The following investigation was conducted by SA DANIEL P. BRADY on 4/26/68, at High Point, N. C.:

Mrs. PEGGY FOISTER, 416 Rock Spring Rd., telephone 882-2751, advised that age 15, resided at her residence from the early part of 11/67, until he flew back to Mexico City / Mexico, from High Point on 4/6/68. Mrs. FOISTER stated that was invited by her and her husband, WILLIAM FOISTER, to come to the U.S. and stay at their residence during this period of time. Mrs. FOISTER stated she and her husband have known and his family for a number of years, and she felt this would be a good opportunity for the boy to learn about America and to improve his English. On 4/26/68, HAROLD DAYID MC GEE, 404 Berkshire Rd., Charlotte, N. C., advised/that he has been employed by Stylecraft Packing Service / 2900 Griffith St., Charlotte, in the Bag Department, on the 3:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. shift since 12/1/67. He stated his wife, ETHEL, is employed by Southern Bell Telephone Co. as a service assistant at the Caldwell St. Building for the past seven years. He stated they have been married nine years and have two children, a boy, five years, and a girl, four years. He stated he has not made any trips out of Charlotte other than to his home in Spruce Pine, N. C., as he and his wife are both from Spruce Pine.

He stated he has frequently discussed with friends, neighbors and fellow employees the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING. He stated he has no pertinent information concerning KING's murder, but often in conversations has made the statement, as have a lot of other acquaintances during conversations, that it apparently was a professional job and the killer did a pretty good job in keeping from being caught.

He stated he and other individuals have often mentioned the fact that KING would probably be assassinated in view of his racial activities, and may have stated on occasion, he could have been assassinated in Charlotte as well as Memphis or any other place he might visit.

MC GEE stated he has never had any information at all concerning the murder or the whereabouts of subject RAY, and he has never heard any individual mention the fact that they knew KING would be murdered. He stated he has never participated in any type of racial activity.

MC GEE stated he was absent from work for about three weeks, having been in an automobile accident near Shelby, N. He stated he has ten brothers and sisters scattered from Texas, Colorado, Florida and in North Carolina; and his wife has a sister in Washington, D. C., who is head of Forbes Personnel Service, and she has a sister in Hickory, N. C., as well as one sister who is not married, BARBARA SUE FORBES, who is employed by Grandfather's Children's Home at Banner Elk, N. C. He stated BARBARA FORBES visited his wife and him for about a week while she was looking for a job in Charlotte, and recently returned to Banner Elk about three or four days ago; and other than that, they have had no company. He stated he has never expressed any opinions regarding KING's murder in any letters to relatives or friends.





He described DAVIS as a white male, about 45 years of age, who was a road grader operator and also a heavy drinker. Chief ELLISON informed that DAVIS desired that he, ELLISON, travel to Wilson, N. C., and take him, DAVIS, into custody for the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING. ELLISON again pointed out that DAVIS is a drinker and had been arrested several times by the Colonial Heights, Va. PD, during the time he was employed as a grader operator in the Colonial Heights area sometime ago. CHARLOTTE AT WILSON, N. C.
