Intensive investigation by Atlanta to date has not established mode of transportation RAY may have used after 4/5/68. Receiving Offices were requested in reairtel to check cars recovered their division that were stolen from the State of Georgia subsequent to 4/4/68, and where the transporter of same was not identified or otherwise accounted for, investigation should be conducted to determine if RAY was person who may have stolen and transported same.

Investigation reflects Subject RAY can be placed in the Atlanta, Georgia, area 3/24/68.

In view of the above, all Continental Offices are requested to review car recoveries within their respective territories of cars stolen from the State of Georgia subsequent to 3/23/68, and where the transporter of same is not otherwise eliminated or accounted for, consider Subject RAY as suspect. Where there is any remote indication that Subject RAY may have been person transporting such a car, exhaustive and intensive investigation should thereafter be conducted.

of 11/67, until he flew back to Mexico City, Mexico,
from High Point on 4/6/68. Mrs. FOISTER stated that
[REDACTED] was invited by her and her husband, WILLIAM FOISTER,
to come to the U. S. and stay at their residence during
this period of time. Mrs. FOISTER stated she and her
husband have known [REDACTED] and his family for a number
of years, and she felt this would be a good opportunity
for the boy to learn about America and to improve his
English. Mrs. FOISTER stated she and her husband obtained
permission from the Superintendent of Schools, High Point,
N. C., to have [REDACTED] attend Northeast Junior High School,
High Point, while staying at their residence. According
to Mrs. FOISTER, [REDACTED] came to High Point on a student
visa and after spending this period of time at her residence
and attending classes at Northeast Junior High School, he
returned to Mexico City.

Mrs. MARIE SECHREST, Secretary, Northeast
Junior High School, High Point, N. C., advised that [REDACTED]
DOB [REDACTED] was residing at the residence
of Mr. and Mrs. WILLIAM FOISTER, 416 Rock Spring Rd.,
High Point, after arriving in this country from Mexico
during the early part of 11/67. Mrs. SECHREST stated Mr.
and Mrs. FOISTER obtained permission from the Superintendent

On the morning of 4/26/68, SA RANDOLPH TROW of the Richmond Office telephonically advised that earlier today Chief of Police ROBERT ELLISON, Colonial Heights, Va., received a call from EARL DAVIS, Rt. 1, Box 265, Wilson, N. C., telephone 234-5967. DAVIS is a heavy equipment operator, a white male, age about 45, who has worked around Colonial Heights in the past, possibly several months ago.

DAVIS desired that Chief ELLISON come to Wilson and take him into custody for the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING.

On the morning of 4/26/68, this information was telephonically furnished to SA JAMES E. CALLAHAN, JR. at Rocky Mount. He was instructed to immediately determine the whereabouts of DAVIS on 3/29-30/68 and 4/4/68, to determine if he looks like JAMES RAY EARL and to interview DAVIS regarding his statements to Chief ELLISON.

and to engage them in conversation so that they leave the credit cards behind. He advised that WILLIAMS has girls that he sends out to make purchases on these credit cards and then to either bring the goods or send the goods to him. He advised that WILLIAMS has Texaco Credit Cards as well as other oil company credit cards and American Express Cards. He said that WILLIAMS has even obtained mink stoles through the fraudulent use of these credit cards.

CE 2243-C said that WILLIAMS is "in with the police chief" in Atlanta & that he has the book published by the Texaco Oil Co. reflecting those credit cards which have been stolen.

On 4/17/68, CE 2243-C advised that MELVIN MC CLEASE STOKLEY (CE 88-10315) currently lives & works in Long Island, N.Y. He said that STOKLEY is currently working at a potato farm or grader in the Long Island area. He advised that on an irregular basis, STOKLEY return to N.C. & that on 4/4/68, STOKLEY was in Elizabeth City, N.C., to pick up his clothes at a cleaner on S. Road St. in Elizabeth City. This cleaning establishment is operated by NAOMI (LNU) who will not be cooperative if interviewed.

On 4/17/68, CE 2243-C was contacted concerning CE 44-814 captioned LESLIE ATKINSON, Aka, Et Al. CE 2243-C said that he spoke with LESLIE ATKINSON during week of 4/7/68 & at that time ATKINSON advised that many arrests were made in Saigon or Thailand for fraudulent use of military identification cards. ATKINSON told him that info concerning these arrests appeared in the local military newspaper in that country. He advised that ATKINSON said he intends to remain in Goldsboro, NC, because he feels if he returns to Saigon or Thailand that he would be arrested as have the others who were there.

CE 2243-C said that he was informed by ATKINSON that the club which has been the front for the illegal activities is still in operation but that it is no longer making or using military identification cards for the purpose of obtaining money orders.

CE 137-3261

On 4/17/68, CE 2243-C advised that he is not familiar with BENJAMIN JUDSON WOOD, III, Aka John Amanda or Morgan J. Belt. He said that he has heard the name of SIDNEY BLANCHARD, WOOD's uncle, & would make inquiries as to his residence in Hertford, NC.

On 4/19/68, CE 2243-C advised that BLANCHARD resides at 238 Market St, in Hertford, NC. He said that he would continue to make inquiries concerning subject, BENJAMIN WOOD.

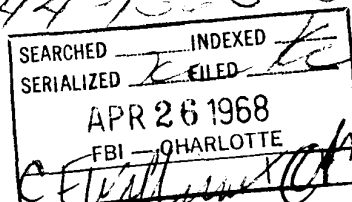

On 4/26/68, HAROLD DAVID MC GEE, 404 Berkshire Rd., Charlotte, N. C., advised that he has been employed by Stylecraft Packing Service, 2900 Griffith St., Charlotte, in the Bag Department, on the 3:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. shift since 12/1/67. He stated his wife, ETHEL, is employed by Southern Bell Telephone Co. as a service assistant at the Caldwell St. Building for the past seven years. He stated they have been married nine years and have two children, a boy, five years, and a girl, four years. He stated he has not made any trips out of Charlotte other than to his home in Spruce Pine, N. C., as he and his wife are both from Spruce Pine.

He stated he has frequently discussed with friends, neighbors and fellow employees the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING. He stated he has no pertinent information concerning KING's murder, but often in conversations has made the statement, as have a lot of other acquaintances during conversations, that it apparently was a professional job and the killer did a pretty good job in keeping from being caught.

He stated he and other individuals have often mentioned the fact that KING would probably be assassinated in view of his racial activities, and may have stated on occasion, he could have been assassinated in Charlotte as well as Memphis or any other place he might visit.

MC GEE stated he has never had any information at all concerning the murder or the whereabouts of subject RAY, and he has never heard any individual mention the fact that they knew KING would be murdered. He stated he has never participated in any type of racial activity.

CE 44-1365

MC GEE stated he was absent from work for about three weeks, having been in an automobile accident near Shelby, N. C.; on 3/2/68, while en route to Spruce Pine and was in a Shelby hospital for a week with facial lacerations and a leg injury, and upon his release, spent two weeks at home prior to returning to work.

He stated he has ten brothers and sisters scattered from Texas, Colorado, Florida and in North Carolina; and his wife has a sister in Washington, D. C., who is head of Forbes Personnel Service, and she has a sister in Hickory, N. C., as well as one sister who is not married, BARBARA SUE FORBES, who is employed by Grandfather's Children's Home at Banner Elk, N. C. He stated BARBARA FORBES visited his wife and him for about a week while she was looking for a job in Charlotte, and recently returned to Banner Elk about three or four days ago; and other than that, they have had no company. He stated he has never expressed any opinions regarding KING's murder in any letters to relatives or friends.

On 4/26/68, Mr. ERNEST GADDY, Stylecraft Packing Service, 2900 Griffith, Charlotte, advised that his records reflect that DAVID MC GEE was in an automobile accident on 3/2/68, and was off work until 3/20/68, when he returned and worked three days. However, he was off on Sunday, and returned and worked 3/25 and 26/68, but was off 3/27, 28 and 29/68. According to Mr. GADDY, the time cards reflected that MC GEE worked 4/1-6/68, from 3:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. each night.

MC GEE is described as a white male, age about 30, 5'9", 145 lbs., brown hair, blue eyes, medium complexion, visible new scars on forehead and face.

Enclosed for the FBI Laboratory are two envelopes containing samples of Thermo Seal tapes for comparison with tapes already in possession of FBI Laboratory.

On 4/24/68 Mr. W. K. SUTTON, Superintendent of Laundry, Canton Laundry, Canton, N. C., made available several samples of two machines utilized by his company in the process of laundry. Mr. SUTTON stated that both machines are Thermo-Seal Machines, the Number One Machine having Serial Number 33882, Model No. H5 S4 B1. Mr. SUTTON stated that Machine No. 2 is also a Thermo-Seal Machine with Serial Number 33883, Model No. h5 S4 B1.

SUTTON advised that he has used the code "20 R-3" in the past. He said the 20 is the lot number, the R designates the week, and the 3 designates the package which corresponds with the customer's name. He advised that his tickets are kept in no particular order and that it would entail a review of thousands of tickets in an effort to locate those carrying this number.

The FBI Laboratory is requested to compare enclosed Thermo-Seal tags with tapes already in the Bureau's possession.

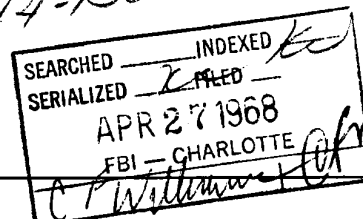

On 4/25/68, J. C. MORTON was telephonically contacted and advised he would be personally contacted by the FBI on 4/26/68, at 2:00 p.m.

On 4/26/68, J. C. MORTON, Oxford, N. C., advised during March and the early part of April, 1968, he was vacationing at St. Thomas, Virgin Islands; and that on 4/24/68, while reading Time Magazine, he noticed the pictures of JAMES EARL RAY, and thought he had seen an individual of similar description while in St. Thomas, Virgin Islands. MORTON further advised on 4/6/68, at about 8:00 or 9:00 p.m., he was at Trader Dan's, C-Amalie, St. Thomas, when he went to the back of the bar in order to speak to JIM SHULP (phonetic), the bar owner; and on his way to the back of the bar, an individual who was apparently intoxicated reached over and pulled his shirt out of his pants. MORTON advised he did not speak to this individual because of the individual's apparently intoxicated condition, and proceeded back to the rear of the bar to talk to the owner.
