ONLY A PORTION OF THE FIRST CHARACTER IS PRESENT ON EACH TAG, AND THIS CHARACTER IS CUT ON A SLIGHT BIAS. NO OTHER VISIBLE LAUNDRY MARKS WERE FOUND ON EITHER GARMENT.

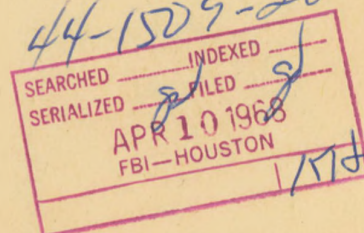

At 10:30 p.m., 4/8/68, I received a telephone call from SA JOHN FOARDE, Legat, Mexico City, in above captioned matter. He stated he had received information indicating that an individual who resembles the description of the assassin of Dr. KING was presently on Pan American Flight No. 502, which was due to arrive in Houston at 11:59 p.m., 4/8/68. He stated this individual reportedly came to Mexico City from Honduras, however, it was not known what transportation he used from Honduras to Mexico City or what his destination was other than Houston, Texas.

He stated that the individual was traveling under the name of CLAUDE CHESTER McCLAREN, JR., and had American Passport No. [REDACTED]. The only background information available to FOARDE was that McCLAREN was born 9/12/36 in Texas.

He stated that the only information the Legat had concerning the assassination of Dr. KING was what had been published in the newspapers and, therefore, he was furnishing such information to this office for evaluation and for whatever action was deemed appropriate.

Subsequent to the receipt of my call from the Legat, I called the Houston Office and caused a search to be made of the indices concerning McCLAREN. No record was located. At that time I was advised by Security Patrol Clerk TISDALE that he had received information from Pan American relaying information which had been received from INS and the Mexican Police in Mexico City which was generally the same information as furnished by the Legat. The only exception was to the effect that McCLAREN apparently has been out of this country since 3/30/68.

I telephonically contacted SA MAL PRICE, Night Supervisor at the Memphis Office, who stated that he would furnish this information to SAC JENSEN, who was unavailable to the writer to determine if the name McCLAREN was known to that office. He stated that possibly the description of McCLAREN may have resembled the initial sketch (artist's conception) of the assassin as prepared by a newspaper man, however, this was only a general description and it was the opinion of the Memphis Office that this artist's conception was not too accurate. He stated, however, he would contact SAC JENSEN and let this office know.

He subsequently called the Houston Office and advised that he was not suggesting any specific investigative action, however, that if McCLAREN was interviewed particular attention should be paid to his whereabouts on 3/29/68 and 3/30/68, and on 4/4/68, the date of the assassination. It is to be noted that the rifle used in the assassination had been purchased in Birmingham on either 3/29 or 3/30/68.

The writer and SA WEIR, to whom this case is assigned, immediately proceeded to the Houston International Airport where they contacted Captain THOMAS N. WHITE, pilot of Pan American Flight No. 502. Captain WHITE advised that McCLAREN was supposed to have boarded his flight in Mexico City at 10:20 p.m., however, he was detained by the Federal Police in Mexico City. However, the details were unknown to Captain WHITE. He did state, however, that McCLAREN had a ticket which indicated that he had entered Honduras on 3/30/68, and had been ticketed from New Orleans, Louisiana, to Honduras. Captain WHITE also furnished a Xerox copy of an artist's conception of the assassin which had been prepared by a member of the Federal Police in Mexico City and which had been published in a local newspaper there. He also furnished a Xerox copy of a photograph of CLAUDE McCLAREN which had been taken by a photographer at the airport in Mexico City. These are attached to this memo. It should be noted that there is a strong resemblance between the photo of McCLAREN and the artist's conception of the assassin as appearing in the Mexican newspapers, however, it is not known how reliable this sketch might be.

I subsequently contacted SA FOARDE in Mexico City and advised him that McCLAREN had been detained in Mexico City and was not on Pan American Flight No. 502 as previously furnished to this office. He stated that he would follow this matter with the Mexican authorities.

STEINMEYER and OTTO T. VAN RY:

On 4/8/68 JIM HAYDEN, Limousine Service, which service handles the Houston Municipal Airport, advised that his records disclose LUPY DELAO who is currently working for Delta Airlines at the Houston Municipal Airport was on duty at the airport when the Delta Flight arrived at 2:55 AM and his records disclosed that DELAO had six persons whom he transported in his limousine to downtown Houston, which persons presumably were from the Delta flight mentioned above.

LUPY DELAO, 1815 Louis, telephone CA 8-6119 advised that he did in fact transport passengers from the Delta flight which arrived at 2:50 AM and he recalled that there were six adult white males who requested transportation in his limousine. He stated he dropped three of the men at the Sheraton Lincoln Hotel in downtown Houston, two of the men were dropped at the Rice Hotel in downtown Houston and one man was dropped at the Downtowner Motel in Houston, Texas. DELAO advised that the two men he dropped at the Rice Hotel indicated at first that they intended to be dropped at the Downtowner Motel however when getting in the vicinity of the Rice Hotel changed their minds and asked to be dropped off at the Rice Hotel. DELAO stated that these two men had very little luggage and each one carried only a small handbag. DELAO stated he could not furnish any descriptive data regarding the two men he dropped off at the Rice Hotel and did not in fact know if they actually stayed at the Rice Hotel or one of the other hotels in the area. DELAO stated that he would have arrived at the Rice Hotel at approximately 3:30 AM as this is the amount of time it normally takes to drive to the Rice Hotel from the airport via the route he took.
