Attached hereto are Xerox copies of pertinent serials basically relating to JOSEPH JOHN GAFFNEY which should be reviewed in detail by Agents assigned this lead.

Briefly, <u>PFC STEPHEN CLARK LANE</u>, U.S. Army, in March, 1967, reported that he had attended school with GAFFNEY who was an Army reservist at Fort Holabard, Maryland. LANE claimed that GAFFNEY told him that he was a member of a two-man sabotage group working for the Minutemen. This Minutemen team was allegedly going to assassinate MARTIN LUTHER KING.

Subsequent investigation was conducted regarding this allegation. The Army desired that LANE's identity be protected.

On April 7, 1967, GAFFNEY was interviewed at his residence at 285 Elm Park Avenue. Elmhurst, Illinois. He is a white male, born at Chicago, 6½" tall, 155 pounds, brown hair, blue eyes, residence phone number 832-6161 (with parents, Mr. and Mrs. JOSEPH W. GAFFNEY). GAFFNEY said he joined the U.S. Army Reserve on April 2, 1966, and went on active duty for six months August 29, 1966. After completing basic training at Fort Benning, Georgia, he returned home for several weeks leave at the end of October, 1966, and thereafter, attended Intelligence School at Fort Holabard, Maryland, and left active military service on February 4, 1967.

GAFFNEY related that while he was home on leave he associated with ORVILLE BRETTMAN, a long-time friend. During their conversations, BRETTMAN mentioned the Minutemen organization and BRETTMAN furnished GAFFNEY with several Minutemen flyers. BRETTMAN was reported to be in the Marine Corps and according to the Chicago file has never been interviewed.

that referenced tel of 3/25/67, reflected JOSEPH GAFFNEY as a source of information concerning the threat to KING; however, subsequent contact with Region 1, 113th MI Group determined original information furnished to the Chicago Office was erroneous and that actual source of information is STEPHEN CLARK LANE, PFC, U. S. Army, assigned Germany, Information apparently was received by 66th MI group, Germany, on 3/2/67, when LANE contacted that station and according to information received from GORDON TYLER, Region 1, 113th INTC Group, Evanston, Illinois, on 3/28/67, LANE has furnished two sworn signed statements concerning the alleged threat to KING by a Minutemen assassination team. Information was telephonically provided to the 113th MI Group in Evanston on 3/25/67, when military authorities in Germany learned of KING's presence in Chicago on that date.

Mr. TYLER advised on 3/28/67, that his group is awaiting copies of above referred to signed statements by LANE and stated on receipt of same, copies will be made available to the Chicago Office. TYLER also advised that Region 1, 113th MI Group will furnish the Chicago Office with additional pertinent data as it is received by his agency. TYLER stated that information as orally furnished on 3/25/67, was correct as received telephonically by his group, however, subsequent communications received reported LANE as source of information and that GAFFNEY was the individual who attempted to recruit LANE as part of an assassination team. According to TYLER, GAFFNEY reportedly currently resides in the Chicago area and is not now on active duty although he is still apparently a member of the Army reserves.

Chicago indices contain no references to the name JOSEPH GAFFNEY and no identifiable references to JOEY ORHM (phonetic) and (FNU) ARMENTO (phonetic), based on available data.

As the Bureau is aware ROBERT DE PUGH, National leader of the Minutemen, was recently in Chicago where he made a speech before approximately 150 individuals at the Teutonia Club. Sources contacted at that time advised knew of no organized functioning Minutemen groups in the Chicago grea.

On March 25-28, 1967, representatives of Region 1, 113th MI Group, Evanston, Illinois, made available information concerning an alleged plot to assassinate Martin Luther King, Jr. as such information was received by that agency:

States Army, assigned in Germany, Serial Number , on March 2, 1967, contacted the 66th MI Group in Germany and advised that in December, 1966, while a student at Fort Holabird, Maryland, met and associated with Joseph J. Gaffney whose home residence was on Elm Park Avenue, Elmhurst, Illinois. Lane advised that Gaffney was a student at Fort Holabird at the same time. According to Lane, Gaffney told him that he, Gaffney, was a member of the Minutemen and belonged to a sabotage cell consisting of himself and an unnamed undercover man in the City of Chicago. Lane advised that Gaffney claimed to know the locations of weapons which were stored in Chicago by the Minutemen and allegedly these weapons were stored in a cellar. Lane stated Gaffney told him that when Martin Luther King, Jr. visits Chicago in 1967 that King was to be the target of an assassination attempt by the Minutemen.

On March 28, 1967, a representative of Region 1, advised that inquiry by that agency had verified that Joseph Gaffney had been a student at Fort Holabird in December, 1966, in a reserve status. Further that Lane was also a student at Fort Holabird at that time. This representative also advised that the undercover man allegedly working with Gaffney in Chicago was one Joey Orhm (phonetic) who is supposedly in California now, exact whereabouts unknown. Further that the individual who allegedly stored the arms to assassinate King is one (first name unknown) Armento (phonetic), no address known.

APPENDIX

"MINUTEMEN"

The "Minutemen" was organized in June, 1960, Its present headquarters are Norborne, Missouri, and ROBERT B. DE PUGH, Norborne, Missouri, is the national coordinator. Statements by DE PUGH and literature distributed by the organization in the past indicated its purpose to be the resistance to, and exposure of, the spread of communist influence within the United States; for the formation of a guerrilla or underground organization to combat the troops of any foreign powers which might eventually occupy this country; and resist passage of laws which would regulate private ownership of firearms.

The Kansas City Star Newspaper, Kansas City, Missouri, has on numerous occasions, carried various articles concerning DE PUGH and the "Minutemen," wherein it was stated that members of the organization participate in maneuvers utilizing guerrilla tactics with machine guns, mortars, grenades, and other firearms.

DE PUGH has publicly stated on numerous occasions that the "Minutemen" as an organization does not buy or store arms or ammunition; however, the individual members of the organization maintain arms and ammunition, which is their constitutional right.

"Minutemen" literature mailed to members in the past has furnished instructions in the use of explosives and has also given details for the making of explosive compounds from such readily accessible ingredients as a common fertilizer, ammonium nitrate.

In May, 1966, a confidential source advised that ROBERT B. DE PUGH, in a recent message to the national coordinators of "Minutemen," announced the "Minutemen" organization was being divided into two separate bodies. One group to be composed directly of members who have been able to maintain complete secrecy of their identity, from both the public and from Government investigative agencies. The second group to be made up of all members who have been publicly identified, or who there is reason to believe have been identified as "Minutemen" members by an agency of the Federal Government.

"MINUTEMEN"

In announcing the reorganization, DE PUGH stated that a complete resistance movement involving total resistance must involve not only guerrilla warfare, but that it must involve psychological and political warfare as well.

DE PUGH stated that what he was proposing and trying to effect was to build a political party that as such would have legal immunity, which would serve as a communications network for patriots that have other interests, and among whose members these other patriots can maintain their secrecy of identify. All future correspondence and communications on the mational level will be done in the name of the Patriotic Party. DE PUGH also advised that if ever called to court, as he expected to be in the future, he was going to state that as far as the national organization is concerned, the "Minutemen" had ceased to exist.

DE PUGH, in the announcement, continued to the effect there is no reason why at some future date, when the environment is more conducive to military action, that the Patriotic Party cannot be used once again to pull together various local organizations into one national organization. By acting both as a front and as a means of coordination, the Patriotic Party can be invaluable in the building of a future resistance movement.

AT CHICAGO AND ELMHURST, ILLINOIS. On receipt of previously requested information, Chicago will consider possible interview of GAFFNEY relative to alleged Minutemen organization activities and storage of guns.

ADMINISTRATIVE

It should be noted that when LANE interviewed by the 66th MI Group, Germany, it was the opinion of the interviewing SAs that LANE was truthful and did not hesitate in furnishing information. It should be further noted that LANE was not willing to have the information which he gave released to GAFFNEY either with or without revealing LANE's identity, nor was he willing to appear before a board and/or court proceeding involving GAFFNEY.

On 3/30/67 Mr. GORDON TYLER, Region 1, 113th MI Group, Evanston, Illinois, stated that a list of individuals who associated with GAFFNEY during his stay at Fort Holabird, was in possession of Army Intelligence and advised that they will undoubtedly interview these individuals regarding GAFFNEY. TYLER stated that LANE has declined to take a polygraph test, stating that everything he said was true. Communications furnished by TYLER indicate GAFFNEY allegedly a sensationalist, always attempting to draw attention to himself. GAFFNEY reportedly adopted and an only child. GAFFNEY's father reportedly quite wealthy and employed by Sears and Roebuck Company, Chicago, Illinois.

TYLER advised Baltimore Office in contact with Army Intelligence Headquarters, Fort Holabird, regarding this matter.

Search of Chicago indices revealed no identifiable references regarding JOEY ARMENTO.

Credit and arrest checks at Elmhurst, Illinois, were conducted by SA RUDOLPH H. MANCINI.

On March 30, 1967, a representative of Region 1, 113th Military Intelligence Group, Evanston, Illinois, furnished additional information concerning Joseph J. Gaffney and the reinterview with Stephen Clark Lane, regarding the alleged plot to assassinate Martin Luther King, Jr. The representative stated according to Lane, Gaffney claimed he had been a member of the Minutemen organization since early 1966. Gaffney gave no reasons for his membership within the Minutemen and is not believed to hold any official position. Lane advised to his knowledge no one else at Fort Holabird was knowledgeable of Gaffney's association with the Minutemen. Gaffney stated that he knew of caches of weapons and ammunition allegedly stored in the basement of a house belonging to Joey Armento (phonetic) in Chicago. Gaffney further stated that when Martin Luther King, Jr. next visited Chicago, which was believed to be some time in 1967, Armento, Gaffney, and one (first name unknown) Orhm (phonetic) would be involved in the assassination attempt. Lane further stated that Gaffney, while at Fort Holabird, had received several letters from Ohrm, allegedly a member of a sabotage cell of the Minutemen in Chicago.

Lane stated in one of the above mentioned letters there were three pamphlets concerning the aims and purposes of the Minutemen organization. Gaffney gave one of the three pamphlets to Lane who took it home with him. Lane stated this incident occurred in early December, 1966. Lane stated that Gaffney told him that he was currently in possession of a

sawed-off shotgun, a rifle, a rifle scope, and a .20 caliber pistol.

Lane also advised Gaffney had in his possession while at Fort Holabirda Minox camera which he took to class in a brief case. Lane claimed he was present with Gaffney when Gaffney developed film from the Minox camera but was unable to determine its contents. According to Lane, Gaffney placed the developed film in an envelope and mailed it to an unknown address. Lane stated he never observed Gaffney using the Minox camera at Fort Holabird.

Lane claims that Gaffney implied threats to him if he reported Gaffney taking the camera to class or reported information concerning the Minutemen affilations of Gaffney. Lane claimed fear for his personal safety was the reason he had not previously furnished knowledge of the alleged plot to Army Intelligence.

Gaffney allegedly is a sensationalist who was always attempting to draw attention to himself.

The Du Page Credit Bureau, which serves Elmhurst, Illinois, reflects records for Joseph W. Gaffney, approximately 50 in 1953, residing at 265 Elm Park, Elmhurst, Illinois. He is reported as General Purchasing Agent for 24 years as of 1953 for Sears Roebuck and Company, Chicago.

Elmhurst Police Department records reflect Joseph John Gaffney, white male, age 19, as of December 18, 1966, residing 285 Elm Park, Elmhurst, Illinois, subject of complaint December 18, 1966, as occupant of suspicious car. Police Department investigation revealed no wrong doing and Joseph John Gaffney not arrested.

APPENDIX

"MINUTEMEN"

The "Minutemen" was organized in June, 1960, Its present headquarters are Norborne, Missouri, and ROBERT B. DE PUGH, Norborne, Missouri, is the national coordinator. Statements by DE PUGH and literature distributed by the organization in the past indicated its purpose to be the resistance to, and exposure of, the spread of communist influence within the United States; for the formation of a guerrilla or underground organization to combat the troops of any foreign powers which might eventually occupy this country; and resist passage of laws which would regulate private ownership of firearms.

The Kansas City Star Newspaper, Kansas City, Missouri, has on numerous occasions, carried various articles concerning DE PUGH and the "Minutemen," wherein it was stated that members of the organization participate in maneuvers utilizing guerrilla tactics with machine guns, mortars, grenades, and other firearms.

DE PUGH has publicly stated on numerous occasions that the "Minutemen" as an organization does not buy or store arms or ammunition; however, the individual members of the organization maintain arms and ammunition, which is their constitutional right.

"Minutemen" literature mailed to members in the past has furnished instructions in the use of explosives and has also given details for the making of explosive compounds from such readily accessible ingredients as a common fertilizer, ammonium nitrate.

In May, 1966, a confidential source advised that ROBERT B. DE PUGH, in a recent message to the national coordinators of "Minutemen," announced the "Minutemen" organization was being divided into two separate bodies. One group to be composed directly of members who have been able to maintain complete secrecy of their identity, from both the public and from Government investigative agencies. The second group to be made up of all members who have been publicly identified, or who there is reason to believe have been identified as "Minutemen" members by an agency of the Federal Government.

"MINUTEMEN"

In announcing the reorganization, DE PUGH stated that a complete resistance movement involving total resistance must involve not only guerrilla warfare, but that it must involve psychological and political warfare as well.

DE PUGH stated that what he was proposing and trying to effect was to build a political party that as such would have legal immunity, which would serve as a communications network for patriots that have other interests, and among whose members these other patriots can maintain their secrecy of identify. All future correspondence and communications on the national level will be done in the name of the Patriotic Party. DE PUGH also advised that if ever called to court, as he expected to be in the future, he was going to state that as far as the national organization is concerned, the "Minutemen" had ceased to exist.

DE PUGH, in the announcement, continued to the effect there is no reason why at some future date, when the environment is more conducive to military action, that the Patriotic Party cannot be used once again to pull together various local organizations into one national organization. By acting both as a front and as a means of coordination, the Patriotic Party can be invaluable in the building of a future resistance movement.

He advised there are no files as such concerning LANE and these individuals.

According to HAVRA, GARRNEY was subject of limited favorable background investigation completed June 2, 1986, resulting in his being granted Top Secret clearance for attendance at Intelligence School, Fort Holabird, Maryland. No photograph of GAFFNEY is available.

Re Chicago memorandum dated March 31, 1967, captioned as above.

On March 30, 1967, a representative of Region I, 113th Military Intelligence Group, Evanston, Illinois, advised that Stephen Clark Lane, a member of the United States Army in Germany, furnished information regarding Joseph John Gaffney, Elmhurst, Illinois. Lane and Gaffney served together at Fort Holabird, Maryland, in December, 1966, while Gaffney was on a six months tour of active duty.

During that time Gaffney reportedly told Lane that he was a member of a two man Minuteman sabotage cell in Chicago, Illinois. The other member of this cell, (first name unknown) Orhm (phonetic) was believed to be in California at that time. Gaffney claimed to have knowledge of a storage of arms in the Chicago area and of a plot to assassinate Martin Luther King, Jr., when King visited Chicago in 1967. Gaffney showed Minutemen literature to Lane. Lane claimed Gaffney implied threats to him if he mentioned Gaffney's affiliation in the Minutemen.

According to Lane, Gaffney was a sensationalist who was always attempting to draw attention to himself.

Lane has advised Army representatives he was not willing to have information furnished released to Gaffney either with or without revealing Lane's identity.

Joseph John Gaffney, 285 Elm Park Avenue, Elmhurst, Illinois, was interviewed on April 7, 1967. He adivsed that he joined the United States Army Reserve on April 2, 1966, and went on active duty for a six month period on August 29, 1966. After completing his basic training at Fort Benning, Georgia, he returned home for several weeks leave at the end of October, 1966. He thereafter attended intelligence school at Fort Holabird, Maryland, and left active military service on February 4, 1967.

He said that while he was home on leave he associated with Orville Brettman, a long time friend. During their conversations Brettman mentioned the Minutemen organization, indicating that he belonged and received literature from it. At that time Brettman gave Gaffney several Minutemen printed flyers and told Gaffney that he would obtain Minutemen literature for him. At that time Gaffney assumed that Brettman would probably send his name to this organization to be placed on their mailing list. Gaffney did not give money to anyone for this purpose, and he has never received any information from this organization. He said that while he was at Fort Holabird, Maryland, in December 1966, he received from Brettman, through the mail, a Minutemen newsletter, "On Target."

Gaffney said that he again saw Brettman in Illinois at the end of March, 1966, when Brettman was home on leave from the Marines. During their conversations Brettman only slightly mentioned the Minutemen and said something about the organization being reorganized. Brettman did not ask Gaffney to join, nor has he sent him anymore literature. Gaffney said that he assumed that Brettman was a member of this organization, but he knew nothing about his activities in it.

Gaffney said that his inquiry in the Minutemen was based entirely on his curiosity and because it was mentioned by his friend. He said that after reading of recent arrest of Minutemen for possession of weapons he has decided to have no association with this organization.

Gaffney denied knowledge of any storage of weapons by the Minutemen or similar groups or of any planned acts of violence by anyone.

Gaffney described Orville Brettman as a white, male, 20 years of age, who recently finished his basic training with the United States Marine Corps at Camp Pendleton, California. Brettman qualified for some type of electronics training and will remain at Camp Pendleton during the mext year. Brettman is the son of Orville Brettman, Sr., rural route, Elgin, Illinois.

Reference is made to Chicago letter dated April 10, 1967, captioned as above.

On June 5, 1967, a representative of Region I, 113th Military Intelligence Group, Evanston, Illinois, advised that this agency had no further information regarding any association of Joseph John Gaffney with the "Minutemen" organization, or with any plan to assassinate Martin Luther King, Jr.

A Chicago source, who is a representative of an agency which gathers intelligence and security information in the Chicago area, advised that no information has been obtained which would indicate the association of Joseph John Gaffney with the "Minutemen" organization, or of any plan to assassinate Martin Luther King, Jr.

Other sources who are familiar with some aspects of "Minutemen" activity and membership in the Chicago area, have been unable to furnish any information to indicate that Joseph John Gaffney has been associated with this organization or of any plans to assassinate Martin Lather Ring, Jr.
