In view of the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., in Memphis, Tennessee, on April 4, 1968, SEATON was contacted by SA MICHAEL J. MAHANEY, JR., and was requested to immediately furnish any information of value that he, SEATON, obtains during his travels through the ghetto areas in Cleveland, Ohio.

Mr. SEATON, who has been extremely cooperative to SA MAHANEY in the past, advised that today, April 5, 1968, he would make his rounds of the ghetto areas, particularly the Hough and Outhwaite areas, and in the event he obtains any information relative to any racial disturbances being planned in these areas in view of Dr. KING's death, he SEATON would immediately apprise SA MAHANEY of same.

It is to be noted that SEATON continues to display a keen interest in being of assistance to the FBI as evidenced by his highly cooperative attitude he exhibited in case captioned, "RAYMOND COILINS, ET AL, FAG", Cleveland file 46-3321 (Neighborhood Youth Corps). It is recommended that he SEATON be continued as a racial source in the Cleveland area.

In view of the foregoing, a copy of this memorandum is being directed to both 46-3321 and also to 157-1416, the file relative to the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

CV-463-R stated he was at the temple and Shabazz restaurant when assassination was mentioned announced, and all were cautioned not to make any statements or to take part in any demonstrations etc.

Information under above caption should pertain only to investigation that may have bearing on identifying subject in instant case. All other information permining to racial incidents and racial activities arising out of assassination of Doctor KING should not be submitted under above caption but should be submitted under appropriate caption pertaining to racial matter.

It is to be noted that the pertinent periods in this investigation concerning any suspects are March 29 and 30, 1968 in Birmingham, Alabama, and April 4, 1968, in Memphis, Tennessee.

In the event that any data is developed regarding suspects, an attempt will be made to establish the whereabouts of the suspects on the above dates which may eliminate the suspect. If this cannot be done, efforts should be made to secure photographs of suspects in question and forward photographs to Memphis and Birmingham for possible elimination. Pertinent descriptive data should be included with photographs.

If unable to eliminate on the basis of esablished whereabouts during pertinent periods, interested offices should make efforts to secure fingerprints of suspect in question and submit same to Bureau for elimination.

A composit description, based on data developed in Birmingham and Memphis of Unsub is as follows:

Investigation to date indicates a possibility exits that suspect is a non-smoker; indications are that suspect rented a room between 3:30 p.m., April 4, 1968, and departed shortly after 6:00 p.m.

In the event information is received regarding suspects in this case where the name of the suspect is known, it should be determined if the suspect has a local police record, the identity of the suspect along with any local police department number should be furnished to the Identification Division to have his prints compared with latent prints of suspect.
