

DONALD TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED HIS MOTHER AT FINDLAY, OHIO TODAY WHO ADVISED THAT THOMAS HAS LEFT GLINDA, DATE UNKOWN, AND WHEREABOUTS UNKOWN. NEITHER MRS. CRAMER NOR DONALD KNOW GLINDA'S HOME ADDRESS IN CHICAGO ALTHOUGH FORMER ADDRESS WAS SCHOOL STREET AS NOTED IN RETEL. BOTH OF OPINION THOMAS IS IN CHICAGO AREA, HOWEVER.

DONALD CLAIMS THOMAS IS AN ALCOHOLIC AND LEAVES FAMILY REGULARLY. HE RECALLS HEARING FROM UNKNOWN PERSONS THAT TWO TO THREE YEARS AGO THOMAS TELEPHONED FBI CHICAGO AND AS JOKE SAID HE WAS GOING TO KILL MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. ACTUALLY, HE WAS DOING THIS BECAUSE HE WAS ANGRY AT SOME NEGROES AT STEWART-WARNER CO.

ALSO THOMAS TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED DONALD SEVERAL YEARS AGO FROM CHICAGO AND SAID HE HAD STRANGLED HIS WIFE AND SHE WAS LYING DEAD IN BED AT THAT TIME AT THEIR HOME AND THAT HE HAD CALLED THE POLICE. DONALD TALKED TO POLICE BY TELEPHONE AT THOMAS' HOME WHO STATED GLINDA WAS NOT INJURED AND THAT THOMAS WAS APPARENTLY DRUNK. DONALD CLAIMS THOMAS HAS LONG HISTORY OF MAKING UP SUCH STORIES.

RE: THREATS TO MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

Bureau by teletype 4/26/68 instructed an immediate investigation be undertaken of MORTON L. ZASLAVSKI who allegedly had put up \$3,000 to have KING killed.

The purpose of this investigation is to determine whether or not ZASLAVSKI could be a conspirator in this case.

Attached herewith is a copy of Chicago airtel and LHM to Bureau dated 4/12/66 which contains the basis for this investigation.

Agents assigned to this inquiry should thoroughly review the attached material as well as Chicago file 29-2401 which contains considerable background information concerning ZASLAVSKI.

Immediate investigation should be undertaken to locate and interview ZASLAVSKI particularly to determine his whereabouts during March and April, 1968.

MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

On April 7, 1966, Sergeant Edward Mc Clellan, Human Relations Unit, Chicago Police Department, advised the Chicago Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation as follows:

Doctor Martin Luther King, Jr., President, Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC) arrived in Chicago during the evening of April 6, 1966. On April 7, 1966, King spent the morning at the offices of the Chicago Urban League, and in the afternoon King was to appear before a gathering of students and faculty at the University of Illinois, Circle Campus, Chicago, Illinois.

In the evening of April 7, 1966, King was to appear at a church located on Chicago's south side, the purpose of or details regarding this meeting were not known.

On April 8, 1966, a source who has furnished reliable information in the past advised that King attended a meeting of SCLC workers and their guests which was held on Chicago's west side on April 6, 1966.

At this meeting tentative plans were made to hold a weekend retreat on April 16 and 17, 1966, or April 23 and 24, 1966, at which time the SCLC operation in Chicago would be evaluated and areas of future concentration would be determined.

At this meeting King commented that banks in Sweden had established a special Martin Luther King fund and that funds from all over the world could be directed into this special account and would then be available for use by the SCLC.

Re: Martin Luther King, Jr.

The "Chicago Daily News" on April 6, 1966, contained an article stating that on April 5, 1966, an order was handed down in Circuit Court, Chicago, Illinois, enjoining Martin Luther King and the SCLC from interfering with the operation of an apartment building at 1321 South Roman, Chicago, Illinois, or collecting rents from the tenants at this building. Further, an accounting was ordered for rents which had been collected and repair expenditures made by King since he took over this building.

This article reported that a SCLC official at Atlanta, Georgia, had advised that the court order would be contested and that this was only the first step to build up a body of legal precedent to guarantee tenants' rights.

On April 8, 1966, Sergeant Mc Clellan advised that King was to attend a SCLC workshop at Woodstock, Illinois, during the afternoon of April 8, 1966, and at 8:40 p.m. King was scheduled to depart Chicago, Illinois, for Atlanta, Georgia.

On April 10, 1966, a program "Sunday with Martin Luther King" was aired on radio station WAAF-AM from 10:00 a.m. to 10:15 a.m.

In monitoring this program, it was noted that it consisted of the sermon by King pointing out that just as Christianity had overcome evil, Negroes would overcome the evil standing between them and freedom.

Listeners were requested to contribute to the SCLC at 123 West Madison Street, Chicago, Illinois, and were invited to tune in each Sunday morning at 10:00 a.m. to hear Martin Luther King.

The "Daily News" on April 5, 1966, contained an article identifying Lavernon Cornelius, 7354 South Michigan, Chicago, Illinois, as one of the sponsors of a "Negro Vigilante Unit" in Chicago known as "The Deacons of Defense and Justice" (DDJ). Cornelius was reported in this article as saying that deacons are primed to fight a war if necessary to protect Negro rights.

Re: Martin Luther King

On April 7, 1966, Cornelius advised that news media had grossly misquoted his association with the DDJ in that his only contact with this group was that several individuals from Bogalusa, Louisiana, had contacted him in Chicago relative to raising funds for the assistance of children who were arrested during the fall of 1965, in connection with civil rights activities in Bogalusa, Louisiana. Cornelius stated that he agreed to assist these individuals in raising defense funds for these children and consented to a press conference being held at his residence relative to raising these funds.

Cornelius advised that at this press conference he was erroneously reported as attempting to establish a DDJ Chapter in Chicago, which he stated is completely untrue, and further during his contact with these people from Bogalusa, no mention was made of attempting to establish a DDJ Chapter in Chicago. Their only purpose in being here was to raise funds.

On April 8, 1966, Cornelius advised that the following handwritten letter was received by him through the United States mail bearing no return address, postmarked Chicago, Illinois, April 7, 1966:

"Dear Sir

"It has been wonderful to read in the newspapers about the Deacons for Defense I feel it is my Duty to tell you about one great Enemy you have here in Chicago that is very Strong and evil he has got away with as much as Killing two colored People and is Doing much harm to the colored People. and he has put the amount of Three Thousand Dollars in order to have Dr Martin Luther King Killed we have proof that he supports all Organizations against the Colored People This is his name and home address

"He also owns this Currency Exchange

"Public Currency Exchange

"I am quite sur the Exchange is not in his name as every thing he does is on the Shady side he was a lawyer at one time I am not sure if he is still in Practice as he is so corrupt all he ever made was stealing As I feel it is my Duty to let you know of this Powerful Person that does Every rotten evil thing with Money So I hope you can and will put him in his Place for once and for all a little Beating Would not be enough For this Brutal anamal in the Near Future as soon as I am able I will let you know and prove to you what I say of Course there is so much More and So Many terrible things He Has done to us Colored People I beg of you to Please put him in a Wheel Chair for life

"James C Watts"

Cornelius had no idea as to the identity of James C. Watts.

The above letter was furnished to Sergeant Leason Linzy, Intelligence Unit, Chicago Police Department.

The records of the Chicago Credit Bureau, Incorporated, as caused to be reviewed on June 4, 1965, identified Morton L. Zaslavsky, date of birth [redacted], Chicago, Illinois, as an attorney who resided at 6240 North Drake Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, and included in his business operations was a currency exchange business at 820 North Avenue, Chicago, Illinois.

On June 4, 1965, a search of the available arrest records of the Chicago Police Department revealed the following arrest record which may be identical with Morton L. Zaslavsky:

On October 9, 1964, Sergeant Samuel Nolan, Human Relations Section, Chicago Police Department, advised that on October 8, 1964, Morton L. Zaslavsky, Manager of the Darlan Realty Company, 820 North Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, appeared in United States District Court, and a temporary injunction was granted prohibiting the Congress of Racial Equality (CORE) from picketing a number of Chicago north side buildings handled by the Darlan Realty Company which CORE charged were slum-type buildings.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.

On 10/3/64, Sgt. SAMUEL NOLAN, Human Relations Section, Chicago Police Department, advised the Chicago FBI that recently a suit had been filed in Federal District Court by MORTON L.

ZASLAVSKY in an effort to seek an injunction against the Chicago Congress of Racial Equality (CORE). ZASLAVSKY is manager of the Darlan Realty Company, 320 N. Avenue, Chicago, Illinois.

Sgt. NOLAN noted that on 9/3/64, a group of seven individuals led by two representatives of the North Side CORE, Chicago, Illinois, had appeared at ZASLAVSKY's for the purpose of conducting a demonstration. They were protesting the slum type buildings in that area in which the people demonstrating held residence. They alleged that ZASLAVSKY was the owner of the buildings Sgt. NOLAN stated.

The current legal action, Sgt. NOLAN continued, charges that the two North Side CORE representatives identified as TAYLOR JONES and RICHARD BROWN have been going into buildings owned by ZASLAVSKY's firm and by doing so were inciting the tenants who reside therein to protest against so called building violations. ZASLAVSKY in his suit is attempting to have the Court enjoin the CORE representatives from demonstrating at the buildings and from agitating tenants who reside in such buildings.

Sgt. NOLAN remarked that according to ZASLAVSKY, no code violations exist in the buildings owned or operated by his realty firm. However, it is his, ZASLAVSKY's, opinion that if the CORE representatives continue to contact the tenants, a serious disturbance will result.

Sgt. NOLAN added that the case, according to his records, has not as yet been determined; however, it has been assigned for a hearing.






