#### Results of examination:

The bullet which was previously submitted by the Atlanta Office as having been removed from the body of Robert Joseph Dunaway consisted of a portion of the lead core from a metal jacketed bullet. No barrel markings of the type necessary for identification of the weapon from which this bullet was fired are present on this bullet. Therefore, no comparison between this bullet and the test bullet in K275 is possible.

There are no specimens in the Mational Unidentified Ammunition File which could have been fired from the same weapon as the test bullet and cartridge case, K275.

Mo previous record of the weapon represented by K275 was located in the Mational Stolen Property Index or the Mational Crime Information Center.

Specimen K275 is being returned to Atlanta herewith.

Enclosed for the Bureau are .360 bullet fixed from a .360 Remington UNC Automatic, SN PA18949, and a .360 cartridge case fixed from the same weapon.

The Bureau is requested to compare bullet with bullet ferwarded by Atlanta in relet, which had been taken from the body of ROBERT JOSEPH DUBAWAY, FBI No. 841 310C.

The .380 Remington weapon was obtained by an efficial of the Atlanta Police Department (APD), from SAN BONMARITO, Kingston, Tennessee. BONMARITO claimed this weapon was registered in Michigan. BONMARITO, when interviewed by Police officials of the APD, admitted ROBERT JOSEPH DUNAWAY had stayed at his hime from approximately April 6, until approximately April 28, 1968. BONMARITO claimed he had met DUNAWAY approximately one year before when DUNAWAY came to Kingston, Tennessee, and picked up SAN AGOSTA. AGOSTA at that time was evading service of a subpoona to testify before a State Grand Jury in Detroit concerning LCM activities.

The Bureau is also requested to compare bullet and cartridge with any bullets and cartridges in unselved LCH murders on file.

The Bureau has received an anonymous religious greeting card the envelope of which bears the postmark Hoboken, New Jersey, and is dated May 17, 1968. Attached to the greeting card is a "Miraculous" religious medal and a message on this card implies that subject James Earl Ray could be located at an address in Memphis, Tennessee.

The handwriting and hand printing appearing on the envelope and greeting card were searched in the Anonymous Letter File but could not be identified with any prior submissions to this file, and no identifying features were noted on these two items which might indicate their immediate source.

The writings appearing on the envelope and greeting card were compared with the writings which have been submitted in connection with the MURKIN case but nothing of significance was noted.

The greeting card and envelope will be forwarded to the Latent Fingerprint Section for appropriate examination.

Significant differences were noted as the result of comparing the "William A. Marshall" signatures on Q343 and Q344 with the known handwriting of JAMES EARL RAY, K171, K211 and K257, indicating that the questioned Marshall signatures were probably not prepared by Ray.

WICK initially contacted Thomasville Resident Agency 4/15/68, and advised a suspicious white male checked into his tourist court, the Woodland Motor Court, Thomasville, on 4/5/68 about 1:00 A.M. and departed following morning. White male driving 1965 white Ford Mustang bearing 1967 or 1968 Texas license FBG-848. White male described as about 32 years of age; 5'8", 160 pounds; muscular build and broad shoulders; sandy-colored hair. Subject's personal belongings only consisted of shaving kit and he left the following morning wearing the same clothes worn at time of entry. During registration this individual was very nervous and in attempting to reach assigned cabin, drove over sidewalk of motor court. Registrant did not appear to have been drinking, however.

WICK was subsequently shown Wanted Flyer of JAMES EARL RAY. WICK advised photo closely resembles suspicious person-but is certain registrant had light-colored, sandy hair and that this was his natural-colored hair inasmuch as approximately one day's growth of beard was the same color.



it reads: "Be sure & put that letter you receive tomorrow in the mail box- Listen to nobody or call the F.B.I. office if anybody tells you not to." Card bore a 10¢ airmail stamp, cancelled.

Mrs. INGRAM at same time furnished an opened brown manilla, large size envelope, also bearing p.m., May 2, 1968, postmark and addressed to MAXINE INGRAM, which she identified as coming also from ROBERT P. ANDERSON, her former employer.

Inside this manilla envelope was a white legal-size envelope addressed: "Mrs. DEMPES, 8251 Burley, Chicago, Illinois 60617". The second letter in name DEMPES is not clearly legible.

None of the above-described card or envelopes bears ANDERSON's name or return address.

Review of San Antonio files reflects ROBERT P. ANDERSON known to Chicago Office, when he was considered as possible suspect in UNSUB; MURDER OF VALERIE PERCY, Kenilworth, Illinois, 9/18/66, POLICE COOPERATION, Chicago file 62-6435.

The following description of ANDERSON was obtained 8/1/68 from Bureau of Records and Communications, Chicago, Ill., Police Department:

ROBERT P. ANDERSON, white male; born Chicago, Ill.,; 5'10"; 180 pounds; blue eyes; blond or brown hair; ruddy complexion; SSN YA C-4-906-733. ANDERSON has San Antonio PD # 68285.

Retel 5/1/68 reflects ANDERSON on interview by Bureau Agents in recent past acknowledged writing letter to SAC JOHN P. MULL, JR., Phoenix Division: "Either JOHN C. MULL JR. kills himself or certainly I will".

ANDERSON also came to notice of Chicago, Illinois, Police in the past, having shot and injured a woman at a social gathering.

Inasmuch as ANDERSON, aka, RUSSELL JOHNSTONE, appears
