ASSASSINATION OF MARTIN LUTHER KING. JR.

Mr. Phil M. Canale, Jr., State Attorney General, Shelby County, Memphis, Tennessee, who is handling the State's prosecution of James Earl Ray, has contacted our Memphis Office and requested that all physical evidence pertaining to the James Earl Ray case now in possession of the Bureau be forwarded to his office.

On September 16, 1968, Mr. D. Robert Owen of your Division authorized turning over to Memphis authorities the 1966 Mustang automobile, and Memphis authorities took possession of this car on September 24, 1968. This discussion with Mr. Owen was confirmed by letter dated September 19, 1968.

Mr. Owen on October 24, 1968, advised Special Agent Richard E. Long he had discussed with Mr. Canale the turning over of all evidence to him and as a result thereof, we should comply with the current request of Mr. Canale. We are, therefore, turning over to Mr. Canale all evidence in this case presently in the Bureau's possession. In accordance with Mr. Owen's request, an Agent of our Memphis Office will obtain the remaining evidence from our Laboratory and turn it over to Mr. Canale as this will minimize the testimony required for the chain of evidence.

NOTE:

Pursuant to instructions of the Department, we retained all of the evidence in this case recovered by us with the exception of the 1966 Mustang in view of the outstanding Federal Civil Rights charge. Department advised that Mr. Canale no doubt needs particular items of evidence in the Bureau's possession and we should furnish any item they request to them.

In view of the current request of Mr. Canale to turn all the evidence over to him, this matter was taken up with the Department on 10/22/68. On 10/24/68, Mr. Owen advised us in line set forth in attached letter. Memphis will be advised accordingly. Our Laboratory has been advised.

I. PERTITEM HISTORY

Reason for Admission: Pre-trial examination pursuant to Section 552.020 by

Circuit Court Order of Cole County elloged to be charged
with the crime of attempted escape.

Legal Status: Subject was transferred to this hospital for pre-trial evaluation from the Missouri State Penitentiary, where he was serving a sentance of twenty years, having been convicted of the crimes of first degrees robbory and two charges of operating a motor vehicle without the permission of the owner. In addition to the sentence, he is serving, he now has a charge against him of attempted escape.

Partinent Social History: According to ac empanying information received from the Hissouri State Penitentiary, at or about 9:00 p.m. on 11 March 1966, the subject attempted to escape and actually had hidden out inside the penitentiary valls until: was discovered at approximately 12:10 a.m. on 13 March 1966 attempting to make his way to the roof from which he apperently planned to scale the prison wall. He had placed a dummy in his bod to cover up for his absence at the 9:00 .m. count on 11 March and had taken a 14 foot iron red with a metal hock on the end with which he was able to scale several flet of one of the walls incide the penitentiary. He had cut a hole through a recurity screen on a window and had been hidding out from search parties on various areas of the roof.

Mr. James Ray was born on in Illinois. The record indicates that he completed ten grades of school and entered the Army in February 1946, where he served ustil December 1948, at which time he was discharged because of a lack of adaptability. His FRI record comprises one and one half pages and show numerous arrests for a variety of charges. He has carved contences in various penal institutions on conviction of such charges as robbery, forgery of postal coney orders, and car theft. He has been incarcerated in one or another penal institution a good part of his adult life.

PHYSICAL STATUS

There is no physical disease or defect which requires treatment at this time.

Payebological Testing: Psychological tests indicate that he has an IQ of 105
which places him within the average range of intellectual functioning. Tests also showed some degree of depression. The psychological tests showed no evidence of a psychosis.

IV. COURSE IN HOSPITAL

He has made a good hospital adjustment and has not been a maragement problem.

V. CONDITION AT PRESENT

Unchanged.

VI. DIAGNOSIS

Secionathic Percenality, Anticodal Type with suclety and depressive features.

Patient has been observed, studied and tested. No symptoms or signs indicating a mental disease or defect could be found. Although he showed signs of anxiety and depression, these could not be considered of psychotic proportions.

III. PINDLIOS

- i) That the accused has no mental disease or defect within the meaning of & Section 552.010.
- 2) That the accused has the capacity to understand the proceedings against him and can assist in his own defense.
- 3) That the accused did know and appreciate the nature, quality and wrongfulness of his conduct.

IX. RECONVENDATION

It is recommended that he be returned to the Minsouri State Penitentiary.




