CALLS FROM PUBLIC TELEPHONES INTERSTATE 10, DECEMBER 15-17, 1967

The following investigation was conducted by SA R. GERARD ROBINSON:

On May 7, 1968, Mr. WALTER FRIDAY, Administrator, Choctaw General Hospital, Butler, Alabama, advised that telephone number 459-2461 has been assigned to that hospital for several years. He said that he has no knowledge concerning any telephone calls received at this hospital from Orange, Texas, or any out-of-state calls in December 1967, as such calls received by the hospital are not centrally recorded. He said that he could not recall any patient at the hospital who might logically have received any telephone calls from Orange, Texas. FRIDAY advised that he checked with several clerical employees of the hospital who served at varying times on telephone duty but none could recall any long distance calls from the State of Texas.

The following investigation was conducted by SA ROBERT D. CAMPBELL:

On May 8, 1968, Mr. CHARLES B. STEPHENS, Semmes Nursery, Semmes, Alabama, advised that he has had telephone number 342-1435 for a long time and that during the middle of December 1967, he had received a call at the Nursery from a customer by the name of PATFIELD, who called from Houston, Texas. He said that PATFIELD had a short time before gone into the nursery business and was then making most of his telephone calls from public telephones.

On May 8, 1968, WILLIAM T. HODGES, 1107 Hannon Road, Mobile, Alabama, advised that he has had telephone number 479-8740 for the past ten years. He said that he occasionally drives a truck moving furniture for Bekins Van Lines and on December 16, 1967, he was in Corpus Christi, Texas, at the residence of a sister-in-law. He recalled the date as it was his sister-in-law's birthday, and on that occasion, he called his wife in Mobile from Corpus Christi.

He said that he had not made any phone calls from Houston, Texas, to his home in Mobile at any time.

Mrs. WILLIAM T. HODGES advised that the only long distance call she received in Mobile in December 1967 was from her husband in Corpus Christi, Texas. She said that she had received no call from the Houston, Texas, area.

The Mobile telephone number 479-7378 is issued to Captain Pete's Restaurant and Lounge, Highway 90. Inquiry at the Lounge on May 8, 1968, reflected that the manager of this establishment during December 1967 was FRANCES PATRONAS, who is now located in Bel Air Apartments, Mobile.

On May 9, 1968, Mrs. FRANCES PATRONAS, Apartment 140, Bel Air Apartments, advised that she recalls receiving no telephone calls at Captain Pete's Restaurant and Lounge from the State of Texas during December 1967 and could furnish no information concerning any such calls.

MARGARET GRIFFIN and MARY WEATHERELL, waitresses at Captain Pete's Restaurant and Lounge during December 1967, were located through Mrs. PATRONAS. MARGARET GRIFFIN could recall no telephone calls from the State of Texas. MARY WEATHERELL advised she recalls a man who had been a customer at this Lounge on a number of occasions, name not recalled, and she seems to recall that this customer had received a phone call one night from a girl friend from Texas. The call she has recollection of was definitely a personal call from a girl friend. She said that this man is a traveling salesman who had been coming through Mobile on a number of occasions in the past and had frequently stopped in at this Lounge.

These persons were shown photographs of JAMES EARL RAY but could not identify any of the photographs as being similar to anyone seen by them in the past.

The following investigation was conducted by SA EARLE HALEY:

AT FORT WORTH, TEXAS

On 4/25/68, MR. FRED FICK, Attorney, 202 Burk Burnett Building, furnished the following information:

He has known JAMES ALLEN SWITH for about two years.

SHITH has been in a lot of trouble and has a long arrest record.

In the summer of 1967 SMITH was in the Tarrant County Jail on four charges of burglary, forgery, and theft. He contacted FICK on several occasions to represent him and get him out on boad. SMITH could not raise any money and finally raised a total of \$400. FICK had set a fee of \$700. SMITH told FICK he owned some property in Housian and had some assets in Houston and if he could get out he could easily raise the other \$300 and pay him in full. FICK finally agreed to make the bonds and SMITH was released. He talked to SMITH after he was released from jail. SMITH was going to Houston and liquidate some assets and pay FICK the balance of his fee for making his bonds.

FICK never saw or heard from SMITH until 2/29/68, when he read in the paper that SMITH was arrested with WALKER MARK FLANAGAN, well known Fort Worth police character, in Dallas. SMITH and

FLANAGAN were immediately taken to Houston, Texas, to face a number of burglary charges. FICK went to the District Attorney's Office in Fort Worth to get off the bonds of SMITH and learned that SMITH had been cooperating with law enforcement officers to get evidence on MARK FLANAGAN. FICK did not plan to make any bond for SMITH in Houston, Texas. District Attorney in Fort Worth and Houston, along with state officers asked his assistance in this matter, and he made bond for SMITH in Houston on or about 3/4/68. He has not seen nor heard from SMITH since then. He has tried to locate SMITH through all known contacts in Fot Worth but has not been successful. He had heard rumors that SMITH might have been killed for cooperating with officers regarding MARK FLANAGAN. He has also heard that SMITH is using this as an excuse to lay low. related that SMITH is a chronic liar, boastful, and exaggerates stories about himmlf. He stated SMITH is a low-life police character and will do most anything to raise a few dollars. FICK had never heard of SMITH having any dealings with MARTIN LUTHER KING and never heard SMITH mention "South Christian Conference." He has talked about everything else but this matter to FICK. SMITH claimed he could do nearly anything FICK did not trust or believe SMITH very much prior to on earth. last time he made bonds for him. He stated at this time be would not believe SMITH "on a stack of Bibles." SMITH has been involved in car thefts but FICK never heard of him being involved in Georgia or deep South. FICK is still trying to locate SMITH, as they have indicated they would call his case in Houston, Texas, in the near future. FICK related if he should receive any information as to the whereabouts of SMITH, he would notily the Fort Worth RA.

MR. H. J. COBB, Deputy Sheriff, was contacted on 4/29/68 and furnished the following information:

He is well acquainted with JAMES ALLEN SMITH and has handled him for auto theft in the past. SMITH is wanted by his attorney and bondsman at this time. SMITH is also wanted for questioning in Oklahoma, but they have not issued a warrant. COBB believes SMITH is hiding due to the fact he cooperated with law enforcement officers in arresting WALTER MARK FLANAGAN. COBB stated SMITH might have been buried but he had not learned any definite information to sustain this belief.

MR. G. W. BURKS, Texas Ranger, advised on 5/2/68, he had not heard from SMITH and had not been able to develop any information as to his whereabouts. He stated SMITH might have been knocked off by some friends of MARK FLANAGAN. BURKS knows SMITH well and has talked to a number of contacts of SMITH but has not been able to locate SMITH. He stated SMITH talks big, brags, tells big stories, and is one of the biggest liars in the world.

MR. GLEN HAWKINS, Detective, Fort Worth PD, was contacted on 5/6/68. He advised he is well acquainted with JAMES ALLEN SMITH. He has made inquiries through all his sources but has not turned up any information on SMITH. He related SMITH could be buried by some friends of MARK FLANAGAN or SMITH might be taking advantage of the situation, has left Fort Worth, and is laying low. HAWKINS had never heard of SMITH being involved in anyting in Georgia or Alabama. He further related he would not believe SMITH or any of the big stories he tells.

MR. FRED FICK was recontacted on 5/7/68, at which time he advised he had not received any information as to the whereabouts of SMITH. The case at Houston has been called but he obtained a postponement for 60 days.

No further investigation being conducted to locate SMITH.

Other Offices receiving copies of this airtel were not furnished rerep and so the following background information is being set forth to assist these Offices in conducting the requested investigation:

Investigation has determined that the subject, using the name of ERIC GALT, left Los Angeles, Calif., on 12/15/67, driving his Mustang automobile, in the company of CHARLES J. STEIN, of Los Angeles. STEIN had formerly been a resident of New Orleans and the alleged purpose of this trip was for STEIN to pick up two children of his sister's who were residing in New Orleans and return them to California. According to STEIN, they arrived in New Orleans on 12/17/67 and left New Orleans on 12/19/67. STEIN stayed with relatives and investigation has determined that subject registered at the Provincial Motel, 1024 Chartres Street, New Orleans, on 12/17/67 as ERIC S. GALT and was assigned room 126. The registration card indicated GALT's automobile to be a Mustang bearing Alabama license 1-38993 and his address as 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, The subject, as GALT, stayed at the motel until 12/19/67 when he checked out.

Interviews of motel employees in regards to the subject have been negative in that they cannot recall him.

There is set forth under a caption for each Office the identity or identities of persons staying at the Provincial Motel from 12/17 through 19/67. The identities of these persons were obtained from the motel registration cards as well as other information which is set forth under the name. The date listed under each name is the date the individual or individuals stayed at the motel. Each Office should locate and interview these individuals for any knowledge or contact they may have had with the subject. Various photographs of JAMES EARL RAY, which have been furnished to all Offices, should be displayed to these individuals to ascertain if they recall RAY.

In order to assist Memphis, the Office of Origin in this matter, each Office should set forth the results of this investigation in report form with copies of the reports designated for the Bureau and Memphis.

In the preparation of these reports, it is suggested that an appropriate predication for this part of the investigation be utilized in the details prior to reporting the results of contacts with these individuals. As an example, the following information might be used for this predication:

Information was Received from the New Orleans Office of the FBI that (insert name and address of person) had registered on (insert date) at the Provincial Motel, 1024 Chartres Street, New Orleans, Louisiana.

Of course, if any pertinent information is developed as a result of these contacts, this information should be brought to the attention of the Bureau and Memphis by the most expiditious means.

Other Offices receiving copies of this airtel were not furnished rerep and so the following background information is being set forth to assist these Offices in conducting the requested investigation:

Investigation has determined that the subject, using the name of ERIC GALT, left Los Angeles, Calif., on 12/15/67, driving his Mustang automobile, in the company of CHARLES J. STEIN, of Los Angeles. STEIN had formerly been a resident of New Orleans and the alleged purpose of this trip was for STEIN to pick up two children of his sister's who were residing in New Orleans and return them to California. According to STEIN, they arrived in New Orleans on 12/17/67 and left New Orleans on STEIN stayed with relatives and investigation has determined that subject registered at the Provincial Motel, 1024 Chartres Street, New Orleans, on 12/17/67 as ERIC S. GALT and was assigned room 126. The registration card indicated GALT's automobile to be a Mustang bearing Alabama license 1-38993 and his address as 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, The subject, as GALT, stayed at the motel until 12/19/67 when he checked out.

Interviews of motel employees in regards to the subject have been negative in that they cannot recall him.

There is set forth under a caption for each Office the identity or identities of persons staying at the Provincial Motel from 12/17 through 19/67. The identities of these persons were obtained from the motel registration cards as well as other information which is set forth under the name. The date listed under each name is the date the individual or individuals stayed at the motel. Each Office should locate and interview these individuals for any knowledge or contact they may have had with the subject. Various photographs of JAMES EARL RAY, which have been furnished to all Offices, should be displayed to these individuals to ascertain if they recall RAY.

In order to assist Memphis, the Office of Origin in this matter, each Office should set forth the results of this investigation in report form with copies of the reports designated for the Bureau and Memphis.

In the preparation of these reports, it is suggested that an appropriate predication for this part of the investigation be utilized in the details prior to reporting the results of contacts with these individuals. As an example, the following information might be used for this predication:

Information was Received from the New Orleans Office of the FBI that (insert name and address of person) had registered on (insert date) at the Provincial Motel, 1024 Chartres Street, New Orleans, Louisiana.

Of course, if any pertinent information is developed as a result of these contacts, this information should be brought to the attention of the Bureau and Memphis by the most expiditious means.
