The description furnished by Mrs. JOHNSON in referenced airtel indicates that this eating establishment is the Dobbs House located at 685 W. Tennessee Street, and this location is on U.S. 90 approximately 1/2 block east of the FSU campus and located next to a large building, that of the Travelodge Motel.

On 4/25/68, Mr. PHIL JOBE, employee, Dobbs House, 685 W. Tennessee Street, Tallahassee, Florida, was contacted and exhibited WF #442-A. He advised that he has previously seen a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY in the local newspaper and has not observed him or anyone meeting his description at that location to the best of his knowledge. He advised that all of the other employees of the Dobbs House are aware and have observed RAY's. photograph in the local newspapers as they have discussed this matter amongst themselves and he stated he feels sure that if anyone had observed anyone meeting the description of RAY or appearing similar to RAY, they would have contacted the local FBI or local authorities. He advised that he was employed at the Dobbs House as of 4/1/68 and could furnish no information concerning an individual reportedly observed in that vicinity on or about that date which resembled RAY.

2 - Memphis (1) - Dallas (44-2649) (Info) 2 - Jacksonville VLW-mhw (5) JK 44-769

On 4/26/68, Mrs. JACQUELINE HOFFMAN, Travelodge Motel, W. Tennessee Street, located next door to Dobbs House Restaurant, was exhibited WF \$442-A and advised that she had previously observed a photograph of RAY in the local newspaper and to the best of her knowledge no one meeting his description or appearing similar to him has every stayed at that motel. She advised that all of her maids are aware of his status and she knows they have observed his photograph as he has been discussed amongst the employees at the motel and anyone meeting that description or appearing similar to RAY would have been reported to the FBI and/or local authorities.

It is to be noted that this is a business area and the complete block of this area is individual stores and businesses. The time related in re airtel of approximately midnight or after, would have meant that all of the stores and businesses in the area, with the exception of the Dobbs House and the Travelodge Motel, would have been closed as these are the only two business establishments in the area open after midnight. However, on 4/26/68, WF #442-A was exhibited to employees of numerous businesses in the area without effecting any identification or obtaining any additional information.

JOHN C. MEDIZER was located at his place of employment, Texas Nameplate Company, 1900 South Ervay Street, at which time he was interviewed.

MEDIZER stated that he left Chicago, Illinois, on March 31, 1968, by way of Greyhound Bus, directly to Dallas, Texas, with an approximate 2-hour layover at St. Louis, Missouri, on the same date. He stated that he arrived in Dallas early on the morning of April 1, 1968, and immediately contacted a friend of his by the name of EDDIE CRANFIELD, who lives at 5506 East R. L. Thornton Freeway.

MEDIZER stated before leaving Chicago he lived at 4601 Belmont and worked for the Rotp-Print Company.

He stated that while in Chicago he was a member of the American Nazi Party (ANP) and plans to continue his membership with the ANP by paying his dues to the ANP headquarters in Arlington, Virginia. MEDIZER further stated he does not plan to contact any of the ANP members in Dallas, Texas, since he is becoming inactive in the ANP inasmuch as he is getting married shortly to a Dallas girl by the name of CHARLENE HARRIS, who works at the Coca Cola Bottling Company, Dallas.

MEDIZER stated that on April 1, 1968, he obtained a construction job through his friend, EDDIE CRANFIELD, with the Leroy Roberts Construction Company, 4031 Mission Street, Dallas. He stated that he worked continuously at this construction company with EDDIE CRANFIELD until approximately April 12, 1968, at which time he left that company because he did not like construction work. MEDIZER stated that he then began working for the Texas Namplate Company on April 18, 1968, and has been so employed to the present date.

MEDIZER then stated that in regard to the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., he does not recall ever making any threats against the life of KING, however, since he is a member of the ANP, he does not agree at all with the policies followed by KING or his successors. He stated, however, that as a member.

Ré Chicago teletypes to Bureau dated 4/25 and 5/2/68 Dallas teletype to Bureau dated 4/26/68, and Springfield teletype to Chicago and Dallas dated 5/3/68.

A summary of investigation conducted at Dallas is set out as follows:

Om 5/6/68, JOHN C. MEDIZER was located at his place of employment, the Texas Nameplate Company, 1900 S. Ervay Street, hallas. Records of that company as furnished by Mrs. MARSARET ROSE, Personnel Department, reflected that MEDIZER had been employed by that company as a printer since 4/18/68, with his residence shown as 5006 East R. L. Thornton Expressway, Dallas. Personnel records of the above company also reflected that MEDIZER sustained an injury while on duty on 4/28/68, and at that time he gave the above address:

On 5/6/68, MEDIZER was interviewed at the Texas Sameplate Company and stated that he left Chicago, Illinois, on 3/31/68, by way of Greyhound Bus, directly to Dallas, Texas, with an approximate 2-hour layover at fit. Louis, Missouri, on the same date. He stated that he arrived Dallas early on the morning of 4/1/68, and immediately contacted a friend of his

by the name of EDDIE CRANFIELD, who lives at 5506 East R. L. Thornton Freeway. MEDIZER stated that before leaving Chicago he lived at 4601 Belmont and worked for the Roto-Print Company. He stated that while in Chicago he was a member of the American Nazi Party (ANP) and plans to continue his membership with the ANP by paying his dues to the ANP headquarters in Arlington, Virginia. MEDIZER further stated that he does not plan to contact any of the ANP members in Dallas, Texas, since he is becoming inactive in the ANP inasmuch as he is getting married shortly to a Dallas girl by the name of CHARLENE HARRIS, who works at the Coca Cola Bottling Company, Dallas, Texas.

MEDIZER then stated that on 4/1/68, he obtained a construction job through his friend, EDDIE CRANFIELD, with the Leroy Roberts Construction Company, 4031 Mission Street, Dallas, Texas. He stated that he worked continuously at this construction company with EDDIE CRANFIELD until approximately 4/12/68, at which time he left that company because he did not like construction work. MEDIZER stated that he then began working for the Texas Nameplate Company on 4/18/68, and has been so employed to the present date.

MEDIZER then stated that in regard to the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR, he does not recall ever making any threats against the life of KING, however, since he is a member of the ANP, he does not agree at all with the policies followed by KING or his successors. He stated, however, that as a member of the ANP he does not believe in violence and the present policy of the ANP is against physical violence.

MEDIZER is described as white male; born 3/6/40, at Chicago, Illinois; 5'10"; 145 pounds, Selective Service No. 11-128-40-55 (Classified as 1-A with the Benton, Illinois Selective Service Board); blue eyes, blond hair.

MEDIZER stated that since he is getting married in the near future, he plans to stay in the Dallas area and purchase a home and become inactive in the ANP.

He further stated that Mr. LEROY ROBERTS or his foreman, BILL DAVIDSON, could vouch for his whereabouts from 4/1 to 12/68.

On 5/6/68, Mr. BILL DAVIDSON, Foreman with the Leroy Roberts Construction Company (supra), advised SA JAMES W. ANDERTON that his payroll records reflect that JOHN C. MEDIZER was employed

by that company as a fork lift operator (assistant) from 4/1/68 through 4/12/68. Mr. DAVIDSON stated that in addition to his pay roll records he recalls MEDIZER working during that period with his friend, EDDIE CRANFIELD.

One of the passengers shown for AAL flight 338 on 4-6-68 is MISS KATHY LYNN SMITH, telephone 713 MU7 2584.

Area Security Supervisor SW Bell Telephone,

JAMES VAUGHAN/was contacted on 5-2-68 in an attempt to determine the location of this telephone in order to set forth a lead. He advised that this was not a good number was as there is no MU exchange in Area Code 713.

New York was requested to recheck the passenger manifest at AAL to verify the number or for any additional information. NY replied that no additional information was available and that the number had been reported correctly.

Numerous attempts to call 713 MU 7 2584 resulted in a ringing telephone, but no answer. Finally on this date the telephone was answered by a female who identified herself as MRS. FRANKIE THORNTON, Route 3, Grapeland, Texas, telephone 713 MU 7 2584. She explained that KATHY LYNN SMITH is her four-year-old granddaughter and that she went along on the flight in question to take care of her granddaughter.

MRS. THORNTON stated that she hasnot seen any pictures of JAMES EARL RAY, and she was advised that an agent would undoubtedly come by her home to exhibit a photo of Ray to her. She stated that she resides on the Farm to Market (number not known to her) 6.6 miles east of Grapeland, Texas.



AT LUFKIN, TEXAS.

CHARLES SHIPWASH, 504 Culverhouse St., was interviewed on 4/9/68. He advised he met "Sandy" outside Slim's Beer lounge just across the Neches river on Hwy 94 about 1:30PM or 2:00 PM and had two beers in SHIPWASH's car. SHIPWASH was unable to give a clear account of what was said but stated he understood Sandy claimed to have been involved in the KING shooting and had been in Memphis and was going "South" and needed a place to hide out. SHIPWASH advised Sandy appeared to have been drinking or taking "pills" but was not intoxicated. Sandy gave no specific indication of having traveled a long distance and was familiar with the Lufkin, Texas area but did not appear to know the immediate area of Apple Springs or Trinity County. SHIPWASH advised he did not observe the license on Sandy's car and the only Italy items he saw in the car were a rifle with scope, pair of tan leather engineers boots and plastic electricians gloves.

SHIPWASH advised he gave the man IX his address on Culverhouse St. and the man appeared to be familiar with the location and indicated he would visit or contact SHIPWASH later in the evening. SHIPWASH advised he would immediately notify the Agent if he has any further contact with Sandy.

On 4/9/68 a check of parking areas of beer taverns on Hwy. 94 west of the Neches River failed to locate a blue 1957 Chevrolet.

On 4/9/68 VESTER CULLINS, Slim's Beer, advised he had some recollection of seeing a blue or turquois 1957 or 1958 Chevrolet turn around near the tavern about 1:30 PM or 2:00 PM and head back toward Lufkin, Texas. He did not see the driver and the car was not known to him. CULLINS advised he did not see two men dringing in a car near the tavern and recalled no stranger being in the tavern during the afternoon.
