

Three latent fingerprints and two latent palm prints of value were found on these lifts. These latent prints have been compared with latent prints previously reported in this case, but no identification effected. Latent prints will be compared with prints of all suspects and you will subsequently be advised of results.

There are presently twenty-one latent fingerprints and five latent palm prints remaining unidentified in this case.
