

He said he could not state positively that the man he knows is RAY but he is very suspicious of him. He said this man came to work with another man who he said is his brother but they do not look alike and he does not believe they are brothers. The person looking like RAY gave his name as DAVID GLAWSON and his brother gave his name as REYMEDRA RAYFORD GLAWSON.

The personnel records of the PAYMAD, Inc. were reviewed and show that DAVID NATHANIEL GLA SON, born 9/14/34, wife NORMA ANN, gave his address as Rt. 4, Box /8/, Lufkin, Texas. His wife's address is shown as DIBCAL, Texas. He sisted 6 children as dependents, has Social Security # and shows his occupation as carpenter. 




