Enclosed herewith for the Laboratory are registration cards for the Candlelight Inn, 4801 Airline Highway, Metairie, La., numbers 8267, 3468, 3534, 3324, 3325, 3370, 3471, 3373, 3746, and 3360. Also enclosed for the Laboratory is a registration card, number 6334, from the Chalmette Hotel, 303 Carondelet Street.

The following information was developed based on a report of a Checkmate following publication of photograph of JAMES SCOTT HORDAL, white male, resided 633 Royal Street, New Orleans, La., from 4/1 through 4/17/68, but maid states he was absent from his room most of the time.

HORDAL was employed as a waiter at the Court of Two Sisters Restaurant, 613 Royal Street, from 3/24 until 4/13/68, with absences on 4/4 and possibly on other dates. HORDAL furnished background information to the Court of Two Sisters Restaurant which included a California drivers license and a list of all schools which he attended in California along with his mother's address in Los Angeles, California.

NORDAL placed a second lock on his room and permitted no one access to this room while he was absent. NORDAL had a large quantity of clothing and luggage and on one occasion the maid saw a large quantity of currency in a pack in the bed that contained a \$100 bill on the top.

During a search of NORDAL's room a key to the Candlelight Inn, 4301 Airline Highway, Metairie, La., was found. This key was for Room 219. A map was also found in this room that bore several cryptic notations.

The Los Angeles Division has advised the New Orleans Division telephonically that all background information furnished by NORDAL at the Court of Two Sisters has been checked and has proved to be false. The records of the Candlelight Inn Motel were checked and registration cards for Room 219 were obtained for all individuals not known to be regular customers at this motel. Further investigation in New Orleans disclosed that SCOTT NORDAL stayed at the Chalmette Hotel, 808 Carondelet Street, New Orleans, La., from 3/23 - 3/23/68.

The Laboratory is requested to compare the handwriting on all of the enclosed registration cards with the known handwriting of JAMES EARL RAY, and WALTER TERRY RIFE, FBI #455-876-6.

The Laboratory is also requested to attempt to determine through handwriting analysis if the individual registering as SCOTT NORDAL at the Chalmette Hotel signed any of the enclosed registration cards from the Candlelight Inn Motel.

All enclosed registration cards are also to be checked for any latent fingerprints of value which might be found. It is known that these registration cards have been handled by numerous individuals acting within the scope of their employment at their respective hotel or motel.

We have received from the General Investigative Division through the Baltimore Division a handwritten letter which is attributed to Daniel David Kennedy, 548 East 38th Street, Baltimore, Maryland. Kennedy is the individual who was apprehended by Mexican authorities in the early hours of April 25, 1968 and considered a "look alike" for James Earl Ray, the subject in this case.

As a result of comparing the questioned handwriting in the "MURKIN" case with the handwriting appearing on the letter authored by Kennedy, it was concluded that the two sets of writings previously mentioned were not prepared by the same individual.

We have received from the General Investigative Division an anonymous hand printed post card, directed to the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Washington, D.C., and postmarked Houston, Texas, April 20, 1968. This card states "Galt is professional killer. Lives off contracts. This one is from SNCC and rights leaders paid partly by Cuba. Galt and partners are in Cuba."

Because of evidence of distortion in the anonymous post card and because the style of hand printing on the card differs from that on specimens in the "MURKIN" case, it could not be definitely determined whether the hand printing on the card and on specimens in the Galt name were prepared by the same individual; however, differences were noted.

This post card cannot be identified in the Anonymous Letter File and will be forwarded to the Latent Fingerprint Section for appropriate examination.

We have received from the General Investigative Division copies of a typewritten letter and envelope addressed to the Social Security Administration, P.O. Box 5, Baltimore, Maryland. The letter is dated 2/29/68 and bears the handwritten signature Eric Galt and requests certain information concerning social security.

The typewritten impressions on the envelope and letter were found to be the same style of type as that appearing on other items received in this matter attributed to Eric S. Galt, but because of the presence of some variations and indistinctness in the photocopy, the Galt signature appearing on the letter cannot be identified as having been prepared by the writer of other signatures in the Galt name appearing on specimens previously received.

The Laboratory has received a copy of an anonymous typewritten communication which was forwarded to the Bureau by Inez Robb, United Feature Syndicate, Inc., New York City. This anonymous letter is dated April 3, 1968, postmarked at Ft. Pierce, Florida, and the writer suggests that "someone should pop him (Martin Luther King) off."

The typewritten impressions appearing on this anonymous letter were compared with those appearing on specimens submitted in the "MURKIN" case and found to be not identical. This letter was also searched in the Anonymous Letter File, but could not be identified with any items which have been included in this file.

The Laboratory has received from Secret Service, through Liaison, an anonymous handwritten letter which was addressed "To The President of The United States Mr. L. B. Johnson, Washington, D.C." This letter was postmarked April 4, 1968, at Savannah, Tennessee. In addition to generally castigating Reverend Martin Luther King, the anonymous writer states "someone will kill this man soon when everyone gets enough and I say the sooner the better!"

The writings in this letter were compared with the writings submitted in the "MURKIN" case and found to be not identical. The letter and envelope were also searched in the Anonymous Letter File but could not be identified with any prior submissions to this file.

The above mentioned anonymous letter has been forwarded to the Latent Fingerprint Section for appropriate examination.

The General Investigative Division has forwarded to the Laboratory an anonymous hand printed letter which was addressed to the "DIRECTOR F. B. I. WASHINGTON, D. C. U. S. A." This letter was postmarked "MONTREAL 7 PM 21 IV P. Q." The letter states that James Earl Ray will be found at a place about 14 miles south of Millen, Georgia, along 121. A palm print also appears at the bottom of this letter.

The letter and envelope were searched through the Anonymous Letter File but could not be identified with any prior submissions to this file.

It was further determined that the hand printing appearing on this letter and envelope was not prepared by the individual responsible for the preparation of hand printing appearing on specimens in the "MURKIN" case attributed to Eric S. Galt. No identifying features were noted on these items which might indicate their immediate source.

The anonymous letter and envelope have been forwarded to the Latent Fingerprint Section for further examination.

On 4/18/68, SA Roger D. Ashland, Washington Field Office, brought to the Laboratory the photograph and signature of one Robert J. Corcoran who is currently applying for a passport and who was thought to be a "look alike" for Eric S. Galt. Corcoran, whose date of birth is given as [redacted] at Baltimore, Maryland, resides at 1929 Gwynn Oak Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, and listed occupation as a salesman.

The writings received in this case lack the comparability for an adequate comparison with the signature Robert J. Corcoran; however, nothing of particular significance was noted between the signature of Corcoran when compared with the writings attributed to Eric S. Galt, from such a comparison as could be made.

The Washington Field Office has forwarded this information to the Baltimore Division for further investigation and the above information was furnished to the Latent Fingerprint Section for a search of the records of the Identification Division and a subsequent comparison of any fingerprint cards located with the unidentified latents appearing on items received in this matter.

The General Investigative Division has forwarded to the Laboratory an anonymous typewritten letter which was postmarked at Long Beach, California, on April 15, 1968, and addressed to The Federal Bureau of Investigation. The paper on which this anonymous letter was prepared bears the letterhead "Army Air Forces, Technical Training Command, Miami Beach, Florida," and is dated April 15, 1968. This letter, obviously referring to the recovery of the white Mustang of Eric Starvo Galt in Atlanta, Georgia, requested that the Bureau please take care of the writer's white Mustang and the letter bore the typewritten signature "Eric Stavio Galt."

The typewritten impressions on the envelope and letter referred to above were compared with the typewriter impressions appearing on specimens received in this investigation which have been attributed to Eric Starvo Galt and these were found to be not identical.

The letter and envelope were also searched in the Anonymous Letter File without effecting an identification and have been forwarded to the Latent Fingerprint Section for appropriate examination.

BECAUSE OF LACK OF COMPARABLE LETTERS AND LETTER COMBINATIONS IT COULD NOT BE DETERMINED WHETHER THE HARVEY LOWMYER SIGNATURE BY WRITER OF MATERIAL ON THE MONEY ORDERS AND OTHER WRITINGS OF GALT.

Two garments were recovered from a blue bag abandoned at the scene of the murder and believed to be the property of the assassin. These two garments, a pair of shorts and a T-shirt, contain laundry markings consisting of a Thermo-Seal stick on type tape bearing the printed numbers "02B-6." Numerous of our field offices have been submitting strips of Thermo-Seal tape produced by laundry marking machines similar to the machine that would have been used to mark the questioned laundry marking. We have eliminated many of these and by our airtel of 4/11/68 advised Los Angeles that laundry markings Los Angeles submitted from Home Service Laundry and Dry Cleaning, 5280 Hollywood Boulevard, Hollywood, California, were similar to the questioned markings and no significant differences exist suggesting the questioned markings could have originated from the Home Service Laundry and Dry Cleaning Company.

Los Angeles has now verified from the records of Home Service Laundry and Dry Cleaning that a particular cleaning service was performed for "E. Galt" and this service is referred to in the records by the number "02B-6," thus obviating the need for pursuing this line of inquiry any further.

ACTION: Unless advised to the contrary, the samples of laundry tape submitted ~~but~~ not yet compared with questioned material will not be subjected to further examination since the source of the questioned material has now been established.

The General Investigative Division has forwarded to the Laboratory an anonymous letter which was received from the Department, dated April 9, 1968 addressed to the Attorney General. This letter names one Edward Gerst as the individual responsible for the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King. The letter further describes this individual as an East German communist who is now in Cuba trying to return to England where he will find friends who will get him back to East Germany.

As the result of an indices search, a reference was located for one Edward Sherman Gerst, Bureau File 67-418747, who was a Bureau applicant in 1947 at which time he was 13 years of age.

The writings appearing in the personnel file of Edward Sherman Gerst have been compared with the writings submitted in this matter attributable to the unknown subject also known as Eric S. Galt. Nothing of significance was noted between the available writings of Edward Sherman Gerst and the afore-mentioned writings of Eric S. Galt; however, these known writings were prepared over twenty years ago when Gerst was 13 years of age.

THE SIGNATURE OF JEROME W. VERNON, FBI
NUMBER SEVEN FOUR THREE TWO TWO SIX B, MANAGER OF
HOME SERVICE LAUNDRY AND DRY CLEANING, IS DISSIMILAR
FROM THE QUESTIONED HANDWRITING IN THE CASE AND IT IS
UNLIKELY THAT HE PREPARED ANY OF THE QUESTIONED
WRITING.

NOTE: Printed laundry markings appear on pair of men's shorts
and a T-shirt recovered from a blue bag believed to have been
abandoned by suspect in Memphis. It has been determined these markings
were made by a machine manufactured by Textile Marking Company,
Syracuse, New York. The field is making widespread inquiry of laundries
utilizing this type of equipment and has submitted numerous samples for
comparison with the questioned markings. To date only the samples
submitted by Los Angeles have any likelihood of having had a common
origin.
