

#### FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Mr. JAMES W. TRINKLE was interviewed at the Dallas Office of the FBI, at which time he advised at the present time he resides at 1500 Provincetown Lane, Richardson, Texas, telephone AD 1-2731. He is employed as a designer-consultant and has an office at 3015 Avenue E East, Great Southwest Industrial Park, Arlington, Texas.

Mr. TRINKLE stated that at approximately 11:30 AM on March 29, 1968, he pulled into a Mobil Service Station located on Interstate Highway 20 at Abilene, Texas, to purchase gasoline. The Mobil station is located next to an overpass on the west side of Abilene, Texas, and a Horne Gulf Service Station is near the Mobil station on the opposite side of the road. TRINKLE stated he was waited on in the Mobil station by a man approximately 6'1" or 6'2" tall, about 30 years of age, and who was well built, had a congenial personality, and who appeared to be the lessor or owner of this station. He was the only man on duty in the station at that time. He described the station as having a rather run-down appearance. He also noted a Myna bird kept in a cage in front of the station.

TRINKLE began talking with the station attendant about his Myna bird and in the conversation, the attendant asked TRINKLE where he was from. TRINKLE said he was driving east at the time and told the attendant he was going to his home in Dallas. During the conversation, the attendant mentioned a man had been into the service station either that morning or the afternoon before and the attendant observed several guns in the backend of the man's car. The attendant told TRINKLE he mentioned the guns to the man thinking he was possibly going hunting and the man said to the attendant, according to TRINKLE, he was going to Memphis to kill some Negroes.

TRINKLE said the attendant did not furnish a description of the man or the car he was driving but the attendant did mention some severe facial scars which the man had. TRINKLE said the attendant described these as very bad scars and the attendant presumed the man possibly obtained these scars from service in the armed forces in Vietnam.

GRIFFIN stated he first saw UNSUB at 1:00 PM, in the cafe located about two blocks west of the Police Dept., Grand Prairie, on Highway 80. This individual was eating lunch there.

GRIFFIN advised he saw this same man again at app. 6;00 PM, eating Supper at the cafe next door to the Downs Theatre, Highway 80, Grand Prairie. GRIFFIN advised SUBJECT left the cafe at 6:00 PM, and he observed him entering a 1963 blue Chevrolet, 1968 Texas license 858, with the first three letters possibly GG.

This individual described WM, 5'8", 170 lbs. dark complected, dark curly hair.



Mr. RUSSELL ELLISON, Residence 2121 Apartments, Apt. 107, phone 677-7689, Advised that he grew up in Selma, Alabama. He advised that he graduated from the Albert G. Parish High School in Selma in 1955, and a friend of his, LEONARD WILSON, graduated from the same school in 1954. He advised WILSON resided in a Government Housing Project near Craig Air Force Base in Selma and as he recalled WILSON's father was employed at the base either as civilian or Government personnel.

ELLISON advised that WILSON was violently opposed to integration, and after graduating from high school, attended the University of Alabama where he was and violently opposed the integration of the university. He advised that later he observed WILSON as a participant in the Selma-Montgomery march in opposition to integration. ELLISON advised that he also observed WILSON in Life Magazine and other publications in which he was violently opposing the Megro situation and integration in Alabama.

ELLISON advised that he has not personally seen WILSON in over twelve years, but the recent composit drawing appearing in all newspapers of the individual believed to have killed MARTIN LUTHER KING in his mind and that of his mother's, was aba ELLISON, Manager of the Spanish Arms Apartments in Abilene, Texas, resembled LEONARD WILSON. He advised that in reading the current Life Magazine which reflected that the suspect to KING's murder possibly registered at the place across the street from where KING was murdered was JOHN WILLARD, this was enough consequence, he felt, to furnish this information to the FBI. Further he stated his mother noted the similarity without his having mentioned it to her.

On 4/23/68, Mrs EMMA JO SCHLEIMER, 1738 Glen Key Lane, advised she had been fishing of Mountain Creek Lake and was approached by two men. One of these individuals resembled JAMES EARL RAY. The indident occurred on 4/14/68, and she first saw a pictrue of RAY about 4/22/68, when she was looking through an old edition of the Dallas Morning News dated 4/14/68.

She furnished approximately the same information regarding the incident as stated in re'd memo. She added the following:

She did not get much of a look at this individual, as he was in a car during the whole time, and he never got out. She never got into the car with the men, but noticed this person wore an eye patch over the left eye, which he took off, and did not seem to need.

She advised the individual resembling RAY could not be more than 28-30 years old, and she is sure of this because she has a married son in his twenties. Additionally this person had Dishwater blond hair worn in a long flattop.

She was furnished a photograph of RAY with an I.O. and advised if she waw this individual again, she would contact the FBI, but she stated the better photograph on the I.O. was of an older person than she had seen.

MRS. EMMA JO SCHLEIMER, 1738 Glen Key Lane, Grand Prairie, Texas, phone nr. AN 2-8446 telephonically advised this office at 9:35 AM, 4/23/68, that on April 14, 1968 she was fishing along at Mountain Creek Lake, Dallas County from approximately 11 AM until 4 PM. She stated that at approximately 3:15 PM that day a late model red car, no further details known by MRS. SCHLEIMER, approached whre she was fishing with two men in this vehicle.

She advised one man got out of the car and came down to where she was fishing and akked her about the fishing that day. She advised he was drinking a can of beer and **ERRHERK** continued to stay beside her for approximately 30 to 40 minutes.

She advised that he returned to his car and got an other can of beer and returned to where she was and tried to convince her that he knew where better fishing was and that she should go with him and the second man who she referred to as his brother.

She discribed this individual as: WHO WAS BESIDE HER AS!

MRS. SCHLEIMER stated that the individual who stayed ink the car looked somewhat like the picture of the man who appeared in the Dallas Morning News, 4/18/68, and the paper stated he was wanted by the FBI and was known as "GALT".

MRS. SCHLEIMER stated that she took a pen and drew a patch over the left eye of the News Paper picture of GALT and it even looked more like the man in the red car.

SHE advised that she is aware that the FBI probably has gotten thousands of calls in this matter, however, she felt she should let the FBI know of this incident.

MRS. SCHLEIMER advised that in order to get rid of the man who stayed beside her, she told him she would follow him to where he knew the fishing was better.

She advised that she followed these two men in her car to the road that went off the lake road and when she had the chance to exit she went right when they continued left on the lake road.

She stated that she did not see the car after she made the turn. Also she advised that she had never seen the two men before or after that nor had she ever seen this car before.

MRS. SCHLEIMER stated that there were no one around the lake she knew or close enough to have heard the conversation with thes man.

MRS. SCHLEIMER advised that this was all of the information whe had and had called in the event that this would be of use to the FBI.

The file reflects that on 6-16-67 their office received a money order from HAROLD B. FITZGERALD, 3230 Peachtree Rodd, Northeast, Atlanta, Georgia to be applied to restitution of a check of NISSEN, which sum was received by MARVIN CUMMINS, Holiday Inn, Sherman on 10-5-67. It shows JOHN HILL was a court appointed attorney for NISSEN and made bond for NISSEN. The file reflects NISSEN's address as of 6-19-67 to be in care of "Spencer International Press, 3230 Peachtree Road, Northeast, Atlanta, Ga., and their is nothing in file since, NISSEN, was released on bond.

JOHN HILL, Attorney, BROWN, KENNEDY & HILL, with offices in the Grayson County State Bank Building advised he was appointed by the court to represent NISSEN, that DEAN MARTIN, County Attorney, had no case agains't NISSEN and "wanted to get rid of it." HILL according, did go on NISSEN's bond, but only after MARTIN first gave HILL a letter indemnifying HILL on this bond, and their is no indication MARTIN will ever prosecute NISSEN on this charge.

HILL stated he never had any correspondence with NISSEN as a result, and has had no word of or from NISSEN since the law he longer.
