All laundry agencies in Savannah checked, with negative results, re use of thermo-seal marking machine tags, red in color, bearing markings of 02B-6 or D2B-6.

Three area laundries were found to be using thermo-seal marking machines; however, number-letter systems and/or color of tags used differ from those mentioned in retel. The following additional information was determined, which may be of value to further investigative efforts:

Local laundry managers using thermo-seal markers advise that most red tags they have seen on laundry coming in for service are from military personnel recently arrived this area from other locations. In addition, local users advise that it is unusual to utilize a letter as the first digit in setting up a letter-number group such as D2B-6. Local users further advise that most systems encompass only a three-digit system, rather than the four-digit system mentioned in retel.

Furthermore, user advised the lettering and/or numbering found on older model thermo-seal markers is smaller than that on more recent models.

Laundry managers also advised that "finished" laundry, which would be tagged such as that in retel, might

YOUNG, Manager, Bonnie Bright Laundry, 3800 South Four Mile Run, Arlington, Va., by SA JOHN W. PFAFF, JR. Mr. YOUNG advised that Bonnie Bright Laundry uses the thermo seal marking tape similar to that shown on the clothing, however, his company has never used a marking code similar to the one on the clothing. His company has always used a marking code consisting of 4 alphabetic letters, a dash and then a number. Mr. YOUNG advised the R. E. Frank Company, 725 11th Street, N.W., Washington, D. C., telephone number 628-2851 is the area distributor from whom they buy their seal marking tape. Mr. YOUNG advised he knew of no laundry in the Northern Virginia area using a marking code similar to or identical with the code used on the clothing in the photograph.
