patrol, Inc., 101 E. Blvd., Charlotte, N. C., was contacted and McDOWELL furnished the following:

On 4/14/68, McDOWELL and his wife were traveling from Charlotte, N. C., to Spartanburg, S. C., when he noticed a man walking in the opposite direction along Highway I-85. The man appeared to McDOWELL to fit the description of the individual mentioned in the newspapers as the man who was involved in the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING. McDOWELL said he turned his car around and headed in the direction the man was walking. McDOWELL picked the man up and the unidentified man told him he was from Virginia and had been to Florida where he had been working on a shrimp boat. McDOWELL advised he stopped for gas and told the gas attendant to call the Gastonia, N. C., police because the man was suspicious. McDOWELL then headed towards Gastonia, N. C., where he intended to drive to the police department. At the first intersection of I-85 the man got out of the car and said he would get another ride from there. As the man walked down the road a Gastonia police car drove by and picked the individual up.


