

Hubert A. Ferrell, white, male, age 50, employed as Division Manager, for United Sayings Life, Dallas, formerly resided in Memphis and has numerous relatives still residing there. Ferrell's wife, Mary Elizabeth Ferrell, has done work for Jim Garrison on several occasions. Ferrell and his brother, name unknown, bought a farm in Arkansas, place unknown. Ferrell's brother called Ferrell after King was shot. Ferrell is known to possess numerous high powered rifles. Ferrell upon learning of King's assasination is supposed to have made the following statement They were supposed to have done that two weeks ago". Hubert A. Ferrell is also known as Buck Féyrell.

Pearce stated he had been contacted by RENNE Smith several times and had has finally convenced Smith to talk to the FBI.

Smith is willing to talk to an agent concerning the above and requested he be contacted at CH 73037 after 8:15 a.m. and before 3:30 p.m. Smith is currently at home daily because of an injury received while on the job, place unknown. Smith does not want his wife to know he is in contact with the FBI.

time and who has furnished the following information.
HERBERT A. (Buck) FERRELL, 4406 Holland, Dallas, Texas, employed as Division Manager, United Savings Life, married to MARY ELIZABETH FERRELL, who has worked for JIM GARRISON, DA, New Orleans, La. FERRELL is from Memphis, Tenn. and has a brother, JAMES FERRELL who presently resides in Memphis, Tenn. and is a conductor for one of the railroads.

The FERRELL famely are reported to be "Negro haters" and HERBERT A. FERRELL and JAMES FERRELL have purchased a farm some where beweren Little Rock, Ark. and Memphis, Tenn., which they plan to move to if

the Negro situation gets to rough in Memphis.

After the reported death of KING, Mrs. FERRELL tried to call the FERRELL family at Memphis and gave the indication that she was afraid that some of her family might have been involved in the killing.

When HERBERT A. (Buck) FERRELL was advised of the death of KING, he made the remark "Well, they finally did it." He then stated that he had

heard two weeks ago that they were going to kill KING.

PEARCE stated that his source believes that possibly one_of the sons of JAMES FERRELL in Memphis, Term . might be involved .n the killing, however he has no positive information to this effect.

PEARCE was requested to contact his source and see if he would agree to a interview with agents in order that it might be determined if he has any worth while information in captioned matter . PEARCE subsequently called back and stated that his souce had agreed to being interviewed by Agents . He identified source as WAYNE SMITH, ph.# CH-7-3037, who is to be called only between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and \$3:30 p.m., since this is the time that his wife is not at home and he does not want her to know that he is talking to any one about it . since he reportedly is a close friend of HERBERT A. (Buck) FERRELL.

On 4/10/68 Sheriff W. E. BILL DECKER, Dallas County SO, Dallas, Texas, telephonically advised that captioned subject was recently released from the Texas State Hospital, Terrell, Texas, and that such release was prior to the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

Sheriff DECKER advised he considered itelogical to check out subject as a suspect in the KING shooting based on subject's physical description and past activities.

Subject is a member of the Stormtrooper Unit of the ANP. A photograph of HILLHOUSE taken in September 1964 is available (157-481-1A1).

Several Non-Prosecutive Summary Reports have been written on HILLHOUSE which contain extensive background information. HILLHOUSE was arrested by Dallas County SO 12/3/67 after which a search of his home at 621 Melba Street, Dallas, revealed a cache of firearms and ammunition. On 4/9/68, she and her husbank were having dinner at the Candlight Inn on Highway 80, Arlington when for some reason her attention was drawn to a white male who was sitting byhimself and eating dinner. She observed this man carefully having the feeling that she had seen him somewhere before. She became suspicious that this might be the man represented in the artist's conception of the UNSUB being sought in the instant case and asked her husband to take a good look.

When the man left the restaurant the ADLAMS followed him to his car which was a new appearing Dodge Charger, light vellow in color with a dark vinal top, bearing 1968 Texas license KZF 723. They followed this car for some distance and observed it durning into the vacinity of an apartement complex at the intersection of Collins and Peach, which is behind a 7-11 Grocery Store.

MRS. ADLAM advised when she got home she looked at the artist's conception in the paper again and that while the individual she saw had glasses on he is almost identical to the drawing. She further advised that she dines often at the Candlight Inn and does not recall having seen this person before.
