In spite of fact Southwestern Bell Telephone Company is involved in strike, officials are cooperating. Records probably will be available beginning 4/29/68, however, they will have to be checked by Agent personnel this division since telephone company on strike.

DON NISHOP, Manager, General Telephone Company, Del Rio, Texas, advised all records of pay telephone calls made in Val Verde County, Texas, the only county on U. S. Route 90 covered by General Telephone Company, are forwarded daily to the General Office at San Angelo, Texas.

The Dallas Division advised that, upon contact with official, General Telephone Company of Southwest, San Angelo, Texas, it was learned that pay phone toll call slips are destroyed after 90 days. After 90 days toll call slips information which had been previously placed on electronic tape are intermingled with all other toll call records.

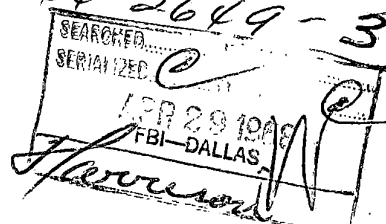

A check of all the long distance calls on the pertinent dates reflects that two calls were made to the Dallas area, both Area Code 806 and both made on Dec. 17, 1967. One call made to 3640709, made at 6:52 PM. Another call made at 8:15 PM to 892-2521.

A check with JIM VAUGHAN, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, indicates that area code 806, 892-2521 is for Idalou, Texas, and the phone at Idalou are handled by the General Telephone Company of the Southwest. Their district office is at Memphis, Texas. Telephone 806 3640709 is the Southwestern Bell Telephone Company number at Hereford, Texas.

HETHERINGTON stated they were trying to identify who was called and whether there is any possible connection with RAY.

Mr. KENNETH E. COMMONS, General Telephone Company of the Southwest, advised that No. 892-2521 is registered to URRUTIA SANTIAGO, 308 West 3rd Street, Idalou, Texas.
