On 4/6/68, Mrs. RAYMOND M. REISS, East Rock Road, Allentown, Pa., was interviewed by SA THOMAS F. HANNIGAN and C. HEBER SMITH.

She advised that she was the aunt of BRUCE JOSEPH WERKHEISER, who was born on [redacted], at Allentown, Pa., and who currently resides at 4375 Hillbrook Road, Memphis, Tenn., telephone number 398-0800. His parents are RAYMOND E. and LOUISE WERKHEISER. He currently attends the 11th grade at White Haven, Tenn., High School.

Mrs. REISS stated that BRUCE WERKHEISER had been in a motorcycle accident two years ago and had suffered severe head injuries. He was now ostensibly normal, although he does have periods of dizzy spells. He was hospitalized in Memphis, Tenn., at the time of his accident. He currently desires to study for the ministry.

He left home in Memphis on 4/2/68, when his father refused to purchase a 1965 automobile for him. He traveled to Allentown in a 1956 Pontiac automobile, color white over yellow, which is now currently at the REISS residence.

WERKHEISER arrived in Allentown at the REISS residence at 8:30 p.m., EST, on 4/4/68. Upon his arrival he had told the REISSes that he had heard over the car radio about KING's death.

During his stay in Allentown he made no phone calls to or from Memphis, other than to his parents.

Mrs. RAYMOND REISS stated that she had been present when BRUCE WERKHEISER had called United Airlines on 4/5/68, for airplane reservations. There had been some delay in making the reservations over the phone and while waiting BRUCE WERKHEISER made the comments attributed to him by Mrs. YVONNE BERNADINO to his cousin DOUGLAS. Mrs. REISS stated that she felt that the remarks were made in jest and that BRUCE WERKHEISER gives no indication of hatred for Negroes.

Mr. REISS was also present at that time, and admonished BRUCE WERKHEISER for his remarks in view of the current circumstances.

Mrs. REISS stated that BRUCE's father had paid for his plane fare and that they had put him on the flight to Memphis on 4/5/68.

Mr. RAY MOORE said that Mrs. BERNADINO called her supervisor to monitor the call, but when the supervisor did so the conversation switched to flight reservation matters.

WERKHEISER had previously held reservations which he said he was cancelling because he was awaiting money from his father in Memphis to make the trip there. WERKHEISER remade reservations for Flight 639 at 3:05 p.m., on 4/6/68, and from Allentown to Chicago O'Hare, with connection to Delta Flight 830 to Memphis.

At 7:00 p.m., RAY MOORE again contacted the Philadelphia Office and advised that WERKHEISER had changed reservations and was taking Flight 645 out of Allentown, Pa., on 7:22 p.m., on 4/5/68, arriving Pittsburgh 8:29 p.m. Then he would take Flight 821 out of Pittsburgh at 9:05 p.m., arriving 9:45 p.m., Memphis time.

MOORE stated that the telephone number which WERKHEISER left as a contact point was listed to a Mr. RAYMOND M. REISS, East Rock Road, Allentown, Pa., and that WERKHEISER's correct name was BRUCE WERKHEISER.

MOORE stated that WERKHEISER was described by the people at the Will-Call Ticket Desk as follows:

MOORE stated that WERKHEISER was accompanied to the airport by two adults and a young lady.

Attempts were made by Philadelphia to contact RAYMOND M. REISS during the pertinent flight period on 4/5/68, with negative results.

On 4/5/68, at 4:50 p.m., Mr. RAY MOORE, United Airlines Reservation Manager, Philadelphia, Pa., telephonically furnished the following information to Supervisor JOHN L. ADAMS:

Mrs. YVONNE BERNADINO, Reservations Clerk, was telephonically making an airplane reservation for a Mr. C. WERKHEISER, telephone number 797-4683. While preparing the reservation, she overheard the following comments from WERKHEISER:

"My buddy shot that b-----d, the police are still looking for him, but they will never find him because they hate the niggers as much as we do. All of them are going to get killed. I heard they are going to get Carmichael next - ya! He's going to get it and then Brown. My father said schools are closed and nothings opened. Should shoot all the niggers."

PHOTO
Kramer was reportedly born [redacted] at Portland,
Oregon, to Richard and Henrietta (nee Binsman) Kramer,
both native-born U. S. citizens. He is described as
6' 1" tall, 170 pounds, brown hair and brown eyes. He
reportedly attended University of Oregon, received BS
degree in June, 1958; MS degree in June, 1963 and MD
degree in June, 1963. Last known address is listed at
1472 C University Avenue, Berkeley, California.

Records of the Berkeley, California, Police
Department reveal he was charged on 4/7/66 for passing
a fictitious check, no disposition shown. On 1/30/66,
he was charged with possession of marijuana and sentenced
to 90 days in jail with three years' probation. As of
May, 1967, that charge was under appeal.

Kramer has frequently corresponded with CIA
and has been interviewed at which time he reportedly
engaged in a lengthy, rambling, disjointed discourse
which ranged in scope from the future economic position of
the world to the fact that a thermo nuclear conflict is
imminent.
