At approximately 3:30 am above date a [REDACTED] telephone number [REDACTED] telephonically contacted this office and relayed the following information.

[REDACTED] advised that he was formerly employed as a Security Guard for Security Systems working at Borg-Warner Cryogenic which is located on Sheppard Rd. in Perry, Ohio. [REDACTED] advised that presently working at the same company is an individual by the name of [REDACTED] who is also a Security Guard. [REDACTED] advised that one time when he was working for the company he had cause to relieve [REDACTED] during the course of his duties and therefore spoke with [REDACTED] for about ten minutes.

[REDACTED] stated that he just observed a picture of JAMES EARL RAY in a magazine and feels that [REDACTED] very much resembles RAY except that [REDACTED] has very curly hair.

[REDACTED] gave the following description of [REDACTED] as being approximately 5ft 7 to 5ft. 8 inches tall 180 lbs. black curly hair and spoke with a southern accent. [REDACTED] also advised that [REDACTED] was in Alabama for a couple of days last week.

[REDACTED] advised that the person to contact re [REDACTED] is [REDACTED] who is in charge of plant security at Borg-Warner Cryogenic. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] resides at [REDACTED] in Austinburg, Ohio telephone number [REDACTED] home address unknown.

[REDACTED] further advised that [REDACTED] told him that he is going south on the 28th of this month. [REDACTED] requested that this office keep his name confidential.

Re previous investigation conducted at Mansfield, Ohio in regard to [REDACTED]

On 4/10/68, Captain [REDACTED] Mansfield, Ohio PD, advised SA [REDACTED] that his department received a telephone message from the Ohio BCI, London, Ohio, that on 6/9/67, the Secret Service placed a stop with BCI against [REDACTED] wanting him for questioning in view of past threats he made upon the life of the President of the United States. The FBI number of [REDACTED] agreed with that of the Identification Division of this bureau. No other details were available.

This information was immediately furnished SA [REDACTED] by telephone who was to inform Secret Service, Cleveland, Ohio, in regard to [REDACTED] probable location as determined from him during prior interview.

On 4/10/68, SA [REDACTED] advised SA [REDACTED] U.S. Secret Service, Cleveland, Ohio, of pertinent information regarding [REDACTED] as developed by FBI interview and as to his probable location and expected itinerary. He was also furnished photographs of [REDACTED] as taken on the day of FBI interview at Mansfield, Ohio.

Captain [REDACTED] and Lt. [REDACTED] Mansfield PD, were subsequently informed on 4/10/68 that Secret Service, Cleveland, Ohio, had been notified regarding this incident.

THE CRIMES: Ray escaped from the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, on April 23, 1967, while serving a 20-year sentence for armed robbery and operating a motor vehicle without the owner's permission. He subsequently allegedly conspired, under the alias Eric Starvo Galt, to violate the civil rights of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., shot to death on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel on April 4, 1968.

THE CRIMINAL: A 40-year-old white native of Illinois, who is known as a "loner" and "drifter" and has taken elaborate steps to establish a false identity, Ray has an extensive criminal record, including convictions for burglary, robbery and forging U. S. Postal Money Orders. Outstanding characteristics include a straight narrow nose, straight and even teeth, a noticeably protruding left ear and a nervous habit of tugging at an ear lobe. He has taken dancing lessons, attended bartending school, enrolled in a correspondence course in locksmithing and traveled widely in a 1966 Mustang recovered in Atlanta, Georgia, a week after Dr. King's murder. Ray likes western and country music, drinks vodka and beer and has worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.

PROCESS: A Federal warrant issued at Jefferson City, Missouri, on July 20, 1967, charges Ray with unlawful interstate flight to avoid confinement for robbery. Another Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, as Eric Starvo Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a citizen.

"TEN MOST WANTED FUGITIVES": Ray is a special addition to the list of "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives." The list as of Saturday p. m., April 20, 1968, was:

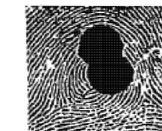

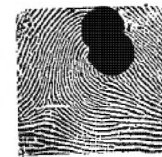

James Earl Ray, a Missouri prison escapee who has been sought under the alias Eric Starvo Galt in connection with the gunshot slaying of civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., has been added to the FBI's list of "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives."

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover ordered the special addition of Ray to the "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives" list, which already contains ten fugitives, to insure the widest possible dissemination of Ray's photograph and description to help effect his earliest possible location.

Ray has been the subject of a massive and intensive search since the brutal gunshot slaying of Dr. King on April 4, 1968, as he stood on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel. One rifle bullet, believed fired from the window of a nearby rooming house, felled the victim.

An exhaustive FBI fingerprint search, comparing latent fingerprints uncovered in the Dr. King case against fingerprints of over 53,000 persons on whom wanted notices have been posted in the FBI's Identification Division, succeeded in determining that Galt and Ray are identical.

A Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, under the alias Eric Starvo Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a United States citizen. Ray is also sought for unlawful interstate flight to avoid confinement after conviction for armed robbery, based on a Federal warrant issued on July 20, 1967, at Jefferson City, Missouri. He had been confined at the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, in March, 1960, with a 20-year sentence following conviction for armed robbery and operating a motor vehicle without permission of the owner. In September, 1966, while serving the sentence, he was confined for a time in the maximum security ward at the State Hospital, Fulton, Missouri. He was reported missing from the Missouri State Penitentiary since April 23, 1967.

Ray, who has an arrest record dating back to 1949 and has been convicted of burglary, armed robbery and forging United States Postal Money Orders, has also been confined in the Los Angeles County Jail, the Joliet and Pontiac, Illinois, State Prisons and the United States Penitentiary, Leavenworth, Kansas.

He served in the Army between February, 1946, and December, 1948, received a three-month sentence at hard labor for being drunk and breaking arrest and was given a General Discharge due to ineptness and lack of adaptability for military service.

Ray is a 40-year-old white male, reportedly born in Illinois on [] He is approximately 5'10" inches tall, weighs from 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes and brown hair which he has worn cut short. He has a small scar on the center of his forehead and a scar on the palm of his right hand. He has been described as having a straight, narrow nose and straight and even teeth and to have a nervous habit of occasionally tugging at an ear lobe. His left ear protrudes noticeably.

Acquaintances describe him as a "loner" and "drifter" whose language and diction reflect a "rural" quality and indicate he has had limited education.

He is reportedly a fan of western and country music, drinks vodka and beer, dresses neatly and claims past employment as a merchant seaman and cook on Mississippi River vessels. He is known to have worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.

He is known as an avid dancer who has taken dancing lessons. He also completed a course at a school of bartending in the Los Angeles area early in 1968.

Ray should be considered armed and extremely dangerous. Anyone with information concerning this fugitive is requested to immediately contact the nearest office of the FBI, the telephone number of which may be found on the first page of local telephone directories.

On Saturday, April 20, 1968, [REDACTED] was interviewed at Miller Drug Store. She advised that an individual who resembled the photograph she observed in the Cleveland newspaper of ERIC STARVO GALT had been coming into the drug store ever since Friday, April 6. She stated he was first observed at approximately six or seven P.M. on April 6. [REDACTED] advised that this individual would come in, sit at the soda fountain, and drink soft drinks for a prolonged period of time. She stated that he would read books and be making notes from these books. [REDACTED] stated that another employee, [REDACTED] had waited on him several times and would be able to furnish additional information.

[REDACTED] advised that she first recalled the unknown male come into Miller Drug Store on Friday, April 6, 1968 around 7:00 P.M. She stated that he has been coming in frequently since that period of time. She stated that he appears to be a very nervous individual and at one time, had mentioned that he had come to Cleveland to visit his sister, but that his sister had departed prior to his arrival, and had gone to New York. He stated that he was waiting around for her return.

occasionally make comments concerning some portions of murder mysteries he was reading. She advised that on April 10, 1968, the day after the funeral service for Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING in Atlanta, this individual was in the store in the early evening at which time Mayor STOKES came into the store. She stated that this individual went right up to Mayor STOKES, shook his hand, and then continued out of the store.

[REDACTED] advised that Mayor STOKES makes frequent stops at Miller Drug Store, usually in the early evening. She advised that the unknown male had been in the store on the next two or possibly three occasions when Mayor STOKES had been in Miller Drug Store.

[REDACTED] stated that this unknown male was in the store on Friday, April 19, 1968 for about an hour to an hour and a half at which time she stated he advised that he was going to return to California.

[REDACTED] viewed a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY and stated that there was a resemblance, although she could not positively state that was the man.

[REDACTED] pharmacist, Miller Drug Store, advised on April 22, 1968 that he had seen the individual that [REDACTED] had referred to and described him as strictly "a kook". [REDACTED] stated that in his mind there was a slight resemblance between the unknown male and photographs of JAMES EARL RAY, although he stated that in his opinion the unknown male was definitely not JAMES EARL RAY. He stated that the unknown male appeared older than the photographs of RAY as well as other discrepancies noted.

It is to be noted that on April 20, 1968 Assistant City Director RICHARD MC KEAN, City of Cleveland, was notified of the unknown male who resembled GALT frequenting Miller Drug Store during

the time that the store had been frequented by Mayor STOKES. MC KEAN was advised that this information was being furnished him for the security of Mayor STOKES.

On Monday, April 22, 1968 SAC CHARLES G. CUSICK and SA [REDACTED], at the request of City Director MC KEAN, conferred with Mayor STOKES and Safety Director MC MANOMAN concerning this matter and furnished him complete information concerning this incident.

Mrs. [REDACTED] 2775 South Park Boulevard, on April 12, 1968, telephonically advised that she might have information concerning the individual believed to have committed the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. She advised that this individual shows some resemblance to the artist's conception that appeared in the Cleveland papers following the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING.

[REDACTED] were contacted at their residence, [REDACTED] Shaker Heights, telephone number [REDACTED] stated that the conversation concerning the individual who resembled the individual who assassinated KING, had taken place a couple of nights previous to his wife calling the FBI. He stated that the individual he had in mind was an individual by the name of [REDACTED]. He stated that he had met [REDACTED] who was a friend of one of his employees. He stated that he had not seen [REDACTED] since approximately 1960. He advised that [REDACTED] was a drifter and that he had expressed more or less fascist ideas. He stated that his wife had called [REDACTED] telephone number [REDACTED] in an attempt to find out where [REDACTED] was, but when his sister or mother had answered the phone, stated he was in California.

[REDACTED] stated that he would describe [REDACTED] as volatile, who is anti-society, and it was his understanding that [REDACTED] had been in the Army during which period of time he had attacked an officer for which he had been sentenced by a court martial to serve time. He stated that he believed [REDACTED] had attended Lakewood High School.
