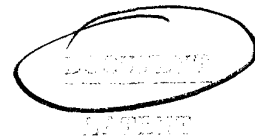

On 4/11/68, MICHAEL TAYLOR, part owner, Taylor-Hulse Dry Cleaning and Laundry, 1976 Ellis St., Augusta, Ga., advised that his company uses Thermoseal marking machine to attach cloth laundry tags to garments. They use code with two numerals designating lot number followed by letter designating week followed by number designating number of bundle. They use 11 colors and rotate colors after going through alphabet when starting over at A. TAYLOR checked his records and determined that the last time they issued number 02B 6 on red tag was on 7/13/67. TAYLOR located laundry ticket marked red 02B 6. This ticket was given to J. B. MC MICHAEL, 2062 Greene St., Augusta, Ga. It was dated 7/13/67, and covered laundry of one shirt, cost 30¢. TAYLOR said this price indicated the item laundered was an outer shirt as opposed to an undershirt. TAYLOR added that J. B. MC MICHAEL is his grandfather, is employed as secretary to all Scottish Rites bodies in the Augusta, Ga. area with his office in the BonAir Hotel. TAYLOR stated he

For the information of the Laboratory, Mr. BROTON advised that the Thermo Seal tape, Lot #5L7, was made in November or December, 1967, but their quality control does not show the number of warp yarns in the cloth. He further noted that the face of the tape has a whitish cast because it is coated with a starch-type material. He stated the true color appearing on the garments recovered in instant case would more closely resemble the color of the underside of the tape.

It is noted that Lot #5L7 was found to be the lot number of the tape in the possession of Home Service Laundry and Dry Cleaning, 5280 Hollywood Boulevard, Hollywood, California, as furnished to Albany Office by Los Angeles Office by re teletype.

The Laboratory is requested to compare the enclosed specimen of tape with the tape on the garments recovered immediately after the slaying at Memphis for identification of the tape.

The sets of type are furnished to the Laboratory for assistance in examinations being conducted on the laundry marks.

Enclosed for the FBI Laboratory are two 3" by 5" cards containing six Thermo Seal pieces of marking tape.

On 4/11/68, Mr. JOSEPH A. YOUNG, Manager, Bonnie Bright Laundry (formerly known as Farlington Laundry), 3800 South Four Mile Run Drive, Arlington, Va., advised SA JOHN W. PFAFF, JR. that his company has used white Thermo Seal marking tape exclusively for over two years. Mr. YOUNG made available six samples of Thermo Seal marking tape which were affixed to two 3" by 5" cards.

Mr. YOUNG noted the machine is capable of making six characters at one time and that the first four characters on this machine are slightly smaller than the last four characters. His company uses a coding system consisting of four alphabetic letters, a dash and one number. According to Mr. YOUNG, there is no standard coding process and each individual laundry is free to employ its own individual coding system.

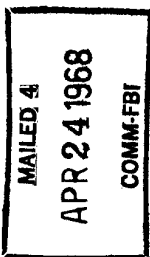

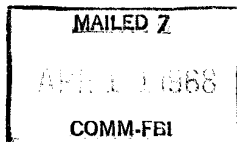
