I am also enclosing sketch (from our local paper) that very much resembles a man that was on TV in a showing of The American Alcoholic over WFMJ - 21 between 10:00 PM & 11 P.M: It was made at an Alcoholic Clinic in Atlanta, Gorgia. It showed this man in jail - also before the judge (being released) also showed him crossing street and entering a bar with another man (looked like other one had blond hair - about 1/2 head shorter than the man I am mentioning. Also showed them coming out of bar & drinking from bottle. When Judge called his name he mentioned the name Rudolph 3 or 4 times. I could not quite get the last name - sounded like Helon or Hallon. Judge was quite plump. Do not know who he was either. Man is classified as an alcoholic. I could be very wrong but I could not help noticing the resemblance to description of dress, heighth etc. that has been in our paper.

Please do not mention this letter to anyone as we are already living in fear all over America of the violence going on.



LT. JAMES MC BRIDE, Youngstown, Ohio Police Department advised this date he had received a telephone call from a friend of his who might have some information regarding the instant matter. He furnished the name and address of this individual who was interviewed as follows.

JAMES QUINN DAILEY, Owner, Emerald Bar, 2719 Market Street, Youngstown, Ohio advised this date the following: On Friday morning, 4/5/68, at about 10:45 AM, shortly after opening hûs bar, three white males and one white female came into his place of business. Mr. Joseph REAGAN, a regular before noon patron, was sitting at the bar at this time. One of the males and the female went directly to the rest rooms. The other two men sat at one of the tables. The television set was turned on and the news was mostly concerned with the MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. murder. Almost immediately, one of the men started complaining about the news coverage on the killing.

These people were in the bar from approximately 10:45 AM to 11:30 AM. They appeared to be dead tired, probably from both drinking and driving. This one male continued to complain about the news coverage indicating he was not sympathetic to the victim or his race.

The four individuals are described as follows:

1. White, male, 5' 11", 185, age 30, well built, short light brown crew cut hair, appeared to be a recently discharged military man. This is the individual DAIDEY believes might have been the subject of this file.

. White, male, tall, thin, long black wavy hair, appeared

to be married or going with the female.

3. White, male, average size.

4. White, female, 5'6", 140, small chest, large hips, black shoulder length uncombed hair, wearing light colored, large print dress.

All of the above individuals were about 30 years of age, all dressed inexpensively, appeared to be long fime friends, all looked seedyand messy, and talked with a farmer/hilbilly accent. One of the above asked for directions to Fort Wayne, Indiana. These individuals left the bar area by automobile, model and license are not known. A Plain Dealer photograph of subject GALT (4/18/68 issue) was shown to DAILEY who indicated there was a resemblance between the two individuals.


