By airtel dated 4/7/69, the Bureau advised Birmingham (44-1740), Jackson (157-9586) and Memphis (44-1987) of the following information:

WILLIAM BRADFORD HUIE has written a third article for "Look" magazine. The article appears in the issued dated April 15, 1969, but this issued was circulated on April 1, 1969. A review of the article reveals that JAMES EARL RAY allegedly registered at the Travelodge Motel, Five Points, Birmingham, Alabama, on March 29, 1968; at a motel near Florence, Alabama, on April 1, 1968; and at a motel near Corinth, Mississippi, on April 2, 1968. It is to be noted that RAY, using the name HARVEY LOWMYER, negotiated the purchase of a rifle at the Aeromarine Supply Company, Birmingham, Alabama, on March 29 and 30, 1968. On April 3, 1968, he was registered at the Rebel Motel, in Memphis, Tennessee.

The Bureau instructed that appropriate investigation should be conducted by Birmingham and Jackson in an effort to establish whether or not RAY was in contact with any individuals immediately prior to the assassination. Birmingham and Jackson were instructed to make inquiry at motels in or near the above cities to determine identities of individuals registered the period 3/29/68 to 4/3/68 and that efforts should be made to identify all individuals listed as well as obtaining descriptions and registrations of automobiles of such persons.

This investigation is directed toward determining if any one individuals might have accompanied RAY or been in contact with him during this period.

Ray was found with \$500 in

The bulk of the stolen money and four other men are still being sought by police.

A review of the closed section regarding 44-1114 reflects that there are 20 volumes, including sub files, in the MURKIN matter. It was also determined in that regard that the case agent at that time was RENEE DU MAINE, who has long been transferred to another division, and that other agents assisting him are no longer available within the Chicago Division. With that in mind, I discussed the matter of a coordinator with SA JOSEPH P. MC CABE of the S-5 Squad, who was more than agreeable to serve in that capacity in connection with captioned matters. It is pointed out that SA MC CABE has had considerable experience in coordinating various projects in the security field within the Chicago Division.

It is noted that the above mentioned Bureau Supervisor stated that the Task Force would have access to all of our Chicago files, including "JUNE" files, but excepting informant files. I was also informed that a teletype setting forth complete and comprehensive instructions in this matter would be forthcoming within the next few days.


