He is described as being very polite but in definite need of a great deal of activity to keep his mind occupied. Dr. PALMAZ advised that he has a very deep-seated hostility toward life in general and that things need to go his way at all times. Dr. PALMAZ considers him to have definite Dr. PALMAZ advised he has never heard NILES make any comments regarding any of the racial or Nazi leaders in the United States.

Dr. PALMAZ noted that NILES wrote a letter to the Social Security Administration recently in regard to his Social Security account, number which he felt was delinquent.

It was noted that since March 30, 1968, NILES has been allowed to work at the Howard Johnson's Restaurant, off the Eastern State, in Williamsburg, Va. Since that time and to date, he has worked five and six days a week, 40 hours per week, and is paid \$58.

On 5/3/68 JAMES HAMILTON, Manager, Howard Johnson's Restaurant, Williamsburg, Va., was interviewed and advised that NILES was employed at his restaurant from 3/30/68 to the present time. He noted that he was at all times on duty during the period 4/3-6/68. His days off during the instant period were April 2 and 9, 1968. HAMILTON advised that NILES is very well liked and gets along well with all the Negro help.

CI advised that in connection with betting at Lima, Ohio, one bets the same as one does at the track, either to win, place or show. He said it is possible to bet a "win parley", or a blace parley", or a "show parley". He said that it is possible to bet two or three horses in any one of the parleys, or for that matter four horses. He advised that if you, for example, bet three horses on a place parley and horses finish either winning or placing, you would therefore win the parley.

The CI advised that the dice is played in Lima, Ohio, and one of the expressions which is used around this area is "7 out", and this refers to the rolling of a seven before you make your point. CI also advised that another expression is, "bet to pass" or "7-11 in the door". "In the Door" refers to the first roll of the dice.

CI said that you can bet to pass on the following numbers:

4,56,8,9 and 10

If you do bet to pass with one of those numbers and you make your point, such as 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 or 10 before seven, then the roller wins. You can also bet to "don't pass". If you bet to "don't pass" and you roll 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 and 10 you lose. If you come out with a 7 on the roll, you also lose. If the dice, however, comes out with two is or a one and a two or two 6s, which brings up a total of 2, 3 or 12, you win if you roll this "in the door", meaning that you win on the first roll.

CI said that poker is played around Lima, but there is nothing unusual in the jargon or the playing of the poker to his knowledge.

On April 28, 1968, GEORGE W. CLINARD was telephonically contacted at his residence, the Waver Hotel, Bucyrus, Ohio, by SA LA VERN C. STOVER. He was inable to furnish any information of value not included in referenced memo of SPC BRICE A. WESTHOVEN.

On April 29, 1968, he was shown 10442-A and glossy photographs of subject JAMES EARLY RAY. He advised that photographs of RAY taken in 1960 bore no resemblance to the individual he observed at the Plaza Cafe approximately two weeks before, but stated that the photographs of the subject taken in 1968 contained facial features that very definitely are similar to those of this individual. He noted that GLORIA ELLIS, who also resides at the Waver Hotel was attending bar at the Plaza Cafe when he observed this individual.

After previous attempts of contact, GLORIA ELLIS was contacted at the Waver Hotel, Bucyrus, Ohio, on May 3, 1968. She stated she recalls CLINARD, approximately three weeks previous, pointed out an individual who he thought resembled JAMES EARL. RAY. After viewing photographs of RAY, Mrs. ELLIS advised that, in her mind, there was absolutely no resemblance between RAY and the individual CLINARD pointed out to her at the Plaza Bar and that she told CLINARD the same at the time he observed this individual. ELLIS added that in her opinion, CLINARD is "some kind of nut" who is using the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING to draw attention to himself.

Ernst Stavro Blofield is a formidable person, John Galt Is a "social drop out" and Eric Starnes is described in the book as a "whiner" from a low-class family.

In view of the above and in order that Agents handling this investigation can be alert to the possibility of Ray's utilizing an alias based on characters in Fleming's books, there is set out as an attachment to this airtel a list of various characters in those books for your assistance.
