

Being forwarded under separate cover is a supply of newspaper mats and proofs for expeditious distribution to all cooperative daily and weekly newspapers in your territory. Additional publications such as shoppers' guides should not be overlooked in obtaining the greatest possible publicity regarding this fugitive.

In most cases, these mats and proofs may be distributed by mail but when circumstances warrant they may be personally delivered by Special Agents. A form letter over the signature of the Special Agent in Charge may be utilized in distributing this material by mail and this letter should point out that the FBI is requesting the aid of the Nation's press in bringing about the prompt apprehension of this badly sought fugitive.

Prompt distribution should be made and additional supplies, if needed, are available at the Bureau. The following number of mats and proofs are being forwarded to your office under separate cover: 250.

As an additional deans of securing widespread publicity concerning Ray, offices covering the place of publication of magazines which have previously cooperated in publicizing FBI fugitives should request the assistance of such publications in carrying an article on captioned fugitive. The Bureau press release, copies of which are available in each office, along with a glossy photograph of this fugitive can be furnished. JOHN E. WILLARD, certificate number 81056, service number 37145, was employed in the Chicago, Illinois South Central District as an agent from July 13, 1964 to January 8, 1965. WILLARD left the company and owed the company \$498.85 in collected premium funds which were not turned in. Thereafter the company made numerous efforts to collect this money from him and began efforts to locate him for contact in 1966. On October 27, 1966, the company put out a broadcast of disappearance for JOHN E. WILLARD and distributed this to various credit agencies throughout the United States. The Chicago, Illinois Credit Bureau reported to the National Life and Accident Insurance Company thereafter that they had determined that WILLARD was last known to be residing at 2564 South Blue Island Avenue, Chicago, and had previously been employed by the Gateway Transport Company.

A former address of 5202 South Maplewood Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, was indicated. WILLARD is a white male, born , 5'11", 203 pounds, and is married to IRENE JOY WILLARD, born . The Chicago Credit Bureau reported that they were divorced or separated. Born to this union were three children,

Mr. TENNISON stated that this was a regular occurrence in that insurance agents would work for a period of time and quit owing the company money, and an effort would be made to locate them. He advised that this stop notice has been distributed throughout the United States and to this date WILLARD has not been located by the company and no restitution on these funds made.

Enclosed for Atlanta is one copy of referenced airtel and two photographs developed from questioned television tape. "AV" WESTIN, Director, Public Broadcast Laboratory (PBL), 342 Madison Avenue, NYC, on 4/10/65, advised that an assistant would sid the VEI in making available tape on questioned broadcast of 4/7/65. He stated that PBL has had employees following the developments leading up to the "poor people's march on Washington" which was to have been led by Rev. MARTIN LUTHER KING in the Spring of 1968. He stated that the questioned portion of the broadcast was produced by CREG SHUKER of PEL. on 1/19/68, FBL made available two film excerpts from the broadcast of 4/7/68 which shows two white males in Bureau Atlanta (Encls. 3) - Memphis (INFO) 44-2386-1100 1- New York JB:jmr APR 3 0 1968 44-1114-358 2025 RELEASE UNDER E.O. 14176

NY 44-1609 background of photograph, either of which could represent the person referred to by Dr. IRVING HAIL of Iradenton, Florida. It is further noted, however, that others in the room made similar remarks about the "poor white people getting screwed" if KING led the march. It is noted that one individual, which according to the tape was located in the area of, or next to, the Negro moderator, who was HOSHA WILLIAMS, seemed to be pulling at his left ear lobe as depicted in the enclosed excerpt from the film. CREG SHUKER, Producer, PRL, stated he was in the room during the filming of this sequence of events and identified the location as Paschal's Hotel, located on Hunter Street, Atlanta, Georgia. He stated he personally recalls most of the participants in the discussion other than the man with his hand up to his ear. He stated that the Southern Christian Leadership Conference Headquarters (SCLC) in Atlanta is believed to have a list of all persons attending this discussion. He stated that the events took place on 3/14/08 and that BILL RUTHERFORD, Executive Director, and TCM OFFEMBERG, Public Relations, SCLC, Office # (404)-522-1420, possibly could furnish names of all persons in the room. RUTHERFORD's home number was given as 523-3381 and that of OFFEMBERG, who is Director of the March as 522-1425. SHUKER stated that other groups and races of people were meeting at the time in the same motel in connection with the upcoming march, but indicated that the group in question was basically white and that HOSFA WILLIAMS came in late only to answer their questions and to convince them that KING would lead and speak for all the poor people, regardless of race, in the March on Washington. SHUKER is in the process of preparing a copy of the entire tape for the FEI which is to be made available to the MNO possibly today, 4/22/08. On 4/11/68 Dr. IRVING HALL, 712 39th Street W., Bradenton, Fla., telephonically advised the Sarasota RA that between the hours of approximately 8:00 and 10:00 p.m. 4/7/68 he and his wife viewed a television program over channel 3, educational television station WEDU-TV, Tampa, Florida. HALL stated the program was a panel-type discussion concerning the study of the march on Washington that was to be lead by Rev. MARTIN LUTHER KING in the Spring of 1968. HALL stated a white male who was a member of the panel who was sitting on the floor near a Negro who was standing and who was the moderator made several comments that dealt with KING leading the march. The white male, according to HALL, reportedly made a comment to the effect, "If KING leads the march on Washington the march will be a Negro march and the poor white people will be getting screwed."

HALL stated that upon viewing the artist's conception of the assassin of KING and comparing the description that had been set forth in local newspapers regarding the assassin, he believes the white male on the above television program who made remarks critical of KING's leadership appeared a similar description to the artist's conception of the assassin.

Mr. R. LEROY LASTINGER, General Manager, WEDU-TV, Educational Television Channel 3, 908 South 20th Street, Tampa, on 4/12/68 advised from approximately 8:30 to 10:30 p.m.

### POSSIBLE RACIAL VIOLENCE MAJOR URBAN AREAS

On April 17, 1968, Doris Hill, an employee of Stoyas Drugs, 1145 Bryn Mawr, Chicago, Illinois, telephonically advised that an individual had come into the drugstore around 11:40 p.m., April 16, 1968, and stated that he was the person who shot Dr. Martin Luther King. He stated he had fired the shot that would start the third world war and would finish it May 1, 1968, by causing a holocaust in Chicago, Illinois, that would make Hiroshima and Nagasaki look like child's play.

The individual described as a white male, age 35, height, 5'  $9\frac{1}{2}$ ", 180 pounds, placed two long distance calls from a pay phone at the drugstore. The calls were made to Dr. David Horton, in Mobile, Alabama, who was believed to live on St. Dominick Street, in Mobile.

Other patrons of the drugstore advised Hill that this individual had earlier been in Teddy's Lounge, at Bryn Mawr and Kenmore Streets. This individual had never been in the drugstore before. He did not appear to be intoxicated, but was quite irrational.

On April 18, 1968, Dr. David Horton, University of South Alabama, Mobile, advised that on April 15, 1968, his wife's brother, Tom Glamore of 9726 Franklin Avenue, Franklin Park, Illinois, called from Chicago, Illinois, and requested Dr. Horton to send him money to buy a television set. Dr. Horton advised this was the first contact with Glamore since 1966, when he, Glamore, ran away from St. Louis, Missouri, believing the Hortons planned to commit him to a mental institution. He stated Glamore raved and was very incoherent. Glamore called again collect on Tuesday, April 16, 1968. Dr. Horton accepted the first call, but as Glamore was extremely belligerent and raved on the phone in an incoherent

Dr. Horton advised Glamore is about 47 years of age, a veteran of World War II and is extremely mentally ill. Dr. Horton advised he felt Glamore should be committed, but hospitals keep releasing him as not being a violent type. Dr. Horton advised Glamore has an obsession that the Mafia is after him and Glamore also told him that Stan Musial killed Dr. Martin Luther King, Glamore has been hospitalized numerous times in the past, according to Dr. Horton with one hospitalization in Downey Veterans Administration Hospital, near Chicago, but he did not know when Glamore had last been in a mental hospital. As a result of his mental condition, Glamore is unable to hold a job and Dr. Horton was unable to furnish any additional information concerning his present condition. One copy each of this letterhead memorandum is being furnished the United States Attorney, Chicago, the United States Secret Service, Chicago, and Region I, 113th MI Group, Evanston, Illinois. He also stated that he believed the individual purchased gas on a temporary Pure Oil Credit Card, which he believes expires in August or September, 1968. He also advised that the credit card slips were purchases on April 16, 1968, and had already been forwarded to the Pure Oil Company Retail Department, Palatine, Illinois.

On April 26, 1968, Mr. CLYDE E. PHODES, Accounting Department, Pure Oil Company, Palatine, Illinois, was telephonically contacted by SA RENE J. DUMAINE, at which time he advised that the package of credit card slips mailed in by Mr. JONES on April 17, 1968, would already be in the Balance process, Accounting Department, and would take until at least April 30, 1968, to locate. He said it is possible that he would be able to locate the credit card slips mailed in on April 22, 1968. He requested that he be furnished with the Transmittal Slip number used by JONES in submitting the credit card transactions.

In a continuing review of Pure Oil Company records, in conjunction with Mr. RHODES and THOMAS DAVINI by SA ROBERT F. PEVAHOUSE on April 29 and 30, 1968, located the list of credit card invoices submitted by Mr. JONES on April 18, 1968. Credit card purchase number was made by Lt. Col. WILKERSON, however, the invoice itself could not be located and the address was not yet in file. The charge for credit card number is another company credit card and the ticket has arready been separated elsewhere. No further effort will be made to locate this card in view of the comments made by Mr. JONES. It should be noted that this review did not reveal any purchase made on a temporary Pure Oil Credit Card.
