PAGE TWO

WAS EXPECTING MAIL. WHEN DEPARTED BOARDING HOUSE STATED HE WOULD SEND FORWARDING ADDRESS TO CHERPES, BUT NEVER DID. APPROXIMATELY MARCH ONE, LAST, LETTER RECEIVED FOR GALT BUT RETURNED TO POST OFFICE BY CHERPES. PRIOR TO DEPARTURE GALT MADE TELEPHONE CALL ALLEGEDLY FROM MOBILE, ALA., TO VERIFY EMPLOYMENT. THEREAFTER DEPARTED RESIDENCE STATING GOING TO MOBILE TO ACCEPT JOB ON A BOAT. CHERPES VIEWED ARTIST CONCEPTION, STATES REASONABLE LIKENESS EXCEPT GALT BELIEVED TO BE THINNER IN FACE.

PERCY STRICKLAND, BOARDER, ADVISED ARTIST CONCEPTION RESEMBLES GALT. GALT DESCRIBED AS SOFTSPOKEN AND RETIRING.

WILLIAM D. PAISLEY, SEVEN ZERO ONE FORTY EIGHTH STREET, SOUTH, BIRMINGHAM, RECALLS SELLING HIS SIXTY SIX WHITE MUSTANG HARDTOP, RED INTERIOR, TO ERIC GALT, TWO SIX ZERO EIGHT HIGHLAND AVE., TEL. THREE TWO THREE - NINE FOUR EIGHT SEVEN, BIRMINGHAM, ON AUG. THIRTY, LAST. ON AUG. TWO NINE, LAST, GALT ANSWERED NEWSPAPER AD FOR MUSTANG AND TOLD PAISLEY'S WIFE THAT HE WAS "NOT FAMILIAR WITH THE CITY." SHE ASKED HIM IF HE WORKED AND HE SAID, "I'M A BARGER. I'M HERE LOOKING FOR A JOB WITH SOCIAL SECURITY." GALT EXPLAINED "BARGER" AS PERSON WORKING ONE RIVER BARGES BETWEEN NEW ORLEANS AND ST. LOUIS, AND MEMPHIS. WHEN ASKED HOW HE COULD PAY FOR THE CAR, HE SAID, "I WILL PAY CASH."

GALT LATER CAME TO PAISLEY RESIDENCE IN A TAXI. HE DECLINED TO DRIVE THE MUSTANG, SAYING HE HAD NO ALA. DRIVER'S LICENSE, BUT HAD ONE FROM LOUISIANA. PAISLEY DROVE GALT AROUND SEVERAL BLOCKS IN MUSTANG AND GALT SAID, "I'LL TAKE IT OFF YOUR HANDS." GALT DID NOT LIKE THE OFF WHITE COLOR OF THE CAR. GALT SUGGESTED HE GIVE PAISLEY SOME "EARNEST MONEY" AND THAT PAISLEY SHOULD DRIVE HIM TO DOWNTOWN BIRMINGHAM. GALT TOLD PAISLEY THAT HE HAD BANK ACCOUNT AT BIRMINGHAM TRUST NATIONAL BANK.

PAISLEY SUGGESTED GALT PAY FOR AUTOMOBILE WITH CASHIERS CHECK AND GALT SAID HE DID NOT KNOW HOW TO GO ABOUT GETTING CASHIERS CHECK. THEY ARRANGED TO MEET THE NEXT DAY AT THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK, BIRMINGHAM, AT TEN A.M. PAISLEY AND HIS SON DAVID TOOK GALT TO FIRST AVE. AND TWENTIETH STREET NORTH, BIRMINGHAM. AT TEN FIFTEEN A.M., AUG. THIRTY, LAST, AFTER RECEIVING TELEPHONE CALL FROM GALT, PAISLEY AND HIS SON MET GALT ON STREET IN FRONT OF FIRST NATIONAL BANK. GALT PRODUCED TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS IN CASH, MOSTLY ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY DOLLAR BILLS. THEY WENT INSIDE BANK WHERE MONEY WAS COUNTED, FIVE DOLLARS CHANGE GIVEN BY PAISLEY TO GALT, AND PAISLEY GAVE GALT A BILL OF SALE AND PAISLEY'S SON TOOK GALT TO PARKING LOT, GAVE HIM THE KEYS AND HE DROVE OFF. PAISLEY'S SON LATER SAW THIS SAME CAR ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS PARKED IN FRONT OF ROOMING HOUSE IN THE TWENTY SIX HUNDRED BLOCK OF HIGHLAND AVENUE.

BOTH MR. AND MRS. PAISLEY AND SON DAVID RECALL GALT STATING HE WORKED ON A BARGE LINE AND SON RECALLS GALT SAYING HE WORKED "OUT OF" ST. LOUIS. HE CLAIMED TO THE PAISLEYS THAT HE WOULD WORK ABOUT TWENTY DAYS ON THE BARGE AND THEN BE OFF ABOUT TEN DAYS.

THE ELDER PAISLEYS RECALL GALT CLAIMING HE WAS MARRIED AND THAT HIS WIFE LIVES "NOW" OVER IN ROCKY RIDGE, (AN AREA SOUTH OF HOMEWOOD, ALA.). SON DAVID RECALLS GALT STATING HE WAS DIVORCED AND THAT HIS WIFE LIVED EITHER ON ROCKY RIDGE OR DOLLY RIDGE ROAD "OVER THE MOUNTAIN", REFERRING TO THAT AREA SOUTH OF HOMEWOOD, ALA. ALL THREE PAISLEYS STATE GALT NOT OBSERVED SMOKING, THAT HE WAS CLEAN CUT, VERY SHY AND QUITE, NEAT DRESSER, WITH POSSIBLY A WESTERN OR TEXAS ACCENT, DEFINITELY NOT NORTHERN, EASTERN OR VIRGINIAN. ELDER PAISLEYS DESCRIBE GALT AS WHITE MALE, AGE ABOUT THIRTY TWO, FIVE FT. TEN AND ONE-HALF, ONE FORTY FIVE LBS., ^DBARK BROWN OR BLACK HAIR WITH WIDOW'S PEAK. ELDER PAISLEYS BOTH STATE THEY ARE NOT SURE THEY COULD IDENTIFY GALT IF THEY OBSERVED HIM AGAIN. DAVID PAISLEY STATES HE CAN DEFINITELY IDENTIFY GALT. DAVID PAISLEY RECALLS GALT SAYING THAT HIS LOUISIANA DRIVER'S LICENSE HAD EXPIRED AND THAT HE HAD NOT OBTAINED AN ALABAMA LICENSE TO DATE (AUG. TWO NINE, LAST). HE WAS VERY EMPHATIC ABOUT NOT TEST DRIVING THE MUSTANG.

STATION, TWO ONE EIGHT EIGHT HIGHLAND AVENUE, RECALLS A MAN NAMED ERIC WHO HAD A WHITE MUSTANG AND WHO WAS A CUSTOMER AT THE STATION FROM THE FIRST PART OF DECEMBER, LAST, UNTIL ABOUT FEBRUARY, LAST. THIS PERSON PAID FOR ALL PURCHASES IN CASH, WAS ALWAYS ALONE, AND WAS OFTEN OBSERVED WEARING BUSINESS SUIT, SHIRT AND TIE. WAS DESCRIBED BY PHILLIPS, AS WHITE MALE, EARLY THIRTIES, FIVE FEET NINE - TEN, ONE EIGHTY POUNDS, BLACK HAIR, COMBED STRAIGHT BACK, VERY EASYGOING. BELIEVES THIS PERSON TOLD HIM HE WAS DIVORCED. PHILLIPS BELIEVES HE CAN IDENTIFY THIS PERSON IF HE OBSERVES HIM AGAIN.

INVESTIGATION TO LOCATE BANK ACCOUNTS REFLECTED THAT GALT HAD SAFETY DEPOSIT BOX, BIRMINGHAM TRUST NATIONAL BANK, BETWEEN SEPTEMBER AND DECEMBER, NINETEEN SIXTYSEVEN. RECORD OF ENTRY AS WELL AS LETTER SENT TO BANK BY GALT IN RESPONSE TO PAYMENT FOR BOX, OBTAINED AND HAND CARRIED TO LABORATORY FOR APPROPRIATE EXAMINATION. LEAD SET FORTH FOR JACKSON, NEW ORLEANS, AND MOBILE TO OBTAIN BACKGROUND INFORMATION AND IDENTIFY GALT UNPRODUCTIVE TO DATE. NEIGHBORHOOD INVESTIGATION REFLECTED ONE BAR MAID IDENTIFIED ARTIST CONCEPTION OF UNSUB AS HAVING BEEN IN BAR VICINITY FIRST
